Tocilizumab gets nod for emergency use

The top drug regulator body, Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) has approved emergency use of drug firm Hetero's Tocilizumab for treatment of hospitalised adults suffering from Covid-19.

Medical practitioners would be able to use the drug for treating Covid-19 in adults who receive systemic corticosteroids, and even those who require supplemental oxygen, non-invasive or invasive mechanical ventilation, or extracorporeal membrane oxygenation.

Tocilizumab, which is a biosimilar version of Roche's Actemra/RoActemra, would be available in the market by September end under the brand name Tocilizumab.

In a statement, Dr. P Sarathi Reddy, chairman, Hetero Group, said that the approval was 'extremely crucial' to ensure supply security in India due to a global shortage of Tocilizumab.
