Sub: <u>Disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015</u>

Dear Sir/ Ma'am,

This is in continuation to our earlier disclosures dated February 12, 2021 and February 18, 2021, whereby, we had informed that New Delhi Television Limited (NDTV/ Company) has filed a writ petition before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court assailing the order dated January 29, 2021 ("Impugned Order") passed by the Dispute Resolution Panel-2, under Section 144C(5) of the Income-tax Act, 1961 for Assessment Year 2009-10.

In the hearing held on February 24, 2021, the Hon'ble Delhi High Court granted interim relief to the Company and held that while the Assessing Officer can continue with the process of passing the Assessment Order pursuant to the Impugned Order, no effect will be given to any such order till the next date of hearing i.e. May 12, 2021.
