Asking officials to improve the recovery rate of Covid-19 patients, Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath said that sample testing of elderly people, children, pregnant women, sick and weak persons be carried out on a priority.



that treatment was not affected for want of medicines.

Chairing a meeting at his official residence in Lucknow on Tuesday, Yogi said that in order to control Corona spread, it was extremely important to ramp up sample testing for the infection. The Chief Minister stressed that one lakh tests should be done daily by Rapid Antigen method, 40,000-45,000 by RTPCR method and 2,500 to 3,000 by TruNAT machines.

Yogi said that Director General of Medical Health and DG of Medical Education should ensure adequate arrangements in hospitals and medical colleges as per Covid protocol.

"For this, both officers are required to do micro-analysis. DGs of Medical Health and Medical Education should ensure regular communication with every CMO and Principal of Medical Colleges respectively," he said.

The Chief Minister said that Covid hospitals must have adequate availability of oxygen with 48-hour backup. He said that specialist doctors should be available in L-2 hospitals and asked officials to ensure proper supply of medicines in Covid and Non-Covid hospitals so

Hike in scholarships for children of ex-servicemen

The Uttar Pradesh government on Tuesday hiked educational scholarship for the children of ex-servicemen, financial assistance to the martyrs' family and doubled financial assistance for marriage of daughters of deceased ex-servicemen.

The decision was taken at a management committee meeting of Uttar Pradesh Sainik Punarvas Nidhi here on Tuesday which was chaired by state Governor Anandiben Patel.

According to the decision, the annual education scholarship for the children of ex-servicemen will now be ₹ 5,000, an increase of ₹ 2,000 for students of standard 9th and 10th, ₹ 6,000 for students of standard 11th and 12th, which was earlier ₹ 4,000 and an increase of ₹ 2,000 from ₹ 5,000 to ₹ 7,000 for graduate students.

Similarly, scholarship for PG students has gone up to ₹ 9,000 from ₹ 6,000.

Besides students doing technical courses up to intermediate level will get ₹ 10,000 annually from the existing ₹ 7,000 while for the technical students of graduate and post graduate level it will be ₹ 25,000 from the existing ₹ 15,000.

The meeting further decided that dependents of martyred soldiers would be given ₹ 50,000 for purchasing any equipment and training for any technical trade.

The financial assistance for marriage of daughters of expired ex-servicemen has been doubled to ₹ 1 lakh from the existing ₹ 50,000.

The governor has also directed the agriculture department to identify 1,342 acres of land in Atari area near the state capital so that earning from farming could be substantial increased. The Governor was not pleased with the earning of ₹ 9.69 lakh from this agriculture land of the ex-servicemen welfare fund.

Funds continue to pour in for Ram temple

Notwithstanding the current economic slowdown, a large amount of cash, gold and silver contributions for construction of Ram temple in Ayodhya are continuously pouring in.

A senior trustee of the Shri Ramjanma Bhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust said that it has already received over ₹ 27 crore besides a huge quantity of gold and silver bricks for the foundation laying ceremony of the temple to be presided by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on August 5.

On Tuesday, Ram Kathavachak (story teller) Murari Babu donated ₹ 5 crore to Trust for Ram Temple construction. The donation was given by Vyas Peeth run by Murari Babu.

On Tuesday the Shri Ramjanma Bhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust issued an appeal asking devotees not to donate gold and silver, which they claim to have received in huge quantity.

"We need cash for construction of the Ram temple and silver and gold will not serve the purpose," Trust general secretary Champat Rai said.

He said that people are donating silver bricks in large numbers with an appeal that it should be used in laying the foundation stone. I appeal to the people to deposit cash in our bank account instead of donating silver bricks," Rai said.

Besides, there is a huge stock of gold and silver jewellery of Ram Lalla which the Temple got in the last many years. The Trust also received several kgs of gold and silver from the receiver and Rs 11 crore which were donated by the devotees since December 6, 1992.

According to available figures, even during lockdown the Trust received online donations of ₹ 6 crore.

Trust chairman Mahant Nritya Gopal Das too donated 5 silver shilas while UP chief minister Yogi Adityanath had donated ₹ 11 lakh on March 25 last when the idols were shifted to a makeshift temple. Several

Court records statements of accused in Ayodhya trial

The special CBI court on Tuesday completed recording of statements of the accused in the trial over the demolition of the Babri mosque structure in Ayodhya on December 6, 1992.

A total of 31 out of the 32 accused recorded their statements, including former Deputy PM Lal Krishna Advani, former union minister Dr Murlu Manohar Joshi and former UP Chief Minister Kalyan Singh.

On Tuesday, CBI special judge SK Yadav recorded the statement of 31st accused Satish Pradhan through video conferencing. However one of the accused, Om Prakash Pandey, is absconding, as he has turned a sadhu and his whereabouts were not known.

The court has given time till July 30 to the defence counsels to submit their written arguments in the court.

As per the Supreme court direction, the special court could give its verdict in the 28-year-old case by August 31 next.

However, all the accused have pleaded innocence and claimed they were politically implicated in the conspiracy.

All statements of the accused were recorded under section 313 of the CrPc in the court of Special CBI judge SK Yadav.

Opp collar govt over law, order

Lucknow (PNS): Armed with the tragic incident of a 14-year-old boy being kidnapped and murdered in Gorakhpur, Opposition parties took on the Yogi government over deteriorating law and order in the state and alleged that criminals were ruling the state.

Bahujan Samaj Party chief Mayawati said that if the government wanted to improve the situation, the CM should take a cue from former regimes of the BSP without hesitation. She reminded that during her four regimes as Chief Ministers, the law and order was stable.

Congress honcho Priyanka Gandhi Vadra tweeted, "Has the UP CM stopped watching news? Do these reports not go before the people sitting in Home Department? Every day new records of goondaraj are being set in UP. The kidnapping incident has occurred in CM's hometown."

Expressing concern over the alarming law and order situation, Priyanka shot off a letter to Yogi Adityanath on Tuesday asking him to look into the issue seriously. She stated that as the CM, Yogi must be knowing about the incidents of Kanpur, Gonda and Gorakhpur.

"I would like to draw your attention to the pain of a Ghaziabad family, to whom I have spoken," she said. The Congress leader stated that Ghaziabad trader Vikram Tyagi was missing for nearly a month and his family feared that he has been kidnapped. Despite repeated pleas, nothing concrete was being done by the police and district administration. She also wrote that two days back, a Congress delegation met his family who were very upset. Through the letter, Priyanka requested the Chief Minister to help the family and asked him to instruct the police to extend all support to the aggrieved family.

Meanwhile, Samajwadi Party chief Akhilesh Yadav also attacked Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath through a tweet, "The news of the murder of kidnapped child from Gorakhpur is very painful and sad. Condolences to the bereaved family. Despite constant kidnappings and murders, the shameless silence and inaction of the BJP government are under question."

Priyanka, Mayawati lock horns over Rajasthan

Bahujan Samaj Party chief Mayawati and Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi locked horns over the ongoing power tussle in Rajasthan.

After issuing a whip to party MLAs in Rajasthan two days back, Mayawati threatened to move Supreme Court if the whip was not followed, and lashed out at CM Ashok Gehlot for his 'malicious intent'.

On her part, Priyanka fired back terming the former UP CM as an unofficial spokesperson of the BJP and her move as murder of democracy and Constitution.

Addressing the media on Tuesday, Mayawati said that after Rajasthan election results, the BSP gave unconditional support of all six MLAs to Congress but Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot aiming to damage the BSP and merged the legislators with Congress 'unconstitutionally'. The BSP chief said that her party was looking for an opportune time to go to the court and to teach Congress a lesson.

Congress itself engaged in an act which they are now calling 'theft'. They had earlier taken away six BSP MLAs. It's unconstitutional, immoral and against the people's mandate. They're now crying foul when its 'stolen assets' are being stolen. It is like 'ulta chor



kotwal ko daante," she added.

Mayawati warned the six BSP MLAs in Rajasthan saying if they vote for the Congress in any proceedings during Rajasthan Assembly session, their membership would be cancelled. This comes after Rajasthan's BSP MLA Lakhman Singh said that he and his five party colleagues did not get any notice from the BSP over voting against Congress and reiterated their support to the ruling party.

On Sunday, the BSP had issued a whip to its six MLAs instructing them to vote against the Congress in the event of a 'No Confidence Motion' or any other proceedings in Rajasthan Assembly session. In September 2019, all six BSP MLAs merged with the Congress, which has not been recognised by the BSP.



Reacting to Mayawati's attack, Priyanka on Tuesday took a veiled dig at the BSP, alleging that the whip issued by it to its MLAs in Rajasthan was a clean chit to those who 'murdered' democracy and Indian Constitution.

"Undeclared spokespersons of the BJP have issued a whip in support of the BJP. But, this is not a whip but a clean chit to those who murder democracy and the Constitution," she said in a tweet in Hindi.

On several occasions earlier, Priyanka termed Mayawati the BJP's spokesperson.

During the war of words between Congress and UP government over issues during lockdown, especially on providing buses for migrants, Mayawati had supported Yogi's stand and criticised Congress.

Cane department clerk held

Lucknow (PNS): The Uttar Pradesh government, on Tuesday, suspended a clerk in the accounts department of the District Cane office in Meerut for embezzlement of over ₹ 2 crore. The accused, Naresh Kumar Sharma, has been arrested and sent to jail. Additional Chief secretary Cane Development Sanjay Bhoosreddy said that during investigations it was found that Sharma had transferred more than ₹ 2 crore of government money into his relatives' accounts by using fraudulent means.

Bhoosreddy said that an FIR has been lodged in the police station concerned under sections 420, 120-B, 467, 468, 471 and 477-A of Indian Penal Code 1860 and Sharma has been sent to jail. The police have recovered ₹ 23 lakh from Sharma.

Stopped on the tracks, revellers attack cops

Lucknow (PNS): Trying to prevent playing loud music at a crowded function during prohibitory hours late into Monday evening, proved costly for Gorakhpur Police personnel, when frenzied revellers attacked them forcing the cops to lock themselves up in the outpost

to escape their wrath. Later, additional police force was rushed to the area, the miscreants were chased and a dozen trouble makers were arrested.

As per reports, Kori police outpost in-charge, KK Singh was on routine patrolling on Monday night when he found a DJ playing music in high volume in the house of Ram Chander. On enquiry, the cop was informed that the revelry was over a 'mundani' ceremony.

Singh reminded the family that playing DJ was not allowed after 10 pm and organising night party sans permission during prohibitory hours without social distancing protocol was illegal and asked them to wind up the function.

However, an hour later, Singh again noticed that high-decibel music was being played. He again called the organiser and took him to the police outpost to initiate legal action.

Soon, a dozen guests reached there, started abusing the cops demanding his immediate release. When Singh refused, a large crowd converged there and forcibly released the accused and stone pelted the police personnel, who locked themselves up in outpost from inside. Apprehending that the outpost could be torched by the irate mob, the cops slipped through a rear door and informed the SHO of Belghat police station, BB Rajbhar. Later, senior officers along with heavy police force reached the spot and nabbed a dozen miscreants.

A case was lodged in this connection naming 12 persons and 50 unidentified persons and they were booked for attacking police officials, damaging government property, violation of lockdown, and 7 Criminal Law Amendment Act.
