# After TN, Kerala moves SC against Governor: 'Complete subversion of Constitution'

KERALA BECAME the third state, after Tamil Nadu and Punjab, to move the Supreme Court Thursday against its Governor over pending Bills and other issues.

The Kerala government has claimed inaction on the part of Governor Arif Mohammed Khan in relation to eight Bills passed by the Assembly, and said many of these involve immense public interest. "Of these, three Bills have remained pending with the Governor for more than two years, and three more in excess of a full year. The conduct of the Governor... threatens to defeat and subvert the very fundamentals and basic foundations of our Constitution, including the rule of law and democratic good governance, apart from defeating the rights of the people of the state to the welfare measures sought to be implemented through the Bills," the Kerala government's plea says.

It adds that under Article 200 of the Constitution, it is the solemn duty of the Governor to "declare either that he assents to the Bill or that he withholds as-

"The Governor appears to be of the view that granting assent or otherwise dealing with Bills is a matter entrusted to him in his absolute discretion... This is a complete subversion of the Constitution," the Kerala government has said.

Kerala Law Minister P Rajeev said that even the Supreme Court had said that the Bills passed by state Assemblies should not be withheld indefinitely, and said Khan was "not discharging his constitutional duties".

Khan, who has had a running battle with the LDF government in the state, has contended that he has withheld assent to some Bills as his queries regarding them were yet to be addressed. Like Kerala and Khan, the Tamil Nadu and Punjab governments have also had several disputes with their Governors R N Ravi and Banwarilal Purohit, respectively. In its plea, the DMK government in Tamil Nadu has said that Governor Ravi has "positioned himself as a political rival to the legitimately elected"

Tamil Nadu regime, and that a Governor's actions should reflect "the satisfaction of the Council of Ministers".

A constitutional authority is "consistently acting in an unconstitutional manner, impeding and obstructing" the functioning of the state government "for extraneous reasons", the state's plea says, adding that the delays in legislation and crucial appointments were leading to "a constitutional deadlock".

The Tamil Nadu petition also refers to Article 200 apart from 163, to say that the Governor has limited scope for action once a Bill is passed by an Assembly, and that "any delay or refusal" effectively disrupts parliamentary democracy. It mentions 12 Bills as pending with Ravi, apart from the delay in approving the transfer of investigation to the CBI in cases involving high-profile politicians.

The oldest legislation pending with the Governor dates back to 2020 and include a Bill to confer on the government the power of inspection and inquiry instead of the Chancellor (Governor) and another Bill to include a government nominee in the panel for selection of some vice-chancellors, says the government. Many of the pending Bills, in fact, similarly involve a shift in administrative authority from the governor to the state government.

## BSY: Will put pressure on BJP high command to appoint Opp leader

BJP LEADER B S Yediyurappa on Thursday acknowledged that there is a delay in naming the leader of opposition in the Karnataka Assembly and the new state party president, and said he would make efforts to exert pressure on the party high command to take these appointments.

The BJP, which is the principal opposition party in the state, has not yet appointed its legislature party leader who will also play the role of the leader of opposition in the Assembly. The previous Assembly session in July was held without a leader of opposition.

The BJP is facing intense criticism from the ruling Congress for its inability to make an appointment to the post. Responding to questions on speculation that BJP legislators have threatened to boycott the next Assembly session unless a leader of opposition is appointed, Yediyurappa said, "I have requested them (BJP high command) to take a decision at the earliest." Before the Winter Session of the Assembly in December, appointments to the posts will likely be made, the BJP Parliamentary Panel member said. Speaking at a press conference, Yediyurappa also said that a leadership tussle is going on between Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah and his deputy DK Shivakumar.

The BJP leader said the Congress government in the state is struggling to fulfil its pre-poll promises, and all development activities in the state have come to a standstill. "The fight for leadership between Siddaramaiah and D K Shivakumar faction has reached its peak," he said, adding that to keep the Deputy Chief Minister in check, "dinner meetings have started in the party".

The "dinner meeting" was in reference to a dinner hosted by Karnataka Home Minister G Parameshwara, which Siddaramaiah and Public Works Department Minister Satish Jarkiholi had reportedly attended.

## WIND SPEED LOW, VISIBILITY DIPS

# AQI hits severe, Capital chokes on cocktail of smoke and dust

FOR THE first time this season, Delhi's air quality plummeted to hit the 'severe' category on Thursday. A cocktail of factors — low wind speed and intrusion of smoke from stubble burning — added to the impact of local emissions.

The air quality had consistently worsened through the day, from what was an average of 351 at 10 am to touch 402 at 5 pm. Pollutants suspended in the air gave the city a sepia tint on Thursday, keeping visibility poor all day.

Kuldeep Srivastava, scientist at the India Meteorological Department (IMD), said visibility at 7 am at the Safdarjung weather station was 500 m, with shallow fog. It had only improved marginally to around 700 m at 2.30 pm. At Palam, visibility remained around 1,000 m from 7 am to 3 pm.

Since fog is formed when water vapour condenses and relative humidity was high in the morning hours, shallow fog may have formed, Srivastava said.

But humidity levels had fallen to around 55% in the afternoon. "Calm conditions are prevailing. At Palam, winds were from the northwest; at Safdarjung, there were easterly winds. The speed was just 2 to 3

kmph at both stations," Srivastava said.

Gufan Beig, founder project director SAFAR, and chair professor, National Institute of Advanced Studies, said, "The contribution of stubble burning is high with a high fire count. Weather conditions have also become favourable for accumulation of pollutants. Low visibility is on account of the intrusion

of particles. Winds are calm even at a height of half a kilometre from the ground, and that is resulting in the suspension of particles and low visibility. Slower winds prevail with lower temperatures. From around this time of the year, wind direction changes and becomes north-northwest. The temperature is not that low, but the major factors now are the transport level

wind direction and speed that is bringing pollutants into Delhi — stubble-related emissions travel at half a kilometre to one kilometre above the surface."

Wind speed of 10 to 12 kmph can help disperse pollutants, and when the wind direction is from opposite sides, that can also result in pollutants not dispersing and getting accumulated in the city, officials said.

## 2 SC men 'stripped, urinated on, robbed' in TN; 6 held

TWO SCHEDULED Caste (SC) men were allegedly stripped, urinated upon and robbed by a gang in Tamil Nadu's Tirunelveli district, prompting the police to arrest six people in connection with the incident.

According to the police, the two men, aged around 21 and 19,

had gone to take a bath around 7.30 pm on October 30 at a riverbed near Manimoortheeswarar. The robbers, who were allegedly intoxicated, intercepted them, threatened them with knives and other sharp weapons and asked for money, they said.

The police said when the men told the gang they did not have any money, the goons attacked them and then called a relative

and asked the person to transfer Rs 5,000 via digital payment. The gang did not let them go and questioned the men about their caste and background.

The young men told them that they belonged to a Scheduled Caste following which the gang, allegedly from a dominant caste, beat them up and later made them strip and passed urine on them, the police said. The victims alleged the gang

had also snatched their phones and jewellery and kept them in confinement till 1 am. On Tuesday, the police arrested six people — Ponmani (25), Nallamuthu (21), Aayiram (19), Ramar (22), Siva (22) and Lakshmanan (20). They were booked under sections of the Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act and other relevant sections of the IPC for robbery.

## Govt to depute monitors at national level to oversee implementation pf livestock schemes'

THE CENTRE has decided to deploy National Level Monitors (NLM) to oversee the implementation of its livestock schemes including National Livestock Mission and Rashtriya Gokul Mission. Speaking to *The Indian Express*, Alka Upadhyaya, Secretary, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, said, "A scheme for NLMs has been approved. The department has begun the process of empaneling the NLMs which will take between one and one and a-half months."

Apart from the National Livestock Mission and Rashtriya Gokul Mission, the Department of Animal Husbandry also implements the National Programme for Dairy Development and Livestock Health and Disease Control programme. These programmes will also be monitored by the NLMs. As per the appointment terms of reference for NLMs, two types of monitoring will be conducted by them — regular and special.

At present, the department monitors the schemes' implementation through "monthly, quarterly and yearly progress reports, management information system, regional review meetings and video conferencing session with participating states." The Centre's focus on monitoring the implementation of its schemes in the Animal Husbandry and Dairying sector is significant given this sector's rising contribution to the economy. The department has now decided to involve the NLMs to ensure its schemes' monitoring is "unbiased and objective".

The NLMs will be third-party independent monitors — individuals and institutions deployed by the government. Individual NLMs will be selected from among retired Civil/Defence Services Officers, and academia. Earlier, the Ministry of Rural Development had deployed NLMs to monitor their schemes. Recently, the NLM teams flagged irregularities in the implementation of the NREGS and PMAY-G schemes across several states.

Ministry and if prescribed implementation processes are being followed. This monitoring will also determine villagers' views on the programmes, consider their suggestions for improvement and whether selection of beneficiaries under a programme has been transparent, unbiased and fair.

The terms of reference also stated that the monitoring will determine if incentives to paravets/technicians/ farmers have been distributed as envisaged under the scheme and whether data generated on vaccination, disease monitoring and artificial insemination has been uploaded on the National Digital Livestock Mission on a real time basis.

"In case of complaints of a serious nature from people's representatives, farmers etc. regarding the misutilisation of funds, irregularities, etc., NLMs are proposed to be deputed to verify facts or for a preliminary enquiry with the approval of the Secretary," stated the terms of reference.

As per these terms, the objectives of this monitoring include ascertaining whether the programmes of the Ministry are implemented according to guidelines prescribed by the
