Nagpur court sentences man to death for raping, killing girl

NAGPUR: A man was sentenced to death on Monday by a Nagpur court for raping and murdering a 5-year-old girl in 2019. Sanjay Puri (32) was sentenced to death by District Judge and Additional Sessions Judge S R Padwal under section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, Section 376(A)(B) of IPC and Section 6 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, said Special Public Prosecutor Prashant Kumar Sathianathan.

Kingpin of Iran-based organ racket nabbed in Hyd

In a major breakthrough, the alleged kingpin of Iran-based organ trade racket, was nabbed from a Hyderabad hotel by the Kerala police while he was planning to leave the country. Identified as Ballamkonda Ramaprasad aka Prathapan, 41, a resident of Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh, he allegedly introduced his victims to the mafia in Iran.

Prathapan was nabbed by a special investigation team (SIT) led by Ernakulam district police chief Vaibhav Saxena. "Prathapan is the kingpin of a

major organ smuggling racket operating in the country. He was the chief coordinator of organ trade. He was responsible for finding the donor, conducting medical examination and ensuring that the person was medically fit to donate organs," said Saxena.

The police worked meticulously to establish the links of Sabitha Nasar of Thrissur, who was arrested on his arrival from Iran with Prathapan.

The gang targeted poor and illiterate rural people from Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Hyderabad, and Delhi. They earned Rs 50 lakh to Rs 1 crore for each

organ sold while the donors received only Rs 5 lakh to Rs 6 lakh each, said a police officer. A youth from Thirunelveli in Palakkad was the only person on the list from Kerala, he said.

Prathapan had himself got in touch with the operators of the racket for the first time to donate a kidney. However, the donation failed as he was found to have contracted some disease during medical examination ahead of the harvest.

While his efforts to donate his kidney failed, he snuffed an opportunity for organ sale as Iran had legalized organ donation from non-related persons in 1988.

Later, he became an active member of the racket and its deals were centered in Iran, the police said. While Sabitha Nasar was the key person in Kerala, he was reporting to one Madhu, a resident of Kochi, who was leading the operations of the racket from Iran.

As per investigations, Madhu arrived in Delhi last year. Then Prathapan, Sabitha Nasar and Madhu formed a shell company, which was controlled by one Sajith Shyam, who was already detained by the police.

The police said the gang contacted donors through social media platforms. Prathapan sent

them to Iran after completing the medical formalities. Sabitha fled ahead to Iran, received the donors and ensured that they returned home after the organs were harvested.

Due to international ramifications and with reports that part of the money may have gone to terror funding, Central agencies, including NIA, are also investigating the case, and have completed the preliminary probe, said sources.

Sources said the Iranian government's compensation scheme for organ donors and the legal backing it provides could have motivated organ trafficking.

WB POLICE SEEK NAVY HELP OVER BANGLADESH MP MURDER CASE

After several failed attempts to trace the body of slain Bangladesh MP Anwarul Azim Anar, the West Bengal police have engaged an Indian Navy team from Visakhapatnam to search a canal in Kolkata where pieces of his dismembered body were said to have been thrown.

Although the accused, butcher Jihad Hawaldar,

has claimed that a trolley bag and a weapon used in the murder were also thrown along with the MP's flesh in the canal at Bagola in the Bhongore area, the searches held by the CID over more than a week have not yielded any results.

According to sources, a team of Dhaka police has been in Nepal in search of others who were involved in the crime and are suspected to be in Nepal.

'IF SOMETHING GOES WRONG WITH RESULTS, IT WOULD BE DUE TO DISUNITY IN INDIA BLOC'

DMK Organising Secretary R.S. Bharathi has said that if by any chance the results of the Lok Sabha elections do not come in the favour of the INDIA bloc on Monday it would be due to the disunity among certain leaders which are part of the coalition.

The DMK leader told IANS that there should not be any negligence on the part of the party agents who are present during the counting of votes.

He said that during certain state Assembly elections, the winning margin was very low.

Bharathi added that the DMK had made adjustments



with the opposition coalition partners and has even reduced its seat tally from 24 in 2019 to 21 in the 2024 Lok Sabha polls for the best interests of the INDIA bloc coalition. He said that "if something goes wrong, then it would be due to certain parties and leaders not ad-

justing with other coalition partners in the best interests of the INDIA bloc coalition".

He also cited the examples of West Bengal and Kerala.

The senior DMK leader, however, said that the Congress leaders, including Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Gandhi, had worked hard

and there were huge crowds present at the rallies of both leaders.

Bharathi added that due to the high voltage campaign of Rahul Gandhi and Priyanka Gandhi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi was forced to alter his campaign schedule.

Before the different Exit Poll results were announced on Saturday, IANS had reported of DMK leadership not averse to switching sides and entering into an alliance with the NDA if the NDA falls short of a majority in forming the government at the Centre.

The BJP and DMK were in political alliance during the Atal Bihari Vajpayee-led NDA government.

'EC has agreed to count postal ballots first'

NEW DELHI: The opposition on Monday said the Election Commission (EC) has agreed to its request of counting the postal ballots first on June 4, when the results of the Lok Sabha polls are scheduled to be declared, and stressed that this is the participatory manner of promoting the spirit of democracy in a non-adversarial fashion.

Leaders from the INDIA opposition bloc had urged the EC on Sunday to ensure that on June 4, the postal ballots are counted and their results declared before the outcome of the EVMs is announced, and said the poll panel should issue clear guidelines on the counting process and ensure that those are implemented. A delegation of leaders from the Indian National Development Inclusive Alliance (INDIA), including the Congress's Abhishek Singhvi, met the full bench of the EC on Sunday, ahead of Tuesday's counting of the votes polled in the LS polls.

Congress in Rajasthan suspects foul play

Asks agents to stay till last vote count

Suspecting foul play in counting, the Congress in Rajasthan has asked its counting agents to remain at the counting table until the last vote count. "The party candidates on some seats have even put guards outside the EVM strong rooms.

Former CM Ashok Gehlot in his post on X has said "I would like to tell all the Congress agents involved in the counting process, AROs, ROs and Congress workers to reach the

counting place on time in the morning and not leave the counting table until the last vote is counted."

He asked the agents to match the total number of votes in Form 17-C and EVM and if there is no match, lodge an objection with the concerned authorities. Gehlot said that All Congress MLAs and Assembly candidates should reach the counting venue (district headquarters) to support and encourage the Lok Sabha candidate.

"Through exit polls an attempt has been made to create an atmosphere in favor of BJP whereas we all have gone among the public and heard the voices of those who are against BJP. You should get the counting of votes done with full en-

thusiasm and positivity. It is in the national interest for the Congress and India alliance to win this Lok Sabha election," said Gehlot.

The president of the state unit of the Congress Govind Singh Datasara echoed Allot and said that BJP people can do a thousand types of foul play but this time our worker is very alert. From our candidates to counting agents, every one is alert and vigilant.

Datasara said that the party has asked the agents to match the EVM votes with Form 17. Form 17 contains details of the votes cast during the polling hours.

He confirmed that many of Congress candidates have even put guard outside the EVM strong rooms.

RAVE PARTY CASE

TELGU ACTOR HELD

BENGALURU: The Central Crime Branch probing the Bengaluru rave party case arrested Telugu film actress Hema following interrogation on Monday.

The rave party was organised on May 19 at a farmhouse near Electronic City. The Central Crime Branch (CCB) had summoned Hema to its office on Monday. Sources said she deposited before her interrogators wearing a burqa to hide her identity. As her replies were not satisfactory, she was arrested.

The rave party was organised on the pretext of a birthday party where most of the people had come from neighbouring Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, according to CCB sources.

Based on a tip-off, the CCB raided the location and collected the blood samples of those who attended the party.

32 monkeys drown in irrigation well

Medininagar (Jharkhand): As many as 32 wild monkeys were suspected to have drowned in an irrigation well in Jharkhand's Palamu district in a bid to quench their thirst, a forest official said on Monday. It took place in Sorath village in Panki block and the corpses were found on Sunday, but officials were yet to ascertain the exact date of the incident.

"A total of 32 wild monkeys were found dead in an irrigation well in Sorath... the corpses were fished out," Medininagar Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Kumar Ashish said.
