Punjab Budget Session: Industry says Punjab govt needs to focus on relief package

Ludhiana Agency. A day after the state presented its annual budget, industry captains in Punjab said that the state government needed to focus on relief packages to help industrial units in the state. Badish Jindal, president of the Federation of Small Industries Association, said: "Industry needs some package to survive. Rather than just focusing on taxes, they need to focus on relief packages."

Finance Minister Manpreet Singh Badal in his budget speech had mentioned that Rs 1500 crore was earmarked to be paid as power subsidy as government had announced of providing power at Rs 5 a unit.

Jindal said, "We are still getting power in the range of Rs 9-12 a unit after all the fixed charges and taxes are added up and another tariff hike is in the offing where we apprehend increase in fixed charges. However, if government pays up all subsidy, it comes out to be Rs 3500 crore. Therefore the government needs to check on the issue of providing power subsidy."

About the e-way limit being increased from Rs 50,000 to Rs one lakh, Inderjit Singh Navyug, president of United Cycles Parts and Manufacturers Association, said: "It was earlier at Rs 1 lakh only. But government had reduced it to Rs 50,000 and after a hue and cry, it has restored it to Rs one lakh. It is not a big deal." Upkar Singh, president of Chamber of Industrial and Commercial Undertakings, questioned no infrastructure improvement announcement for focal points by Punjab government in Monday's budget.

Union Cabinet approves transfer of 50.76 acres of land to PGIMER, Chandigarh

Chandigarh Agency. The Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, on Tuesday approved a proposal to transfer 50.76 acres of land at Sarangpur, Chandigarh, to Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER).

According to the PGIMER, the land is meant for a project that will mostly benefit the Out-patient Department. Cancer management research and Palliative care centres will come up under one roof, besides a learning resource centre (LRC) and multi-level parking.

According to the PGI director, it will give breathing space to the hospital. "The setting up of a new OPD, shifting of trauma centre, cancer care and LRC, will decrease the waiting time for surgeries for the common man. Emergency services will be available in a highly efficient manner and infrastructural medical facilities will improve considerably. This will benefit the poorest of the poor patients attending the PGI-Chandigarh. Health services and tertiary care will be more effective," PGI Director Dr Jagat Ram told Chandigarh Newline.

There are around 10,000 patients who visit the PGI daily, on an average. The PGIMER is planning to set up four major health facilities, including a cancer institute on 50 acres at Sarangpur. The institute has decided to set up four centres on this land, including a learning resource centre, new OPD block, trauma centre and cancer centre. Dr Ram said, "I would really like to thank UT Administrator and Punjab Governor V P Singh Badnore who really pursued it, along with our efforts."

Chandigarh MP Kirron Kher 'raids' parking lot, Congress says 'political gimmick'

Chandigarh Agency. Soon after the Chandigarh Municipal Corporation took possession of all 26 paid parking lots in the city Tuesday, BJP leader Kirron Kher inspected one in sector 35, after which she called up the civic commissioner to ask why rates for 'smart parking' were being charged when the facility was not being offered there. She also posted a video of her visit on social media.

Officials of the civic body's engineering wing and medical officer of health (MOH) wing took possession at 8 am and charged flat rates of Rs 10 for two-wheelers and Rs 20 for four-wheelers, doing away with hourly charges. Soon after, Kher arrived at a sector 35 parking lot in an Innova car. The video shows her asking the amount being charged for parking. Speaking to Chandigarh Newline, she said, "When the firm whose contract has been terminated had claimed to provide smart parking, why were they charging Rs 20 when the facility was not being provided?" Her post on Twitter said that a lot of people had been complaining to her about the same, after which she "raided the parking...and found it to be true." Getting it fixed. Will ensure that the prices are dropped to INR 10 ASAP," her post further said. Kher then called up Municipal Commissioner KK Yadav to ask why Rs 10 (regular parking) was AS it is the general house that decides revision of rates, the MP then called up Mayor Rajesh Kalita.

Punjab and Haryana HC pulls up cops for 'faulty' investigation, orders CBI probe into 2016 drugs case

Chandigarh Agency. ORDERING A CBI probe into a drugs case registered against a 28-year-old civil engineer in Amritsar, the Punjab and Haryana High Court said Punjab Police had conducted a "faulty investigation" and "violated" mandatory provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act. "Faulty investigation results in miscarriage of justice, but sometimes innocent persons are falsely implicated and the actual accused is acquitted in failure of compliance of those mandatory provisions," Justice Daya Chaudhary said in the order, while directing the CBI director to appoint an SP-rank officer to probe the case within 8 weeks. The accused, Abhishek Mittal, had sought a court-monitored CBI investigation into the case which was lodged in November 2016 by the State Special Operation Cell (SSOC) of District Amritsar.

According to the FIR lodged against him, Mittal was accused of being in possession of Rs 39,73,000 worth of "drug money" and 500 gms of heroin. However, Mittal told the court that he has been falsely implicated and is a civil engineer from Punjab Technical University, Jalandhar. Mittal further told the court that he and his family are pursuing business activities in different fields including with certain traders from Pakistan. The court was told that the money recovered was earnings from his shawl business. According to his plea in court, Mittal was on his way back to Jalandhar from Amritsar on November 8, 2016, along with some cash and a stock of shawls when his vehicle was stopped at the Dhillwan toll plaza by certain persons who took him to the SSOC police station. A case was later registered against him for allegedly being in possession of heroin and cash. However, police

in the FIR mentioned that the recovery was made at Daburji bypass, which is 30 km from Dhillwan. The court was told that the place of arrest can be verified from the call details or tower locations of phones of the accused and concerned police officers.

Justice Chaudhary in the order said it is clear that CCTV footage of the toll plaza and call details of the accused and police officers were not taken into consideration even during the investigation conducted by a senior rank officer, despite the court having issued a direction for the same. The CCTV coverage clearly reflects the number and make of the car, but as per the CFSL report, the same has not been shown to be visible.

The contradictions and variations, which are apparent, need to be investigated further," the court said, adding the CCTV coverage at the Dhillwan toll plaza needs to be looked into.

Robert Vadra questioned by ED for three hours in connection with money laundering case

New Delhi - Robert Vadra, the brother-in-law of Congress president Rahul Gandhi, was questioned by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) for about three hours on Wednesday in connection with a money-laundering case, officials said. Vadra reached the agency's office at Jammagar House in central Delhi at around 10:30 am along with his lawyers and left

after about three hours of questioning, they added. The businessman told the investigating officer (IO) of the case that he was not well and hence, the recording of his statement was discontinued, the

officials said. On Wednesday, it was a scheduled appearance of Vadra before the ED in a criminal complaint related to allegations of money laundering to purchase assets abroad, the officials said.
