

SAMJHAUTA BLAST
Pak woman challenges acquittal of Aseemanand, three others

A PAKISTANI national, the daughter of one of the 68 people killed in the 2007 Samjhauta Express blast, on Friday filed an appeal before the Punjab and Haryana High Court challenging the acquittal of Swami Aseemanand and the other accused in the case.

Hafizabad resident Rahila Wakil, whose father Muhammad Wakil was killed in the blast, filed the appeal through a relative based in Uttar Pradesh. However, the plea has not been cleared by the High Court Registry yet for hearing due to certain technical objections.

"We have filed the appeal and it will soon come up for hearing," said advocate Momin Malik, who represents Wakil. Haryana Police, NIA and the Centre have been included as respondents in the case besides the accused, who stand acquitted at present.

Twelve years after the blast, a special NIA court in Panchkula on March 20 had acquitted Aseemanand, Lokesh Sharma, Kamal Chauhan and Rajinder Chaudhary. The court had observed that a "dastardly act of violence" remains unpunished for want of credible and admissible evidence. Neither the NIA, nor the Centre has filed any appeal in the case.

Pertinently, hours before the verdict, NIA special judge Jagdeep Singh had dismissed the plea filed by Wakil for the examination of several eyewitnesses from her country. The court had said it was apparent that the application "is nothing but an effort to seek publicity" and "an effort to get the matter prolonged..."

Scarlett death case: One sentenced to 10 yrs in jail

THE BOMBAY High Court on Friday awarded ten years rigorous imprisonment to convict Samson D'Souza a day after he was found guilty of culpable homicide, drugging and sexually assaulting British teenager Scarlett Keeling at Goa's Anjuna beach in February 2008.

D'Souza and Placido Carvalho were both accused of the crime and an eight-year-long trial in a Goa Children's Court had culminated with both of them being acquitted.

On Wednesday, a bench of Justices R D Dhanuka and Prithviraj Chavan overturned the trial court order acquitting D'Souza and convicted him under sections 328 (causing hurt by means of poison), 354 (Assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty), 304 (ii) (culpable homicide not amounting to murder), 201 (destruction of evidence) of Indian

Penal Code and Section 8(II) (grave sexual assault) of Goa Children's Act. The HC however, upheld the acquittal of Carvalho. D'Souza broke down after the sentencing and applied for time to surrender and to appeal before the Supreme Court, which was objected to by the prosecution and rejected by the court.

During the trial, his lawyer, Shaileendra Bhohe, pushed for leniency saying his client was the sole earning member of his family and that he had already served a six-and-a-half months in prison, during the course of the investigation. Bhohe added that his client had, "no other criminal record in the past or in the eleven years the trial was in progress or any other blemishes in his record". Bhohe also pleaded that the bench take the case as a "matter of commission" claiming that D'Souza's "nature of crime was not harsh or gruesome or cruel".

At this point, Justice Chavan said, "that part is over. Please only tell us the part where the quan-

tum of sentence is to be decided."

Prosecution lawyer Ejaz Khan, in turn, said, "D'Souza was a waiter then. When he saw the young girl in such a state, he should have acted as an adult. Instead, the accused gave her drugs, morphine and liquor, and left her to die without informing anyone. He did not co-operate during the time of investigation. His conduct reflects his mindset. Under Section 8(II) we are asking for life imprisonment as it involves a child, and his act of sexually assaulting is grave..."

Lawyer Vikram Verma, who represented Scarlett's mother Fiona, was allowed to speak at this point despite the defence lawyer's objections. "The world over child abuse and paedophilia is taken very seriously," he told the bench. "In this case, reform is not possible," he reiterated.

After the judgment was pronounced, Fiona, speaking to a section of reporters said she was happy with the punishment but hoped "he stays inside for that long", said a BBC report.

Monsoon covers entire country four days late, to make comeback by July 25

THE SOUTHWEST Monsoon covered the entire country on Friday, four days after its normal date of July 15, according to a statement from the Indian Meteorological Department (IMD).

Over the past week, rainfall has been concentrated near the Himalayan foothills, lashing the eastern and northeastern portions of the country. On the other hand, the central and southern regions have experienced very little rainfall so far. As a result, the overall rainfall for the season in the country so far has remained 18 per cent below normal, as on

KERALA ON RED ALERT; FISHERMEN 'MISSING'

Thiruvananthapuram: With the Southwest monsoon gathering strength in Kerala since Thursday, the Met department on Friday sounded a red alert in several districts for the next four days. Seven fishermen in South Kerala, who ventured into the sea on Wednesday, are reportedly missing. **ENS**

July 19. The presence of Cyclone Vayu impeded the movement of the monsoon this year causing a delay of two to three weeks be-

fore it hit Central India, according to the IMD. In turn, the window for kharif crop sowing in states like Kerala, Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh drastically shortened.

"Due to this, the June rainfall ended remaining a 33 per cent deficit. But, the rainfall improved in July. Till July 19, the month's rainfall stands 3 per cent short of normal," the statement said.

According to officials at IMD, there may be a revival in the monsoon after July 25. Kerala and other places along the west coast have been placed on 'red alert' for the next three to four days, they said.

"During the last few days, the

monsoon has shifted towards and has remained active along the foothills of the Himalayas. But, with a low pressure system likely to form in the Bay of Bengal and other atmospheric conditions building up, monsoon revival is expected around July 25," DS Pai, Head of Climate Research and Services at IMD, Pune, told The Indian Express.

A conducive situation for a revival is also being delayed because the El Nino has not completely waned yet, officials noted.

El Nino is an abnormal warming along the equator at the Pacific Ocean and is known to suppress the Indian summer monsoon.

दिल्ली-मुंबई और दिल्ली-हावड़ा मार्ग पर बढ़ेगी ट्रेनों की रफ्तार

नई दिल्ली, 19 जुलाई।

दिल्ली-मुंबई व दिल्ली-हावड़ा कॉरिडोर पर ट्रेनों की रफ्तार और तेज होगी। रेल मंत्रालय ने कॉरिडोर पर औसतन 40 किलोमीटर की रफ्तार सुनिश्चित करने के लिए नए प्रावधान किए हैं। इसकी मदद से देश की राजधानी व शताब्दी समेत प्रीमियम ट्रेनों की सुविधा व रफ्तार बढ़ाने पर काम किया जा रहा है। मंत्रालय के मुताबिक इसके लिए कॉरिडोर पर छोटे-छोटे बदलाव किए गए हैं और कई अन्य अहम कॉरिडोर पर इसकी प्रक्रिया चल रही है।

इन ट्रेनों पर करीब 120 किलोमीटर प्रति घंटा की रफ्तार से ट्रेनों चलती थीं। नए प्रावधानों से इस रफ्तार को 160 किलोमीटर

प्रति घंटा तक लाया गया है। रफ्तार के लिए रेल मंत्रालय ने ऑटोमैटिक ट्रेन प्रोटेक्शन सिस्टम (एटीपी) लागू किया है। इसकी मदद से लोको पायलट के सामने एक स्क्रीन पर ट्रेन के संचालन की जानकारी आती रहती है।

● 120 किलोमीटर प्रति घंटा की रफ्तार से चलने वाली ट्रेनों की रफ्तार हो जाएगी 160 किलोमीटर

जिसकी मदद से रात में भी रेल का बेहतर संचालन संभव हो सका है। ऐसे ही व्यवस्था अन्य कॉरिडोर पर भी लागू होगी। इस व्यवस्था की मदद से रेल ट्रेक पर बेहतर निगरानी संभव हो सकती है। मंत्रालय के मुताबिक ट्रेन प्रोटेक्शन एंड वार्निंग सिस्टम को यूरोपीय तकनीक से विकसित किया गया है।

इसकी वजह से रेलवे तकनीक को बढ़ावा मिला है और यात्रियों की सुविधाएं आसान हुई हैं।

इसी प्रकार लिंगमपल्ली-वादी स्टेशन के बीच एक ऑटो मैटिक ट्रेन प्रोटेक्शन सिस्टम (टीसीपी) विकसित किया जा रहा है। यह 250 किलोमीटर लंबा रूट है और यातायात का अधिक दबाव है। इस कॉरिडोर को 110 किलोमीटर प्रति घंटा की रफ्तार के लिए तैयार किया जा रहा है। इसके अतिरिक्त रफ्तार तेज करने के लिए यात्रियों के लिए नए कोच उपलब्ध कराए जा रहे हैं।

मंत्रालय के मुताबिक अभी राजधानी व शताब्दी ट्रेनों अधिकतम रफ्तार पर चल रही हैं। इनके अतिरिक्त अब अन्य ट्रेन सेवाओं के लिए भी सुधार किए जा रहे हैं। इसके लिए लगातार रेल नेटवर्क पर कार्य किए जा रहे हैं।
