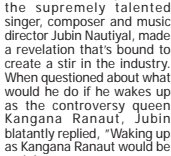

The festivities range from two to three days and are marked with get together, feasting, charity and gift giving. Five crocodiles rescued, 10 spotted as water recedes



VADODARA : Crocodiles are literally keeping wildlife rescuers and forest department on their toes, with some as low as 8ft scarier citizens everywhere. Since Thursday night, at least five crocodiles have been rescued while forest teams have spotted seven more including two each in residential colonies of Navayard and Tarsali and the inundated Sayajibaug Zoo. On Friday morning, slum dwellers in Ganeshnagar woke up to the sight of a six foot long reptile that had crawled on top of a hutment right behind the MS University's boys hostel. 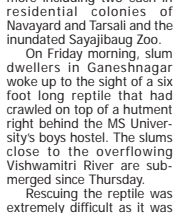

VADODARA: Vishwamitri River once again started swelling rapidly on Friday after water level increased by nearly seven foot within hours as Ajwa Lake began overflowing at about 213 feet due to heavy rain in the catchment area. The civic authorities announced by 2pm that Vishwamitri level would rise and advised citizens to stay away from the river. By then, many offices had already allowed their employees to leave for the day while schools and colleges too sent students home. As a result of people rushing back home, the city roads witnessed heavy traffic late in the afternoon. "As soon as I heard Vishwamitri water level was swelling, I left my workplace and headed home," said Amisha Shah, a resident of New VIP Road. Long queues were seen at milk parlours and vegetable markets as flood-water residents rushed to stock up essentials.

Tata Steel to go slow on capex

Tata Steel will recalibrate its capital expenditure this fiscal by postponing some of its planned expenditure in Europe and splitting expenses in India in phases. TV Narendran, MD and CEO, Tata Steel Ltd. (TSL), said that about 74,000-crore capital expenditure of the 712,000 crore proposed for this fiscal would be recalibrated. "We want to run a cash positive business," he said. The exercise is being done in line with market conditions and lower cash flows. Tata Steel ended the first quarter with higher
