Need to give befitting reply to those who insult Sanatan through votes: Rajnath Singh

NEEMUCH: Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Monday said that a befitting reply should be given to those who are insulting 'Sanatan Dharam' adding that the reply should be given through votes and not violence.

Addressing a public rally, Rajnath Singh said, "There is a need to give a befitting reply to those who insult Sanatan Dharam. Give them a reply, not through violence but through votes. These people have made it a drama."

He further praised the governance of Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan in Madhya Pradesh.

"Madhya Pradesh, which was once known as a BIMARU state, has today come out of this category. Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has served the public as a servant. Such sensitive leaders are rare in politics," he said.

"The change that took place in Madhya Pradesh should not stop. In between, you have already seen Kamal Nath ji in the Congress government. They have obstructed the central schemes," he added.

He further mentioned that the financial health of Madhya Pradesh has become better in the last 20 years.

"In the year 2001-02, the GDP of Madhya Pradesh was Rs 71,594 crores. Today in 2023 the GDP of Madhya Pradesh has increased to more than Rs 13,22,000 crores. The per capita

income of Madhya Pradesh which was only Rs 11,718 rupees in 2001-02 has increased ten times to Rs 1,40,000 in 2023," he said.

"What is the biggest need for a poor person after food? The biggest dream of the poor is to have a roof over his family's head. When Kamal Nath was in power, the central government had sanctioned eight lakh houses under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Awas Yojana, but 2 lakh houses were returned," he added.

He also mentioned that Prime Minister Narendra Modi's work has resulted in almost ending the extreme poverty in India today.

"This area is also the land of Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar. Baba Saheb was born here in the nearby Mhow. Baba Saheb wanted every poor, Dalit, deprived and exploited to have the right to live life with dignity. This is what Modiji is doing," he said.

Madhya Pradesh is among the five states where assembly elections are to be held later this year to elect 230 members of the state.

In the 2018 assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh, Congress emerged as the single largest party with 114 seats and BJP got 109 seats.

However, in 2020, the Congress government lost the majority followed by the resignations of some MLAs. After this, the BJP formed the government in the state and Shivraj Singh Chouhan was reinstated as the Chief Minister.

"I'll repeat the same thing again and again": Udhayanidhi Stalin on Sanatana Dharma

THOOTHUKUDI: Unfazed by attacks from various leaders, Tamil Nadu Minister for Youth Welfare and Sports Development Udhayanidhi Stalin on Monday said that he would repeat the same thing again and again as he has included all religions and not just Hindus.

"The day before yesterday I spoke at a function about it (Sanatana Dharma). Whatever I said, I'll repeat the same thing again and again...I included all the religions and not just Hindus...I spoke condemning the caste differences that's all," Udhayanidhi Stalin said.

The Minister's speech triggered a political outrage by the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP).

Earlier on Sunday, Udhayanidhi said, "Sanatana is like malaria and dengue and so it must be eradicated and not opposed."

"I thank the organisers of this conference for giving me the opportunity to deliver a special address. You have kept the name of the confer-

ence as 'Sanatana Abolition Conference' rather than 'Anti-Sanatana Conference', I appreciate that," Udhayanidhi said.

He further said, "Few things cannot be opposed, that should be abolished only. We can't oppose Dengue, Mosquitoes, Malaria, or Corona, we have to eradicate this that's how we have to eradicate Sanatana. Rather opposing Sanatana it should be eradicated."

"The name Sanatana is from Sanskrit. It is against Social Justice and equality," he added.

While clarifying that he had not called for "genocide" he said that "Uprooting Sanatan Dharma is upholding humanity and human equality."

"I never called for the genocide of people who are following Sanatan Dharma. Sanatan Dharma is a principle that divides people in the name of caste and religion. Uprooting Sanatan Dharma is upholding humanity and human equality,"

Udhayanidhi Stalin wrote in a message on X on Saturday night.

Reiterating his statement at the 'Sanatana Abolition Conference', Udhayanidhi Stalin wrote, "I stand firmly by every word I have spoken. I spoke on behalf of the oppressed and marginalized, who suffer due to the Sanatan Dharma."

"I am ready to present the extensive writings of Periyar and Ambedkar, who conducted in-depth research on Sanatan Dharma and its negative impact on society in any forum," he added.

Repeating his point made in his speech, he wrote, "Let me reiterate the crucial aspect of my speech: I believe, like the spread of diseases like COVID-19, Dengue, and Malaria by mosquitoes, that Sanatan Dharma is responsible for many social evils."

"I am prepared to confront any challenges that come my way, whether in a court of law or the people's court. Stop spreading fake news," he added.

NIA court finds two guilty in murder of retired school principal based in Kanpur

NEW DELHI: A special National Investigation Agency (NIA) court in Uttar Pradesh's Lucknow on Monday found two accused guilty of killing a retired school principal belonging to Kanpur in fulfillment and furtherance of the Islamic State of Iraq and Syria (ISIS) agenda by spreading fear and terror among the people.

The Lucknow Special Court held the accused guilty under various sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act and the Arms Act. The quantum of sentence against the accused, Atif Muzaffar and Md Faisal Khan, both residents of Kanpur Nagar in Uttar Pradesh, will be pronounced on September 11.

The victim, Ram Babu Shukla, the Kanpur-based retired principal of Swami Atmaprakash Brahmchari Junior High School in

be disbelievers (Qafirs). A third accused, Mohammad Saifulla, had died in the exchange of fire with Uttar Pradesh's Anti-Terrorist Squad on the night of March 7, 2017.

Investigations by the NIA revealed that the accused were operating under the influence of ISIS, a proscribed terrorist organisation. They had conspired to carry out terrorist activities (Jihad) in India by targeting non-Muslims through violent acts. In furtherance of their conspiracy to promote the ISIS ideology and agenda, they murdered Shukla to strike terror and alarm in the minds of the common people.

The case was initially registered on October 24, 2016, at Chakeri Police Station in Kanpur Nagar. The NIA had taken over the case from Uttar Pradesh Police in November 2017 and re-registered a fresh case.

Congress to campaign in poll-bound Telangana

NEW DELHI: The newly constituted Congress Working Committee (CWC) will hold its first meeting in poll-bound Telangana's Hyderabad on September 16, under the leadership of Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge.

It will be attended by all the CWC members, permanent and special invitees. Disclosing this here today, the Congress general secretary in charge of Organization KC Venugopal and the general secretary in charge of Communications, Jairam Ramesh said, the CWC meeting will be followed by an 'extended CWC' meeting on September 17 which will also be attended by the PCC presidents, office bearers of the Congress Parliamentary Party and the Congress Legislative Party leaders.

The meeting will be followed by a massive public rally in the evening around Hyderabad on the same day. The rally has been organized to coincide with the liberation day of Hyderabad, on September 17. In the rally, the Congress will also announce five guarantees to

the people of the state. After the rally on the same evening, the Congress president will flag off the cavalcades of CWC members, PCC presidents, CLP leaders and others to 119 assembly constituencies of Telangana. All of them will stay overnight in their respective allotted assembly constituencies.

On September 18, the Congress leaders will hold meetings in their allotted segments and go door to door distributing five guarantees to the people and a charge-sheet against the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) government.

However, the MPs have been exempted from the September 18 programme because of the special parliamentary session. To commemorate the first anniversary of the Bharat Jodo Yatra, the Congress has planned 722 'Bharat Jodo Yatras' across the country on September 7. These yatras will be led by the CWC members, the PCC presidents, CLP leaders and other senior leaders, to the statues of Mahatma Gandhi and Dr BR Ambedkar.

SFI demands action against probable ABVP DUSU candidate for barging in Miranda House

NEW DELHI: Students' Federation of India (SFI) on Monday said that immediate action should be taken against the probable Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad (ABVP) Delhi University Students Union (DUSU) candidate Ankita Biswas for allegedly barging in Delhi University's Miranda House College.

In this regard, SFI Delhi shared a video and claimed that probable ABVP candidate Ankita Biswas was jumping over the gates to enter the college for election campaigning.

"SFI Delhi expresses our deepest concern over the forced entry of ABVP lumpens into the Miranda House College. It is the second time that the same event has occurred in the college with ABVP cadres even clambering fences to enter the college premises. The videos coming out show

that a mob including Ankita Biswas - a prospective ABVP DUSU candidate - broke into the campus and created a ruckus, making female students on the campus feel threatened," an official statement issued by SFI said. SFI alleged that ABVP is harassing students in the name of election campaigning in DU.

"From Aditi Mahavidyalaya to Ramanujan, and to Miranda House, the ABVP has followed the same tactic of barging into college premises with non-collegiate local boys and harassing students as part of their DUSU election campaign," Aditi Tyagi, SFI DU leader said.

"SFI Delhi urges the whole of the student community to stand against the wanton display of unrelenting hooliganism in the name of elections!," an official statement said.

BENGALURU: Karnataka Chief Minister Basavaraja Bommai on Monday spoke on the continuing row over Cauvery water sharing and said that the government has failed in managing the distribution of water since the beginning. "The government has failed in Cauvery water management since the beginning. They should have recovered when the rains subsided in the month of June. Water was not released to our farmers in the beginning. They are continuously supplying water to Tamil Nadu. The Tamil Nadu government had asked for 15000 cusecs of water. They are claiming that we have released 5 thousand cusecs of water," Karnataka CM Bommai said. He further said, "The Bekkedatu project has been in demand for centuries."
