## Debate on Sanatan Dharma in public: D Raja challenges BJP leaders

CHENNAI: While expressing his support to Minister Udhayanidhi Stalin on the Sanatan Dharma row, CPI General Secretary D Raja challenged Union Minister Amit Shah and BJP leaders to debate on Sanatan Dharma in public.

He added that Sanatan Dharma is an ideology that does not accept changes and wants the continuation of the caste structure. "It is not wrong in talking about defeating the ideology. Sanatan Dharma has been made an issue by the BJP. They are turning the issue against religion and are instigating violence. Are you ready to debate in public about Sanatan Dharma?" the senior leader asked during a press meet held in Chennai on Friday. Speaking on the convening of a special session of



Parliament, Raja said that the government has not disclosed the intention and need for holding the special session to other parties as well as to the public.

"There was no discussion with the parties before announcing the special session. Parliament is

the highest body in Indian democracy. But it is becoming increasingly redundant," he opined. He added that the BJP has been shattered due to the INDIA alliance formed by the Opposition party and they have a guilty complex that they did not

contribute to the freedom struggle. "They are trying to rewrite history and redefine nationhood. India is a diversified country but they are making it one dimensional. First they called for 'one nation, one language', then 'one nation, one tax'. Now they are for 'one nation, one election'. They will make 'one nation, one party', and 'one nation, one leader.' This is called dictatorship," Raja explained.

Commenting on India's leadership in G20, Raja clarified that BJP is propagating that the leadership is due to Modi. But G20 leadership is given on a rotational basis.

"They are speaking about 'one earth, one family'. But they should introspect whether all Indians are treated as one family or not," he said.

## Take action against Udhay, Sekar Babu: TN BJP urges Gov Ravi



CHENNAI: Tamil Nadu BJP leaders on Thursday called on Governor R N Ravi and submitted a memorandum written by Annamalai that requested the Governor to take action against state ministers Udhayanidhi and P K Sekar Babu. The BJP has announced a State-wide protest against the HR&CE minister and the Tamil Nadu government on September 11 for hurting the sentiments of the practitioners of Sanatana Dharma.

"Udhayanidhi Stalin has deliberately disturbed peace and tranquillity in Tamil Nadu and has to be dealt with in the same manner as every citizen of this country but is safeguarded by the police from action due to the privilege of being the son of the chief minister

of Tamil Nadu. We request you to kindly instruct the DGP of the state to take action on the complaints immediately, FIR be filed, and action be taken as per the guidelines laid by the Supreme Court of India," Annamalai said in a letter. Further, the saffron party leader urged the Governor to dismiss Minister PK Sekar Babu from the Council of Ministers for violating his oaths of office.

"As a Minister for the administration of Hindu temples, a place of practice of Sanatana Dharma, PK Sekar Babu has willfully violated the oath for office by being present in the Sanatana eradication conference and for being a mute spectator for the call for the eradication of the Dharma.

CHENNAI: The ruling DMK got its lieutenants to up its ante on the Sanatana Dharma issue unfazed by the ruling BJP's extraordinary interest on the Sanatana Dharma issue. Rushing to the defence of his youth wing secretary Udhayanidhi Stalin, DMK deputy general secretary cum Nilgiris MP A Raja on Wednesday dared the union home minister Amit Shah for a public debate on Sanatana Dharma. Speaking at the condemnation protest organized by Secular Progressive Alliance against the Vishwakarma Yojana scheme launched by the BJP regime here, Raja said, "Bring anyone from the BJP. I am ready for a public debate on Sanatana Dharma. The Vishwakarma Yojana scheme is a manifestation of Sanatana Dharma." "Udhayanidhi has spoken softly. I would go hard at Sanatana Dharma," he added. His statement comes a day after he dared the BJP for a debate on the issue and said, "I dare Amit Shah from Pudukottai (Pudukottai). Let it be anyone from the BJP, or yourself (Amit Shah). Let us have an open debate in Delhi. Let one lakh people gather. Let us debate Sanatana Dharma. Let the people of the

country decide who is right? I am ready. DMK is ready. Are you ready?" Raja was speaking at the meeting organized by his party in Pudukottai ruled by BJP ally NR Congress.

Remarking that Amit Shah became a minister and he became a minister only because of the destruction of Sanatana Dharma, Raja added; "Only because of that you are home minister, otherwise you would have been doing something else. Only because we fought Sanatana Dharma, Tamizhisai Soundararajan is Governor now, Vanathi Srinivasan is an advocate. Only because we destroyed it, Annamalai is IPS, instead of rearing cattle. Are you not ashamed of speaking in support of Sanatana Dharma after securing the positions (of power) through the Sanatana Dharma we destroyed.

Don't you have conscience?" Quoting B R Ambedkar who said that if the education of a person is detrimental to the society he is more dangerous than the beast, A Raja said, "Mr Modi, Amit Shah and Tamizhisai, what Ambedkar said would apply to you."

# Increased intake of multivitamins may raise risk of cancer: Study

Love to mindlessly pop multivitamin pills, without any proven deficiency? Beware, you may be at an increased risk of cancer, warns a study. The study led by a team from the Karolinska Institutet in Sweden showed that Vitamin C and other antioxidants stimulate the formation of new blood vessels in lung cancer tumours.

The discovery, published in The Journal of Clinical Investigation, corroborates the idea that dietary supplements containing antioxidants can accelerate tumour growth and metastasis. However, the risk is only when taken in excess amounts.

"We've found that antioxidants activate a mechanism that causes cancer tumours to form new blood vessels, which is surprising, since it was previously thought that antioxidants have a protective effect," said study leader Martin Bergo, Professor at the Department of Biosciences and Nutrition at Karolinska Institutet in Sweden.

"The new blood vessels nourish the tumours and can help them grow and spread," Bergo added.

Antioxidants neutralise free oxygen radicals, which can damage the body, and are therefore commonly found in dietary supplements. But



overly high doses can be harmful.

"There's no need to fear antioxidants in normal food but most people don't need additional amounts of them," Bergo said.

"In fact, it can be harmful for cancer patients and people with an elevated cancer risk."

Prof. Bergo's research group has previously shown that antioxidants like vitamin C and E accelerate the growth and spread of lung cancer by stabilising a protein called BACH1.

BACH1 is activated when the level of free oxygen radicals drops, which happens,

for example, when extra antioxidants are introduced via the diet or when spontaneous mutations in the tumour cells activate endogenous antioxidants.

Now the researchers have been able to show that the activation of BACH1 induces the formation of new blood

vessels (angiogenesis).

While low oxygen levels (hypoxia) are known to be required for angiogenesis to occur in cancer tumours, the new mechanism identified by the researchers demonstrates that tumours can form new blood vessels in the presence of normal oxygen levels as well.

The study also shows that BACH1 is regulated in a similar way as the HIF-1alpha protein - a mechanism that was awarded the 2019 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine and that allows cells to adapt to changes in oxygen levels. HIF-1 alpha and BACH1 work together in the tumours, the new research showed.

"Many clinical trials have evaluated the efficacy of angiogenesis inhibitors, but the results have not been as successful as anticipated," said Ting Wang, doctoral student in Professor Bergo's group at Karolinska Institutet. "Our study opens the door to more effective ways of preventing angiogenesis in tumours, for example, patients whose tumours exhibit high levels of BACH1 might benefit more from anti-angiogenesis therapy than patients with low BACH1 levels."

The researchers used a range of cell-biological methods and concentrated most of

their work on lung cancer tumours by studying organoids - small cultivated micro tumours from patients. But they also studied mice and samples of human breast and kidney tumours.

Tumours in which BACH1 was activated, either via ingested antioxidants or by overexpression of the BACH1 gene, produced more new blood vessels and were highly sensitive to angiogenesis inhibitors. "The next step is to examine in detail how levels of oxygen and free radicals can regulate the BACH1 protein, and we will continue to determine the clinical relevance of our results," Wang said. "We'll also be doing similar studies in other cancer forms such as breast, kidney and skin cancer."
