Sub: Disclosure under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015

Dear Sir/ Ma'am,

This is in furtherance to the disclosures made by New Delhi Television Limited (“NDTV”) on December 4, 2019, December 10, 2019, December 17, 2019 and January 24, 2020, in regard to the Civil Appeal filed by NDTV before the Hon’ble Supreme Court, challenging the order dated August 7, 2019 passed by Securities Appellate Tribunal (“SAT”), and the Notice of Demand/Recovery Certificate dated November 22, 2019 issued by the Securities & Exchange Board of India (“SEBI”), under Rule 2 of the Second Schedule to the Income Tax Act, 1961 r/w Section 28A of the Securities and Exchange Board of India Act, 1992.

SEBI has separately filed a Special Leave Petition in the Hon’ble Supreme Court, challenging the Judgment dated September 4, 2019 passed by the Hon’ble Bombay High Court, which has been tagged with the Civil Appeal filed by NDTV.

In the hearing held on February 22, 2021 before the Hon’ble Supreme Court, the Solicitor General appearing for SEBI sought an adjournment. Accordingly, the matters have been adjourned to March 22, 2021 on the same terms as before.
