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'Still love you': Pakistani woman Seema Haider's husband appeals for her return

Seema Haider, a mother of four, entered India with her children. Her first husband Ghulam Haider, currently in Saudi Arabia, has now requested her to return, professing his love for her.

New Delhi. "I still love you the same and will continue to do so...please come back" - This is an appeal from a husband to his runaway wife.

Professing his love for his wife Seema Haider, a Pakistani woman who illegally entered India to live with a Hindu man after she met him through a game of PUBG in 2019, Ghulam Haider requested her to return. Seema, a mother of four, entered India with her children, to pursue her love for Sachin Meena. Her first husband Ghulam Haider, currently in Saudi Arabia, has said he still loves her. In an interview with a Pakistani YouTuber, Ghulam said he is worried about their children and wants Seema to come back to him. "You know very well how much I love you. If anything happens to you there, just think about what will happen to our children. Who will take responsibility? So for their sake, please come back," he

said in the interview. "I still love you the same and will continue to do so. I miss the kids and you so much. No one will say anything to you. I will keep you with me and we will start a new life again," he added. Talking to a Pakistani reporter named Mohsin, Ghulam Haider appealed for Seema's return. He said that if she feels unsafe in Pakistan, he will take her and the children to Saudi with him, and settle down there.

On 'Hindustan Zindabad' slogans
Some time back, Seema's children were seen raising the slogan 'Hindustan Zindabad'. Reacting to it, Ghulam said, "They are children. They will say Pakistan Zindabad as well if you ask them to." Furthermore, Ghulam revealed that he left his first wife for Seema and went to Saudi Arabia to earn more money for their family. As proof of his commitment, Ghulam said he would previously send Rs 40-50



thousand a month to Seema, and later increased the allowance to Rs 80-90 thousand, so their children could be well taken care of. Ghulam said he gave Seema Rs 17 lakh for a house, despite not having that much money at the time. He said that Seema desired to buy her own house. **'Don't spread lies about Seema'** Ghulam Haider not only requested

his wife's return, but also appealed to people not to spread lies about her. He said, "Some people are defaming Seema on social media for a few likes, which is absolutely wrong." "Her marriage to me was her first. We spoke lovingly till May 10 and I know my wife is of good character," he added. **Ghulam's plea to Indian government**

Earlier, Ghulam had made a heartfelt appeal to the Indian government to send his wife and children back to Pakistan. He alleged that his wife was lured and manipulated to come to India through PUBG. Ghulam Haider appealed to the Narendra Modi government for the safe return of his wife and children to Pakistan, where they could be reunited as a family once again.

Seema and Sachin's love story
Seema and Sachin fell in love while talking on PUBG, a gaming application, in 2019. She illegally entered India through Nepal and the two started living together in a rented apartment in Greater Noida's Rabupura area with Seema's four children. She was arrested on July 4 for entering India illegally without a visa through Nepal. Sachin was also arrested for helping her. However, the two were granted bail on Friday.

"Should We Schedule Rajdhani Stop Next?": Supreme Court On Unusual Request

The petitioner had alleged that even though there was a proposal to allot a stop for the new 'Vande Bharat' at Tirur, it didn't fructify without any reason.

Despite Malappuram being densely populated and many people depending on train services for their travel purposes, a stop has not been allotted for the district, the petitioner alleged. Tirur was allotted a stop on behalf of the Malappuram district, but the Indian Railways called back the

stop and instead another railway station -- Shornur in the Palakkad district -- was allotted, which is roughly 56 km away from Tirur, the petitioner said, alleging it was done for political reasons. The failure to allot a stop at Tirur Railway Station is an injustice to the people of Malappuram and, therefore, ignoring their requests and demands causes great prejudice, he argued.

"The stops to be provided for a train is a matter that has to be determined by the Railways. No person has a vested right to demand that a particular train should stop at a particular station," the Supreme Court said, adding that if every individual or public-spirited person in every district starts clamouring or demanding a stop to be provided at a railway station of their choice, the purpose of setting up high speed trains would itself be lost.

S Jaishankar, Derek O'Brien Among 11 To Be Elected To Rajya Sabha Unopposed

The ruling BJP has gained a seat and has 93 members in Rajya Sabha, where the government does not have a majority.



New Delhi. Foreign Minister S Jaishankar and Trinamool Congress leader Derek O'Brien are among 11 leaders set to be elected unopposed to Rajya Sabha. The ruling BJP will gain a seat, bolstering its count to 93 members in Rajya Sabha, where the government does not have a majority.

There will be no voting for six seats in West Bengal, three in Gujarat and one seat in Goa on July 24, as was scheduled, because there are no opposing candidates in these seats. Today was the last date for withdrawing nominations to contest the polls.

Six Trinamool Congress and five BJP candidates will be elected unopposed. The Trinamool will also win a bypoll on one Rajya Sabha seat in West Bengal. S Jaishankar - who has won a second term in the upper house - Babubhai Desai and Kesardev Singh Jhala are the BJP candidates elected from Gujarat, Anant Maharaj from West Bengal, and Sadanand Shet Tanavade from Goa.

Besides Derek O'Brien, the other Trinamool Congress leaders elected unopposed are Sukhendu Sekhar Roy, Dola Sen, Saket Gokhale, Samirul Islam, and Prakash Barik. The Congress is set to lose one seat and drop to 30 members in Rajya Sabha. Seven seats in the 245-member Rajya Sabha will fall vacant after July 24 - four seats in Jammu and Kashmir, two nominated and one vacant seat in Uttar Pradesh. The total seats in Rajya Sabha will come down to 238 and the majority mark will be 120.

Solicitor-General Tushar Mehta informed the court that the Centre has filed an affidavit that the Bill will be introduced in the upcoming Parliament session to replace the Ordinance.

New Delhi. Both Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and Lieutenant Governor VK Saxena have to rise above political bickering, the Supreme Court said today while making a suggestion to break the impasse on the Centre's controversial ordinance which upturned a judgement of the top court granting greater control to the Delhi government over its bureaucrats.

"We have a suggestion to break the impasse. Can the LG and CM sit down and give an agreeable candidate? So that the person can be appointed for DERC (Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission)," the court said. Senior Advocate Harish Salve, appearing for the Lieutenant Governor, said he was fine with the court's suggestion. "The ideal situation is both agreeing to a



name for the DERC Chairperson. We don't want to step into this. We want both of you to sit together and resolve this," the court added. The court made the suggestion after Senior Advocate Abhishek Manu Singhvi, arguing for the Aam Aadmi Party government, told the court the DERC was "headless". Solicitor-General Tushar Mehta informed the court that the Centre has

filed an affidavit that the Bill will be introduced in the upcoming Parliament session to replace the Ordinance.

This case relates to one section of the Ordinance -- appointment of DERC Chairperson.

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The court is also hearing a second plea challenging the whole ordinance, in which it will issue notice and send the matter to a Constitution bench. The Supreme Court will next hear the case on Thursday. The Centre is unlikely to face any trouble getting its ordinance through Rajya Sabha, where it does not have a majority, despite the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) securing the Congress's support on the subject.

Mumbai-Surat flying Raneer train loses double-decker coaches after decades

The new Flying Raneer is composed of air-conditioned chair cars, second-class seating coaches, a ladies-only coach, and a ladies' season ticket holders coach in addition to the general coach.

New Delhi. Over 43 years after it became the first train in the history of the Indian Railways to be hitched with double-decker coaches, a new-look Flying Raneer was on Sunday flagged off from Mumbai to Surat.

Union Minister of State for Railways and Textiles Darshana Jardosh flagged off the train and also travelled aboard from Mumbai Central station to Surat, over 200 km away. The train no longer has the double-decker coaches. It has the Linke Hofmann Buschnew (LHB) coaches which are faster and more comfortable than its predecessor, an official said.

The new Flying Raneer is composed of air-conditioned chair cars, second-class seating coaches, a ladies-only coach, and a ladies' season ticket holders coach in addition to the general coach. "Here begins another era for the new and enhanced Flying Raneer - the latest addition to Naye Bharat Ki Nayi Rail. Flagged off Flying Raneer train from



Mumbai Central Railway Station as it commences its maiden trip to Surat with new LHB coaches, tweeted Jardosh, Lok

Sabha member from Surat constituency. "Travelling by train has its own charm - you get to make new friends, you gather

some priceless memories and you also get to enjoy India's landscape," the minister said. On December 18, 1979, the Flying Raneer became the first train in the history of the Indian Railways to be hitched with the double-decker coaches. "End of an era! The last public service of non-AC double-decker coaches of the iconic Flying Raneer Express train entered Mumbai Central station this morning. From this evening, the train has been upgraded with LHB-class upgraded version of coaches, but is sadly not a double-decker," said Rajendra Aklekar, journalist and author on India's rail history.

"Could not miss the historic last run of the double-decker coaches for anything. They were introduced on the train exactly 43 years six months 29 days ago. The only double-decker train to remain now is the Valsad Fast Passenger, operated by Western Railway," Aklekar tweeted.
