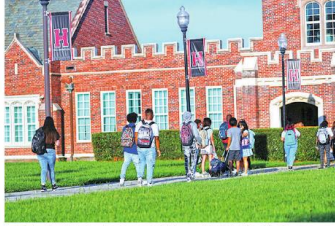

EU Won't Impose Travel Curbs on US Despite Surge in Covid-19 Case

New cases in US at 270 per 100,000 inhabitants and exceed the EU limit of 75

Brussels: The European Union decided not to reinstate restrictions on non-essential travel from the US despite new Covid-19 cases there exceeding the bloc's threshold. The next review of the list of countries being granted unrestricted access into the EU will be in two weeks, according to a spokesperson for the Slovakian Presidency, who confirmed Monday's decision.

New Covid cases in the US rose to about 270 per 100,000 inhabitants over the previous 14 days, according to data compiled by the European Center for Disease Prevention and Control. The EU limit is 75 new cases.

The guidance from the bloc is a recommendation and any decision on who to let in, and what restrictions to impose, ultimately rests with the government of each member state. While countries have largely followed the guidelines, there have been times when individual nations have diverged from them.

Airline routes between the EU and US have recovered to almost 50% of pre-pandemic levels as Brussels chose to let in fully vaccinated Americans in June.

Easing mutual access has been a point of contention between the two regions. The Biden administration has kept foreign travel restrictions in place despite its pressure to allow visitors from places like the US. US officials have cited rising delta variant cases as one reason for that decision.

Singapore: Singapore said 70% of its population has been fully vaccinated, and 79% have received at least one dose, giving the city-state one of the best vaccination rates in the world as today it starts to ease social distancing restrictions and restart parts of the economy. **Bloomberg**

America Warns Citizens against Travel to France



Washington: The US State Department has advised Americans to avoid all travel to France over the current coronavirus cases in the country. France is battling a fourth wave of the virus even though Covid-19 hospitalisations are still way off previous highs.

The State Department issued a "Level 4: Do Not Travel" advisory for France on Monday, based on a parallel warning from the US Centers for Disease Control, the country's top medical body.

"If you must travel to France, make sure you are fully vaccinated before travel," the CDC said.

France has recorded more than 6 million cases and 111,000 deaths in total, and daily cases have crept back up to around 20,000 a day while deaths remain low compared to the height of the pandemic.

A total of 74 million vaccine doses have been administered in France, according to the World Health Organization, and over 55 percent of the eligible population have received both vaccine doses.

Anger at President Emmanuel Macron's controversial plan to squeeze infections and encourage vaccinations has seen large protests recently, though polls have shown that a clear majority of French back the Covid pass, even including the extension this week to cafes and restaurants. **AFP**

Prince Andrew Sued in NY Court for Alleged Sex Abuse

New York: Queen Elizabeth II's second son, Prince Andrew, was sued in a New York court on Monday for alleged sexual abuse of a woman who says she was "lured out" for underage sex by late US financier Jeffrey Epstein.

The filing at the US district court in Manhattan said Virginia Giuffre was the plaintiff in the case against the defendant, named as "Prince Andrew, Duke of York."

Giuffre alleged in the filing that she "was regularly abused by Epstein and was lured out by Epstein to other powerful men for sexual purposes." "One such powerful man... was the Defendant, Prince Andrew."

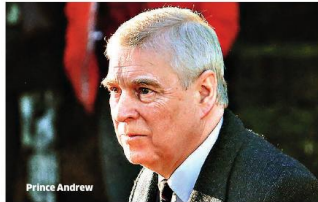
According to the complaint, Giuffre said Andrew sexually abused her at the London home of socialite Ghislaine Maxwell more than 20 years ago, when she was under 18.

"Epstein, Maxwell, and Prince Andrew forced (the) Plaintiff, a child, to have sexual intercourse with Prince Andrew against her will," it said.

Andrew, 61, has vehemently denied claims he had sex with Giuffre, and said he has no recollection of meeting her, but the allegations threaten to damage the British royal family.

A spokesman for Buckingham Palace declined to comment on the lawsuit and a public relations company representing Andrew e-mailed a "no comment" response to AFP on Tuesday.

Kim Jong Un's Sister Condemns Seoul over Drills with US

Asks Washington to withdraw its forces from the peninsula

Seoul: The influential sister of North Korean leader Kim Jong Un called South authorities "perfidious" Tuesday over the South's joint military exercises with the United States, and demanded Washington withdraw its forces from the peninsula. Kim Jong Un's latest remarks came despite a surprise thaw on the Korean peninsula, prompted by a series of personal letters between her brother and South Korean President Moon Jae-in.

The two sides last month restored cross-border communications that were severed more than a year ago, announcing their leaders had agreed to work

on improving ties.

But Kim Yo Jong—a key adviser to her brother—condemned South Korea for holding "dangerous" joint military drills with the United States this month, which the North has long considered rehearsals for invasion. She expressed her "deep regret at the perfidious behaviour of the south Korean authorities" in a statement released by Pyongyang's official KCNA news agency.

In an unusually explicit comment from a North Korean official—Pyongyang usually restricts itself to ambiguous calls for the United States to abandon its "hostile policy"—she demanded Washington pull out its forces from the peninsula.

Seoul and Washington are treaty allies, with around 28,500 American troops stationed in South Korea to defend it against its nuclear-armed neighbour. **AFP**

Unvaccinated Germans Face More Covid Tests to Avoid Restrictions

Berlin: Germany needs to increase testing and boost vaccinations to avoid another Covid lockdown, the conservative candidate to succeed Angela Merkel as chancellor said on Tuesday, before government talks to curb a rise in new cases.

Less than seven weeks before a federal election, Merkel and leaders of the 16 federal states will try to agree on measures to avert a new wave of infections, driven by the spread of the Delta variant.

"We want to and will test more to avoid a new lockdown," Armin Laschet told the North Rhine-



Westphalia assembly.

Hoping to become chancellor after a Sept. 26 election, Laschet is desperate to avoid new restrictions and said Germany should introduce incentives to encourage more people to get vaccinated and also ramp up compulsory testing.

Germany had made the tests free for all in March to make a gradual return to normal life possible after a lockdown to break a third wave of COVID-19 surges.

Taliban Tighten Control of Afghan North as UN Fears Erasure of Human Rights

Kabul: Taliban fighters tightened their grip on captured territory in Afghanistan on Tuesday as civilians hid in their homes and a pro-government commander vowed to fight to the death to defend Mazar-i-Sharif, the biggest city in the north. President Ashraf Ghani called on regional strongmen to support his government after a stunning string of Taliban gains as US led foreign forces pull out, while a UN official said the gains made in human rights over the past 20 years were in danger of being erased.

In the capital, Kabul, Ghani's aides said he was seeking help from regional militias he has squabbled with over the years to rally to the defence of his government. He also appealed to civilians to defend the country's "democratic fabric", aides said. In the town of Alibak, capital of Samangan province on the border between Mazar-i-Sharif and Kabul, Taliban fighters were consolidating their control, moving into government buildings, residents said.

Most government security forces appeared to have withdrawn, residents said. "The only way is self-imposed house arrest or to find a way to leave for Kabul," said Sher Mohammad Abas, a provincial tax officer, when asked about living conditions in Alibak. "But there even Kabul is not a safe option anymore," said Abbas, a father of four and a sole breadwinner for a family of nine.—Reuters

Zuma's Graft Trial Postponed to Sept 9

Johannesburg: The long-rumoured corruption trial of South Africa's former president Jacob Zuma over an arms deal dating back more than two decades was postponed on Tuesday to next month after he was hospitalized last week.

The 78-year-old was admitted to hospital for observation on Friday for an undisclosed condition, which prompted Tuesday's hearing to be held virtually rather than in open court. "The matter is postponed to 9th and 10th of September, 2021," Judge Piet Koopmans declared, pending a medical report on Zuma.

The case has been carrying on for years and suffered a string of hold-ups. **AFP**
