A 'trishul' for decarbonisation

India must focus on power, industry and agriculture to achieve its 2070 target; but all three sectors are politically inconvenient to tackle

Even as the latest edition of the United Nations Climate Change Conference draws to a close in Egypt, India's quest to decarbonise its economy rests on a "trishul" (trident) strategy — power, industry and agriculture are the three prongs that together accounted for 80 per cent of the country's 3,274 million tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (MtCO₂e) in emissions in pre-pandemic 2019.

And India's progress towards net zero by 2070 will depend on how successful it is in facilitating an orderly transition to a clean economy by addressing these key areas, said management consultant McKinsey in its latest report.

Cleaning up the country's air does not come cheap. India needs investments of \$7-12 trillion until 2050 to decarbonise its economy, around 6 per cent of GDP through this period, in an accelerated transition, according to McKinsey estimates. Arthur D Little and Teri experts anticipate expenditure of \$300-400 billion to meet 2030's renewable targets.

Though one can argue with the numbers, the need for clean energy is indisputable. Though India's emissions currently stand at a mere 1.8 MtCO₂e per capita (versus the US at 14.7 and China at 7.6), it is still the world's third-largest emitter at 2.9 GtCO₂e or gigatonnes CO₂ equivalent (4.9 per cent of global emissions), said McKinsey, in its latest report on "Decarbonizing India".

India will likely be a \$22-trillion economy in real 2010 dollar terms, about seven times its current GDP, by 2070, according to EIU estimates, while greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions may increase to 11.8 GtCO₂e, four-fold above current levels, at current reduction rates. Over three-fourths of the India of 2050 is yet to be built, and this growth could multiply demand across power and steel sectors eight-fold. An accelerated approach cuts emissions to 0.4 GtCO₂e, leading to a 98 per cent reduction in emissions intensity by 2070 versus 2019 by creating 287 GtCO₂e of carbon space, McKinsey said.

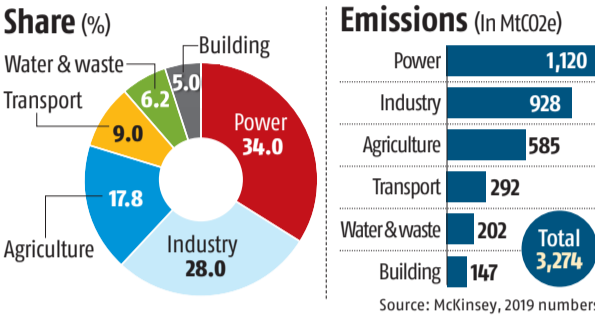
"To achieve net zero, we must focus on our target of creating 500 Gw of non-fossil fuel fired capacity," said Ajay Shankar, distinguished fellow at Teri and a former senior bureaucrat in the power ministry. "It's achievable, affordable, and is the least cost of meeting additional electricity goals. We achieve that and we can achieve everything."

In that context, electric vehicles (EVs) are effective only if they are powered by renew-

ables, and not coal, said Pankaj Gupta, CEO, Mufin Green Finance, an EV financier. "The thought process has to start with clean electricity," he added.

The key to net zero lies in identifying the sectors that are the biggest emitters rather than focusing on areas that are politically convenient to tackle, industry officials said. Public opinion is clouded by what it sees. For instance, one would blame toxic fumes from tailpipes of vehicles in

India's densely packed cities for pollution; even some experts do. But transport is the least of our problems, McKinsey's report shows. Vehicular pollution accounts for just 9 per cent of total emissions. The more intractable polluters lie in the politically sensitive sectors of power and agriculture, which together account for over half the emissions for which the government has no answers yet.

For instance, farmers continue to burn stubble with impunity, and are reluctant to adopt new practices for rice cultivation. Corporate lobbies have forced New Delhi to postpone installing sulphur mitigating equipment at coal-fired generators, the world's biggest polluters, by a decade. Coal Minister Pralhad Joshi told *Business Standard* that the focus is now to capture,

not halt carbon emissions — an about-turn from a year back when the government wanted to retire a quarter of the coal-fired capacity.

"India's main focus remains clean energy, where coal as a resource will be needed for sustainable planning of the power ecosystem," said Hetal Gandhi, director, research, CRISIL. "In our view, over fiscals 2023-2032 an estimated 350-360 Gw of non-fossil fuel including storage (solar, wind, other RE, hydro, PSE, battery, nuclear) is expected to be added as compared to 30-40 Gw of fossil fuel additions," she added.

India announced its goal to become a net-zero emitter by 2070 last year at COP26. It will be the last major economy to get there. Besides committing to using half of power-installed capacity from non-fossil fuel-based energy by 2030, it seeks to achieve a 45 per cent reduction in emissions intensity from 2005 levels. About 70 per cent of India's emissions are driven by six sectors: power, steel, automotive, aviation, cement and agriculture. Electricity generation contributes 34 per cent, followed by industry at 28 per cent and agriculture at 18 per cent.

India has reduced the emissions intensity of GDP by 1.3 per cent per year over the last decade. However, this pace of intensity reduction is not quick enough, McKinsey said, because it will not cause India's emissions

curve to bend, given the fast growth expected. India has the second highest emissions intensity or volume of emissions per unit of GDP, at 1.5, after Russia. The US and Japan are at 0.3 and 0.4 respectively.

"Although the government has rolled out many policies and incentives, there is a requirement to accelerate the adoption of existing policies and incentives and implement them with greater urgency," said Jyoti Kumar Bansal, chief, sustainability, CSR, Tata Power. "Climate action must match its pace to the crisis." Tata Power is pursuing 2 Gw of solar and hybrid capacities annually to be carbon net-zero before 2045.

Taming emissions while accommodating growth will require much more aggressive actions, policies and scale, and if India is to have an orderly and accelerated decarbonisation, the transition has to be set up within this decade, McKinsey said. Investment, currently at \$44 billion a year, may need to increase 3.6 times by 2030 and 10 times by 2040.

Renewable capacity addition has to increase fivefold to 50 Gw per year in 2030, and ninefold a year in 2040, according to the report. Early imposition of a carbon price could lead to 200 MT of steel capacity being built on the green hydrogen route instead of coal by 2050. All two-wheelers, three-wheelers and light truck sold may need to be electric early in the next decade, and all cars sold electric by 2035. For this, battery costs may need to decline by 40 per cent in 2030. Charging stations would need to increase 40 times by 2040. Green hydrogen would need a subsidy of \$60-80 per Kw for electrolyser manufacturing, and carbon prices (within this decade) to support uptake in steelmaking; 29 Gw of electrolyzers may need to be installed by 2030 (relative to the current deployment of about 1.4 Gw, globally) and almost 400 Gw by 2040, McKinsey said.

McKinsey's accelerated approach towards cutting emissions that meshes with the Modi government's ambitions has its benefits. But there can be harsh consequences for huge national assets in refining, power and mining, and for the millions employed in them. Over 60 per cent of India's refining capacity, 90 per cent of its coal-mining capacity, and all its coal power generation would be infructuous by 2050 in an accelerated transition. Tax collections from automotive fuel, which at \$85 billion comprise 18 per cent of the annual central government income, could decline to \$36 billion by 2050. Ten times as much land, a politically sensitive issue in India, as is used today would need to be identified and made available, which is not possible without efficient land use practices.

PE/VC investments drop 75% in October over last year: IVCA-EY

Private equity and venture capital (PE/VC) investments in October 2022 dropped 75 per cent compared with the same period last year, with total investments of \$3.3 billion across 75 deals, including six large deals worth \$2.2 billion, according to the IVCA-EY monthly PE/VC round-up.

According to Vivek Soni, partner and national leader, private equity services, EY, after being on a declining trend for the past five months, PE/VC investments have recorded a 60 per cent sequential uptick this month.

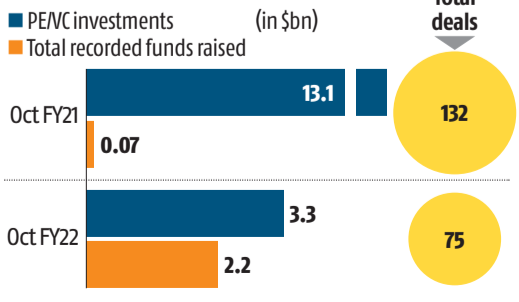
"The Indian economy continues to outperform relative to other emerging markets and while there may be short-term volatility, the PE/VC community continues to be sanguine about India's long-term growth prospects," he said.

Inflation woes, recession fears, the rising cost of capital, and elevated levels of uncertainty driven by geopolitical tensions have weighed down the PE/VC activity in 2022, globally as well as locally. "In India, the investment momentum, both in terms of size and number of deals, has slowed down considerably," Soni added.

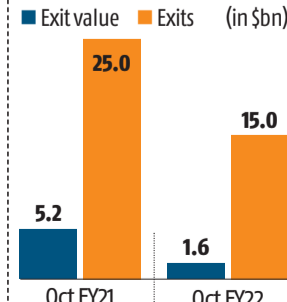
2022 has, so far, been the best year for credit investments, recording \$3.5 billion in investments. Credit investments in 2022 to date are 5 per cent more than the pre-

vious high recorded in 2019. Four sectors — financial services, real estate, infrastructure and e-commerce —

accounted for almost 80 per cent of all credit investments between 2017 and 2022 (January-October).

What if timekeepers do away with leap second?

The International Bureau of Weights and Measures (BIPM — Le Bureau Internationale Poid et Mesure) meets tomorrow (November 18) at its headquarters in Versailles, France, to vote on various things. One of these involves the future of the "leap second": Will international timekeepers continue to add a second every so often to adjust for natural variations in the Earth's rotation and revolution?

Many of the world's largest digital businesses and several government bodies wish to abandon this practice. This decision, one way or another, will actually make a difference to ordinary citizens.

What is a second?

The basic unit of time, the second, was redefined in 1967. Until then, it was defined in terms of the day with 86,400 seconds (24 hours x 60 minutes x 60 seconds) per day. A day, however, is hard to measure precisely. While we understand a day intuitively as one rotation period, the Earth does not rotate at perfectly uniform speed.

The second was redefined in atomic terms in 1967. Using atomic clocks, the second is counted in terms of the frequency of photon absorption in a Caesium isotope (Caesium-133). This can be exactly measured, and it doesn't vary. The atomic second, which is the international unit of time, is the period taken by Caesium 133 to emit 9,192,631,770 flashes. This can be counted in any lab with appropriate equipment. Of course, the day was redefined as the period when 86,400 new atomic seconds occurred. This is the international definition, used in UTC (Universal Coordinated Time or Temps Universel Coordonné).



Are these measures precise?

The second is very precise. But the day is not, since the Earth has variances in rotation speed, and orbital period. As far as we can figure, the Earth's rotation is slowing by 1 millisecond or so (1/1000 of a second) every 100 years, but this deceleration is not uniform. So the length of day is increasing. What's more, there are annual variations in the orbit around the Sun. These are not completely corrected by adding February 29, every leap year.

So what is a "leapsecond"?

The BIPM adds a "leap second" every so often to adjust for these variations. This involves tedious calculations and a consensus decision taken by scientists interacting at the inter-governmental body. The BIPM adds up errors and corrects them by adding a full second either on June 30, or December 31. Instead of 23:59:59 switching to 0:0:0 as is normal, an extra "23:59:60" is inserted. As many as 27 leap-seconds have been added in this fashion, between 1970 and now.

So what's the problem?

"Everybody" uses digital time-keeping systems. Your car's GPS splits time into

nanoseconds (1 billionth of a second, or 1 divided by 10 to the power of 9) to tell you where you are. Financial exchanges put time-stamps on orders to one thousandth (millisecond) of a second accuracy, or one-millionth (microsecond) in some cases. Fancy military gear such as target radar requires even greater accuracy (1 picosecond, or 1 divided by 10¹²).

Programming a digital system working in nanoseconds, or picoseconds, to add a full second every so often is a painful, error-ridden process. Doing this to millions of different systems is even more messy. If there's an error, or if one critical system doesn't synchronise, given our reliance on absolutely precise time-keeping, it could have severe consequences — perhaps as severe as the famous Y2K problem. Glitches are known to cause internet outages, for example.

What problems are known to have been caused by leap seconds?

The leap second change triggered a Reddit crash in 2012, and outages at Mozilla, LinkedIn, Yelp and Amadeus. In 2017, Cloudflare, which hosts many of the world's biggest websites, was knocked out. Its software thought time had gone backward and couldn't handle that! This leads to another potential problem — if we ever have to subtract a leap second (which may be necessary), most digital time-keeping systems will probably crash.

What is BIPM going to vote on?

The BIPM is going to consider dropping the practice of adjusting time altogether. Google, Microsoft, Meta and Amazon have lobbied together with the support of many digitally-enabled businesses and platforms to scrap the leap-second. Their contention is, an inaccuracy in adjustment could cause much more trouble than simply living with inaccuracy.

3 killed, 6 injured in truck-taxi collision
