Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Part A of Schedule III of SEBI (LODR) Regulations 2015, it is hereby informed that the Company has received a Direction from National Green Tribunal Southern Zone, Chennai to pay Rs. 5 Crore as no fault liability to be utilised for improvement of the environment & health of the people of the Nagapattinam district, Tamil Nadu.

5	Supplementary information	The oil leak was arrested on 04.03.2023 early in morning. Subsequently, the damaged portion of pipeline was also removed as per directives of the District Administration, Nagapattinam. The Joint Committee constituted by NGT concluded that the quantity of oil leak was less and there was no environmental impact and as such no remedial measure was suggested by the Joint Committee for subject crude oil pipeline. The Joint Committee also concluded that villagers were happy with the action taken by District Administration and CPCL.
6	Impact of financial, operation or other activities of the listed entity, quantifiable in monetary terms to the extent possible	There is no impact on the operation and other activities of the company. However, the financial implication would be limited to Rs. 5 Crore as no fault liability.

The Company is examining the order and appropriate action would be taken in due course.
