## Wall collapse: Factory owner among 6 held

A DAY after 12 labourers, including three children, were killed in a wall collapse at a salt processing plant in the Halvad town of Morbi, the factory owner, his brother and four employees were arrested Thursday.

The accused were booked for culpable homicide not amounting to murder. Two other accused were wanted in the case, police said.

Based on a complaint filed by Rajesh Pirana, Halvad police booked Afzal Ghoniya, the owner of the Sagar Chem Food Industries (SCFI) and his brother Waris alias Devo Dhoniya, who looks after administration and stacking and loading of salt bags. The police also booked Rajeshkumar Jain, Kishanram Chaudhary and his brother Atmaram Chaudhary who, too, have stakes in the factory and are associated with the administration. Three supervisors at the factory—Sanjay Khatri, Manoj Sanura and Asif Nurabhai, too, have been booked.

The eight have been booked under IPC Sections 304 (culpable

homicide not amounting to murder), 308 (attempt to commit culpable homicide), 114 (abetter present when offence is committed) as well as Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act for allegedly employing children in the factory.

Afzal, Waris, Atmaram, Sanjay, Manu and Ashik Nurabhai were arrested Friday. "We are interrogating the six accused and investigation is on," KJ Mathukiya, police inspector of Halvad, said.

Rajesh Pirana's father Ramesh Pirana and sister Kajal Pirana were among those killed in the incident that occurred Wednesday morning. The labourers were killed after a wall of a shade under which they were working collapsed. In his complaint, Rajesh stated the accused constructed the wall without a foundation and stacked salt bags alongside. Rajesh, who is also a worker at the factory, further stated that pressure created by the stacks of salt bags caused the wall to fall, killing all the accused on the spot.

Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel had visited the factory after the incident and sought a report from the administration within three days.

## Rajnath urges youths to build a nation rooted in India's heritage

UNION DEFENCE Minister Rajnath Singh Friday urged the youth to work towards nation-building by learning lessons from India's heritage. Enlisting the "long tradition" of showing the "path to the world" in the field of Science and Math, Singh said India can be the "leader, guide, and light to the world facing a crisis".

"India has given the world the Zero in Math... Right from Aryabhata, Varahamihir, Brahmagupta, Bodhayan, Charak, Sushruta, Nagarjuna to Sawai Jai Singh, India has led the way in Science. Indian scientist Baudhayan discovered the Pythagoras theorem years before Pythagoras did... The list of India's achievements in science is long but I am only taking a few names. Today, when we are all working for the creation of a New India, it is important for all of us to understand our heritage... Just like a building cannot be strong without a foundation, a tree cannot grow without roots. Similarly, a nation cannot be built without its cultural legacy," Singh said addressing

the Sanskar Abhyudya Yuva Shibir of the Kundalidham Swaminarayan sect at its Kwarelibaug premises in Vadodara.

The event was Singh's first participation in a Swaminarayan event. He was felicitated with a memento of the upcoming Shri Ram Temple in Ayodhya as well as a statue of Lord Swaminarayan riding a horse. Calling the conclave a "link" to the culture of India, Singh hailed the Swaminarayan sect for being

"large-hearted" and narrated an anecdote attributing it to Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

"Narendra Modiji has told us a story about the dedication of the Swaminarayan sect towards serving the society. When he (Modi) was working in Gujarat, a natural calamity struck the state. The government needed food packets to be provided to the affected people. Modiji said that when he approached the Swaminarayan sect, they did not ask him how many packets

were needed. They simply asked him at what time he needed the food packets," Singh said.

Singh invoked "youth icon" Swami Vivekanand and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel during his 30-minute-long address to drive home the point about "building the character of the youth". "Sardar Patel has said that the country would not need a single police station if we can build the nation on the character of its people," he noted.

India's diversity has never "come in the way" of its development, the defence minister added. "India is the only country which is home to all 72 firqas (sects) of Islam and also houses one of the oldest churches in the world... This is India's culture. The world is changing and needs to think about reforming human life and India can be a leader, guide, and light to the world through its culture," he said.

At the event, Singh also unveiled the certificate by the Guinness Book of World Records bagged by the head priest of the Kundalidham Swaminarayan sect, Gyanjivandas Swami, for reciting the Shri Haricharitrnamrut Sagar Katha for 2,440 hours.

## LiFi technology from Ahmedabad firm powers internet at Nadabet

LI-FI TECHNOLOGY — also known as Light Fidelity — provided by Ahmedabad-based NAV Wireless Technologies Pvt Ltd has been saturating the internet broadband needs of Border Security Force (BSF) and tourists at Nadabet, which is the farthest and one of the most secluded points on the India-Pakistan border in Gujarat, since the last nine months.

"Nadabet is located on the border and it is connected by a small road to Suigam (in Banaskantha district) located 30 kilometres away. The saline ecosystem does not allow laying or underground or overhead optic fibre cables. Radio frequencies cannot be used as it is near Pakistan. So state government was facing an issue in providing internet connectivity to Nadabet which is now being developed as a tourist location," said Hardik Soni, co-founder of the company that has used indigenous LiFi technology to bridge the gap and provide internet services. LiFi technology uses light beams within visible and invisible spectrum to transmit data over several kilometres.

Being a wireless technology, it is bidirectional and can transmit

data at high speeds. "Since last nine months, internet provided by this technology is being used by soldiers of BSF and tourists alike. Around 15,000 people visit Nadabet every month and they are able to use the high-speed internet. This is the first big project taken up by the state and central governments to deploy LiFi technology at a spot having difficult terrain and security concerns," Soni said during an interaction with media persons at his office. Suigam being a gram panchayat is connected by an optic fibre cable.

"We have connected the optic fibre cable in Suigam to our LiFi devices in Suigam and Nadabet to provide high bandwidth internet. There are multiple users and 100 MBPS (megabits per second) will not be sufficient. So this technology provides speeds in gigabytes," the official said adding that the telecom infrastructure of BSNL and Gujarat Informatics Ltd is also been used to provide this service.

"We are not the telecom or internet service provider. We only handle the technology and the equipment," he added.

Nadabet is not only an important BSF base, but Gujarat government has been trying to promote this India-Pakistan border for tourists.

## Ahmedabad University launches centre for Space and Cosmology

Ahmedabad: Ahmedabad University launched an International Centre for Space and Cosmology Friday. The Centre will drive research in the areas of Space, Astrophysics and Cosmology, train next generation of researchers, and advance the public understanding of this domain of Physics. It seeks to reach out to young students to encourage

them to consider a research career in Space and Cosmology, and provide them with information regarding opportunities.

The Centre will operate closely with other research clusters at Ahmedabad University and is also planning workshops and conferences, looking to host visitors for short and long durations. ENS

## IITGN PhD scholar bags Fulbright-Nehru Fellowship

RISHIRAJ ADHIKARY, a PhD scholar at the Indian Institute of Technology Gandhinagar (IITGN), working under the supervision of Prof Nipun Batra in the discipline of Computer Science and Engineering, has been awarded the prestigious Fulbright-Nehru Doctoral Research Fellowship 2022-23.

The fellowship, instituted by the United States-India Educational Foundation (USIEF), Fulbright Commission in India, is awarded every year after a rigorous application and interview process. Rishiraj's PhD research at IITGN focuses on human-computer interaction and ubiquitous

computing. He will be going to Carnegie Mellon University in the US for nine months from August to work with Prof Mayank Goel at the Human-Computer Interaction Institute.

"Besides working on my research objective, I will also play my role as a cultural ambassador of India in the US. My research in the US will explore technologies that can develop a preventive, continual healthcare system to reduce death caused due to respiratory

illness. In particular, I will strengthen my research on monitoring lung health and create systems for non-contact monitoring of physiological indices," said Rishiraj. He is also a Prime Minister's Research Fellow (PMRF) in the May 2021 cycle.

The opportunity will provide him with significant exposure to state-of-the-art research facilities and a global outlook at CMU.

Prof Nipun Batra, Assistant Professor, Computer Science and Engineering at IITGN and PhD supervisor of Rishiraj, said, "I am very glad that Rishiraj will be visiting Carnegie Mellon University (a top-ranked US university for the Computer Science programmes). The experience will help him grow as a researcher and an individual."
