Zika virus detected in mosquito species in Karnataka's Chikkaballapura dist

BENGALURU, NOV 2 /--/ Zika virus has been detected in a mosquito species in Chikkaballapura district of Karnataka following which blood samples of people with high fever have been sent to the National Institute of Virology (NIV) for examination, officials said on Thursday.

The virus was detected in *Aedes aegypti* mosquitoes after samples from six waterbodies in Chikkaballapura were collected and sent for examination in August last week, they said. Following confirmation of the presence of Zika virus in the mosquito samples collected from Talakayalabetta in the district, an alert was issued in a five kilometre radius of the area as a precautionary measure to contain the breeding. The officials stressed that the virus has been detected only in mosquito samples collected from the Talakayalabetta waterbody and no cases have been detected in people yet. Karnataka Health Minister Dinesh Gundu Rao said no person has been tested positive for Zika virus. "The virus has been detected in a mosquito pool. This report came 10 days ago. Don't be afraid of Zika virus," he said.

"We will be monitoring the situation. A few people were showing some symptoms of fever and rashes. They have been kept in the hospital and checked. Their samples have

been sent. Some of them have also been discharged from the hospital. They are okay," he said. "We will be looking into it. We are taking preventive measures. Our people are on the job. The only precaution we need to take is on pregnant women where it might affect the child. So far, nothing of that sort is there. I request people not to panic. Our department is fully looking into it. Hopefully, there will be no breakout of it anywhere," he told PTI videos.

State Health Commissioner D Randeep told PTI, "Zika virus was found in a mosquito pool in Chikkaballapura and not in any humans as of now. Samples of three patients with fever have been sent for testing to the National Institute of Virology. These patients are doing fine." Chikkaballapura District Health Officer Dr Mahesh Kumar said mosquito samples were collected from six sites by the entomologist team of the state government in August last week and "we received the reports on October 25". According to reports, mosquito samples collected from five sites tested negative but those collected from the Talakayalabetta waterbody in Shidlaghatta taluk were found to be positive for Zika virus.

"Since the day we received reports, an alert was issued in the five-kilometre radius of Talakayalabetta.

We have taken all preventive measures at the field level. We formed 53 teams. Each team has two members who have been surveying 888 houses surrounding the five km radius of that area. We have been getting screenings done regularly," he told PTI. As a precautionary measure, blood samples of 33 patients have been sent to the NIV here. Twenty nine of them are antenatal cases and four samples are of patients with high fever. "We are waiting for the results, which are expected to come in another 10 days," he added.

"Samples are being collected regularly. All these patients whose blood samples have been sent are doing fine. Only one patient with a fever had to be admitted to the district hospital here but the patient has been discharged," Kumar said. According to health officials, all precautionary measures have been taken to control the mosquito breeding around houses. Health awareness is being created; people have been made to understand the importance of maintaining cleanliness and hygiene in and around houses. Mosquito fogging is being done near the area where the Zika virus was detected and the revenue department has also been urged to cooperate with the health department and take necessary action to contain further spread of the virus. Naxals kill villager in Chhattisgarh, warn election officials not to visit polling booths

BIJAPUR, NOV 2 /--/ Naxalites have killed a 40-year-old man in poll-bound Chhattisgarh, accusing him of being a police informer, and warned election officials not to visit polling booths to conduct voting on November 7, an official said on Thursday. As per preliminary information, Naxalites strangled the man, Muchaki Linga, with a rope on the intervening night of Wednesday and Thursday and threw his body on the roadside between Galgam and Nadpalli villages in Bijapur district, he said.

They accused Linga, who was from Galgam, of acting as a police informer, he said, adding that security forces have launched a combing operation in the region to trace the Naxals. In another incident, a press note carrying a warning for polling officials, apparently issued by the West Bastar Division Committee of the outlawed CPI (Maist), surfaced in the district on Wednesday.

"Polling is going to be held in the area (Bijapur) on November 7 and you (poll officials and employees) are preparing for it. The West Bastar Division Committee has already issued a statement giving a call to boycott the false elections.

"Bijapur has 245 polling booths and you will be coming with EVMs on November 6-7. You will be accompanied by security forces which poses a threat to your lives.

Therefore, we appeal to you, keeping your safety in mind, that you should not come," the press note said. Bijapur is among the 20 assembly constituencies that will go to polls in the first phase of two-phased state assembly elections on November 7. Polling for the remaining 70 of the total 90 seats will be held in the second phase on November 17. (PTI)

Telangana BJP chief Kishan Reddy not to contest Assembly polls

HYDERABAD, NOV 2 /--/ Two BJP parliament members G Kishan Reddy and K Laxman who earlier unsuccessfully contested for Telangana Assembly have been kept aside for the November 30 polls, according to the list of 35 candidates announced by the saffron party on Thursday.

The BJP has fielded Lankala Deepak Reddy against cricketer Mohammad Azharuddin (Congress) in Jubilee Hills constituency. With the fresh list, the BJP has so far released 88 names for the polls of the state assembly which has 119 seats.

Telangana BJP chief Kishan Reddy, a Lok Sabha member from Secunderabad, contested from Amberpet in the 2018 polls and lost to BRS sitting

MLA K Venkatesh, while Laxman was defeated in Musheerabad segment by his BRS rival M Gopal. Laxman was nominated to Rajya Sabha from Uttar Pradesh last year. A senior BJP leader told PTI that names for some of the seats have not been announced, keeping in view of the ongoing talks with Pawan Kalyan-led Janasena party. The party sources said Janasena would be offered six to seven seats in districts bordering Andhra Pradesh.

CKrishna Yadav, former minister in undivided Andhra Pradesh, is being nominated for the Amberpet segment, while Poosa Raju will contest from Musheerabad. Actor and former minister Babu Mohan and senior leader Marri Shahshidhar Reddy's names also figured in the

list. The party also nominated trade union leader Ashwathama Reddy. This is the third list of BJP candidates. The first list with 52 and the second list with just one name were released by the party earlier. Three Lok Sabha MPs, including its former Telangana president Bandi Sanjay Kumar, figured in the BJP's first list of 52 candidates. The BJP has also given ticket to its firebrand Hindutva leader T Raja Singh from his Goshamahal seat after revoking his suspension, effected last year for alleged insulting remarks towards Prophet Mohammad. Its election committee head Etela Rajender has been fielded from Huzurabad, a seat the former BRS leader represents in the outgoing assembly. (PTI)

ED officer arrested in Jaipur by Rajasthan Anti-Corruption Bureau

JAIPUR, NOV 2 /--/ The Rajasthan Anti-Corruption Bureau on Thursday arrested an Enforcement Directorate officer, posted in Manipur, and his associate here for allegedly taking a bribe of Rs 15 lakh for settling a matter related to a chit fund case, officials said. Those arrested are Naval Kishore Meena, an enforcement officer in the federal probe agency and resident of Vimalpura in Jaipur district, and Babul Meena, a junior assistant in the Mundawar Sub Registrar Office in the newly formed Kotpuli-Behror district of

Rajasthan, the bureau said in a statement. Sources in the Enforcement Directorate (ED) said that the agency will initiate a probe after lodging a criminal case of money laundering against the officer. Naval Kishore had allegedly demanded Rs 17 lakh in lieu of settling a case lodged in the ED office in Manipur capital Imphal against the complainant in

the chit fund matter, the bureau said and added that he is posted at the ED's sub-zonal office in Imphal. The complainant had informed the bureau that a bribe of Rs 17 lakh was allegedly demanded by Naval Kishore for settling the case registered against him in the office of the ED in Imphal, the statement said. HC asks Centre, Delhi govt to respond to plea to include ayurveda, yoga in Ayushman Bharat

NEW DELHI, NOV 2 /--/ The Delhi High Court Thursday sought the response of the Centre and Delhi government on a plea seeking inclusion of ayurveda, yoga and naturopathy in Ayushman Bharat, the national public health insurance scheme.

A bench of Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma and Justice Tushar Rao Gedela issued notices to the union ministries of Health and Family Welfare, Ayush, Finance and Home Affairs besides the Delhi government and asked them to file their counter affidavits within eight weeks. The bench listed the matter for further hearing on January 29. The petition sought inclusion of ayurveda, yoga and naturopathy in the National Health Protection Mission, Pradhan Mantri

Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY), also known as Ayushman Bharat, to secure the citizens' right to health.

Ayushman Bharat, which was launched in 2018, has two main components PM-JAY and the Health and Wellness Centres. Under PM-JAY, health insurance coverage of Rs 5 lakh per family per year is provided to over 12 crore poor and vulnerable families (approximately 55 crore beneficiaries), according to the National Health Authority website. The petitioner, advocate Ashwini Kumar Upadhyay, said the central government, in order to achieve universal health coverage (UHC) for economically weaker sections (EWS) and below poverty line (BPL) people, launched a major scheme, Ayushman Bharat, in line

with the National Health Policy-2017 but Indian systems - ayurveda, yoga, naturopathy are not covered under it. "PM-JAY, that is, Ayushman Bharat predominantly covers and is limited to allopathic hospitals and dispensaries, while India boasts various indigenous medical systems, including ayurveda, yoga, naturopathy, siddha, unani, homeopathy, which are rooted in India's rich traditions and are highly effective in addressing the healthcare needs of the present time," the petition said. It said India is rich in various great traditions of sages and has clear evidence of this in various available scriptures, vedas, puranas and Upanishads. "Unfortunately, due to various policies created by foreign rulers and

individuals with a colonial mindset, our cultural, intellectual knowledge and scientific heritage have been systematically eroded.

Along with this, these foreigners, motivated by a profit-oriented approach, have thoughtfully implemented many laws and schemes during the time of our country's independence that have slowly undermined our rich heritage and history," the plea said. It sought the scheme to be implemented in every state so a significant portion of the country's population is able to avail itself of affordable healthcare benefits and wellness in various serious diseases, without any harm and at low rates, and provide employment to thousands of people in the field of ayurveda. Yasin Malik, Pahloo appear before court in Rubaiya Sayeed case, witnesses identify another accused

JAMMU, NOV 2 /--/ Separatist leader Yasin Malik and his associate Rafiq Pahloo appeared before a special court here on Thursday via video conference in connection with the 1989 abduction of Rubaiya Sayeed, the daughter of the then Union home minister Mufti Mohammad Sayeed.

Two eyewitnesses examined in the court identified Ali Mohammad Mir as another accused in the case, Senior Additional Advocate General and Chief Prosecutor of the CBI Monika Kohli told PTI. She said the next date of the hearing was fixed on December 14. "In the 1989 Rubaiya Sayeed abduction case, two witnesses were examined. They identified one accused Ali Mohammad Mir," she said. Giving further details, senior public prosecutor SK Bhat told PTI that two witnesses numbers 24 and 25 were examined. They supported the prosecution and identified accused Ali Mohammad Mir, he said.

Ali Mohammad Mir, who is the prime accused in

the kidnapping case after Malik, had taken Rubaiya Sayeed in his vehicle to Sopore from Srinagar and kept her at a guesthouse. Bhat said Jammu and Kashmir Liberation Front (JKLF) chief Malik and Pahloo appeared via video conference.

Malik, who is lodged in Delhi's Tihar Jail where he is serving a jail term in a terror financing case, was not produced in the court physically due to a Union Ministry of Home Affairs order restricting his movement. Pahloo is lodged in the Central Jail in Srinagar following his arrest for reviving the terrorist apparatus in the Kashmir valley. Bhat added.

He said that Pahloo, alias 'Nanaji', was among 10 terrorists arrested in July from a hotel in a case related to a conspiracy to revive the banned JKLF and separatist amalgam Hurriyat conference in the valley. In a separate case connected with the killing of four Indian Air Force (IAF) personnel in a terrorist attack in Srinagar in 1990, the court had summoned a

witness for identification but he could not appear as he is unwell, Bhat said. The court has set December 14 as the next date of hearing in the IAF killing case and called for the summoning of witnesses for cross-examination, the prosecutor said.

The special Terrorist and Disruptive Activities (Prevention) Act court has already framed charges separately against JKLF chief Malik and several others in both cases. The charges against Malik, Pahloo and eight others in the 1989 abduction case of Rubaiya Sayeed were framed by the court on January 11, 2021. (PTI)
