Dear Shareholder,

We hope this communique finds you safe and in good health.

We are pleased to inform you that the Board of Directors at their Meeting held on Friday, May 05, 2023 have recommended a Final Dividend of Rs. 5.50/- per equity share of Rs. 2/- each (i.e. 275%) for the Financial Year ended March 31, 2023 and the said Final Dividend will be payable post approval of the shareholders at the ensuing Annual General Meeting of the Company to be held on Thursday, August 10, 2023.

As you are aware as per the Income-Tax Act 1961, as amended by the Finance Act, 2020, dividends paid and distributed by a Company on or after April 1, 2020 shall be taxable in the hands of the shareholders. The Company shall therefore be required to deduct tax at source (TDS) at the time of making the payment of the said Dividend, after obtaining the approval of Shareholders in the forthcoming AGM.

The TDS rate may vary depending on the residential status of the shareholder and the documents submitted by them and accepted by the Company in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

The TDS for various categories of shareholders along with required documents are provided in table below:

Please note that the Company is not obligated to apply the beneficial DTAA rates at the time of tax deduction/withholding on dividend amounts. Application of beneficial DTAA Rate shall depend upon the completeness and satisfactory review by the Company, of the documents submitted by Non- Resident Shareholder.

TDS to be deducted at higher rate in case of non-filers of Return of Income

The Finance Act, 2021, has inter alia inserted the provisions of section 206AB of the Act with effect from July 1, 2021. The provisions of section 206AB of the Act require the deductor to deduct tax at higher of the following rates from amount paid/ credited to 'specified person':

- i. At twice the rate specified in the relevant provision of the Act; or
- ii. At twice the rates or rates in force; or
- iii. At the rate of 5%

The 'specified person' means a person who has:

- a. not filed return of income for both of the two assessment years relevant to the two previous years immediately prior to the previous year in which tax is required to be deducted, for which the time limit of filing return of income under sub-section (1) of section 139 has expired; and
- b. subjected to tax deduction/collection at source in aggregate amounting to Rs. 50,000 or more in each of such two immediate previous years.

For shareholders having multiple accounts under different status / category:

Shareholders holding shares under multiple accounts under different status / category and single PAN, may note that, higher of the tax as applicable to the status in which shares held under a PAN will be considered on their entire holding in different accounts.

If the dividend income is taxable in the hands of any person other than the recipient of the dividend, then the requisite details by way of a declaration under section 199 of the Act and Rule 37BA of the Income-tax Rules, 1962 should be provided by the registered owner.

Kindly note that, if you have not submitted the aforesaid documents earlier for the Financial Year 2023-24 for the purpose of claiming exemption from tax deduction at source, you are requested to submit the same on the portal – <https://zfrmz.in/Lbw6k3DvzvXlxVaeXwsJ> or in case of any difficulty, you can also submit to the Company at email Id : tdsforms@bharatforge.com on or before **Friday, July 07, 2023** in order to enable the Company to determine and deduct the appropriate TDS/ withholding tax rate.

No communication/documents on the tax determination/deduction shall be entertained post **Friday, July 07, 2023**.

In case of any queries the shareholders can send an email to: tdsforms@bharatforge.com on or before **Friday, July 07, 2023**.

It may be further noted that in case the tax on said Final Dividend is deducted at a higher rate in the absence of receipt of the aforementioned details/documents from you, there would still be an option available with you to file the return of income and claim an appropriate refund, if eligible. No claim shall lie against the Company for such taxes deducted.

The tax credit can be viewed in Form 26AS by logging in with your credentials (with valid PAN) at TRACES <https://www.tdscpc.gov.in/app/login.xhtml> or the e-filing website of the Income Tax department of India <https://www.incometaxindiaefiling.gov.in/home>.

Updation of PAN/ Bank Account details:

All Shareholders are requested to ensure that the details such as Permanent Account Number (PAN), residential status, category of Shareholder (e.g. Domestic Company, Foreign Company, Individual, Firm, LLP, HUF, Foreign Portfolio Investors / Foreign Institutional Investors, Government, Trust, Alternate Investment Fund, etc.), email id and address and Bank account details are updated, in their respective demat account(s) maintained with the Depository Participants.
