Myanmar blocks FB; UN to mobilise global community to ensure coup fails

The UN Security Council met on Tuesday to discuss the situation in Myanmar

YANGON: Myanmar's new military government has blocked access to Facebook as resistance to Monday's coup surged amid calls for civil disobedience to protest the ousting of the elected civilian government and its leader Aung San Suu Kyi.

Mar have been ordered to temporarily block Facebook. We urge authorities to restore connectivity so that people in Myanmar can communicate with family and friends and access important information, said a Facebook spokesperson.
