Gehlot wins trust vote

Will not let the government topple at any cost, he asserts

New Delhi/ Jaipur, August 14

The Congress heaved a sigh of relief as the Ashok Gehlot Government in Rajasthan won the trust vote on Friday. The State witnessed political turmoil after former PCC president Sachin Pilot and 18 MLAs belonging to his camp rebelled against Gehlot. The trust vote took place days after the Congress high command brought peace between the factions.

The Congress said in a statement after the trust vote that BJP's "dirty tricks to topple democracy" will not work in Rajasthan. "Rajasthan is a land of glory, bravery and honour," it said. AICC general secretary in-charge of organisation and Rajya Sabha MP from the State KC Venugopal, congratulating Gehlot Government, said BJP's daydream to topple an elected Government has been knocked down by the uncompromising unity and solidarity shown by the MLAs. "The Government will continue to work for the betterment of people in Rajasthan," he said.

Voice vote

Earlier, the motion of confidence moved by Parliamentary Affairs Minister Shanti Dhariwal was passed by voice vote, an expected win after the return of the dissenting Congress MLAs led by Sachin Pilot to the party. Reprising to the debate on the motion, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot criticised the BJP, accusing it again of trying to bring down his government. "I will not let the government topple at any cost even if you make all attempts," he said.

Gehlot said the crisis had come to an end in a beauti-

ful manner and this had hurt the BJP. "What was done in Arunachal Pradesh, Karnataka, Goa, Madhya Pradesh? Elected governments are being toppled and democracy is under danger," he said, accusing the BJP of targeting Congress governments.

Without mentioning names, he alleged that a Union minister was involved in the conspiracy to topple his government, saying this had become clear after some audio clips surfaced. The indirect reference was to Gajendra Singh Shekhawat, who had earlier rejected the Congress allegation.

BJP's counter

The opposition BJP accused the Gehlot camp of blaming it for the infighting within the Congress.

Targeting the chief minister for his comments against his now sacked deputy, Leader of Opposition Gulab Chand Kataria questioned how Pilot became useless after the formation of the government when he had strengthened the party while in opposition. Mocking Gehlot for keeping his loyalists holed up in hotels for a month, he said if the government had a majority it could have proven it earlier. He also questioned the Congress government over the de-

Modi's amnesty schemes are for dishonest: Cong

The Congress alleged on Friday that the "honouring the honest" announcement made by Prime Minister Narendra Modi is yet another amnesty scheme to "honour the dishonest".

The Party's media-in-charge Randeep Singh Surjewala said in a statement that BJP's legacy is amnesty schemes for tax evaders and converting black money to white. He charged that tax anarchy, tax terrorism and *raid raj* of ED-Income Tax are the hallmarks of the Modi Government.

Surjewala said Modi republished the speech he delivered on February 14, 2020. "Except for managed news headlines, PM's announcements ended up being a 'Zero Sum Game'."

As per the budget, ₹9,40,000 crore of direct tax is under dispute, he said. "Of this, demands related to corporate tax amount to ₹4,88,000 crore while taxes on income and other heads amount to ₹4,50,000 crore. In contrast, arrears as on March 2014 were only ₹4,10,000 crore, an increase of 129 per cent" he said.

"Is announcing 'three amnesty schemes' back to back honouring the honest? Repeated voluntary disclosure schemes are only meant to serve the 'dishonest' at the cost of the 'honest'. These are convert 'black money into white' schemes, he accused. For a government that came to power promising to bring back ₹80 lakh crore worth of 'black money' from abroad, these 'amnesty schemes' expose the *janulas* sold to the people," he added.

Surjewala said "target based" tax collection is the new 'tax terrorism'.

ployment of the state police at hotels where the MLAs were staying.

Pilot intervenes

Pilot intervened in the debate, reacting to remarks by Kataria and Deputy Leader of Opposition Rajendra Rathore. Referring to his seat being changed — earlier he sat next to Gehlot as the deputy chief minister — Pilot said he is now placed at the border between his party and the opposition in the House. "Who is sent to the border? The strongest warrior is sent," he said. Indirectly, he also referred to his meeting with the party high command. "But I want to tell that whatever I or my companions had to say, we have told the doctor about our complaints, he said, adding that the MLAs were now all together in the assembly after receiving the treatment. The House later adjourned to meet again next Friday.

Gehlot later said in Twitter that winning the trust vote in the assembly is a message to the forces that are trying to destabilise elected governments in the country.

"Their every tactic failed in Rajasthan," he said. "It is people's unwavering trust in us and the unity of our Congress MLAs that has brought this victory," he added.

How Bollywood's reel world has tracked India's economic evolution over years

As Chairman of the Prime Minister's Economic Advisory Council, Bibek Debroy's contributions to economic theory, study of income and social inequalities, and to law reforms, and additionally to Indology are well known. But Debroy has also, surprisingly, co-authored a paper that looks at India's economic transition through Bollywood's eyes. "We made a film on CD, with clips: the idea was to use Bollywood to drive home economic policy messages. This paper was born of that," he confides. In this obit interview, he expands on the theme.

Your paper notes that films over the years reflected the changing moods in economic policy... We're essentially talking about commercial films: films that began to reflect liberalisation, with a time lag. We also wanted to look at the portrayal of villains. At the time of land reforms, the typical villain was the landlord. Then, when the Essential Commodities Act came

along, the villain was often the hoarding ration shop owner. Then, during the phase of urbanisation and land conversion, the real estate mafia was the villain. In between, when you had the Gold Control Order, the gold smuggler was the villain. When liberalisation happened, we had a new aspiring middle class, and an entirely different film villain.

From the 1950s through to the 2000s, what sense does Bollywood convey of India's changing attitude towards wealth and poverty?

In films made in India by Indians, when we talk of an aspiring middle class, the idea that it is not bad to be rich begins to come out clearly. But economic changes are reflected in many un-likely areas, too. For instance, one could sit down with all the Amul ads, say, or with RK Laxman's cartoons over time, and see how they reflect the economic transition.

Are there parallels between the economics of 'Bollywood' and the broader economy?

We have a society and economy in the 21st century, but a lot of stuff is informal. Overnight you cannot transition from the unorganised to the organised. This is true of the broader economy, and the film industry is no different. Take something like credit: forget the formal banking system, I'm not even sure if in the informal system the way credit is granted is very transparent; or whether the distribution system is transparent.

Will giving film-making industry status help?

That recommendation has been made several times, and I am in complete agreement with it, but it is a red herring. What does it mean to declare it as the industry? It means getting credit from the banking system. This presumes the film industry wants to borrow from the formal banking system, which will bring in greater transparency requirement. I am not convinced the film industry across the board wants this transparency. Unless that happens, the demand for declaring it an industry doesn't amount to much.

EESL acts to avoid repeat of smart meter 'mischief'

In a 'pure case of sabotage' in UP, 'someone' shut down 1.5 lakh meters

Energy Efficiency Services Limited will tighten protocols to prevent sabotage of smart meters after an attempt to illicitly disconnect all 12.3 lakh smart meters that are operational in Uttar Pradesh.

"At around 3:30 PM (on Wednesday), a command was given by someone to disconnect all 12.3 lakh smart meters in Uttar Pradesh. The EESL team came to know of it at around 4:30 PM and we stopped the shutdown process. By that time, almost 1.5 lakh homes/connections were disconnected," a top EESL official told *BusinessLine*.

Unprecedented mischief
A sabotage of this magnitude has never happened before in India and now steps have been taken to prevent it from happening again.

"This is a pure case of sabotage. It is not a hacking but it is an insider of EESL's vendor - L&T - tasked with manning the Head-End System (a server where the data is processed). It is a blatant breach of protocol because L&T has been told that disconnections (if they need to) happen in batches of 50 with prior approvals of the power distribution companies (Discoms). As per contract, L&T is the System Integrator," the official said.

Under the new protocols

set by EESL, those manning the Head-End System (HES) cannot disconnect or reconnect from there. "If there is a big necessity, then that approval has to be given at a very high level in EESL, even for a single disconnection!" the official said.

New protocol

"There is nothing wrong with the meters. The data comes from the meters to the HES, and then it goes to the Meter Data Management System (MDMS). This MDMS is controlled by the Discoms and any disconnections or re-connections happen from there, as per protocol," the official added.

But there was a breach of protocol on Thursday when the alleged sabotage took place and smart meters deployed across Lucknow, Varanasi, Prayagraj, Meerut, Gorakhpur, Ghaziabad, and Noida were disconnected. Smart meters presently serve only a small fraction of UP's electricity consumers.

High level probe

"We are also coming to know that there were multiple user ids created without authorisation. A high level EESL team is reaching on Friday morning to investigate the matter and a formal police complaint will also be lodged," the official said.

The EESL team was trying to reconnect all these homes from around 5:00 PM to midnight on Wednesday. The connections have been restored to almost all homes except maybe some 200-300 cases where manual reconnection is happening.
