

Manipur violence: COCOMI to boycott govt for failing to convene emergency assembly session

IMPHAL, AUG 6/--/The Coordinating Committee on Manipur Integrity (COCOMI), an umbrella body of several Imphal-based civil society organisations, has decided to boycott the state government for its failure to convene an emergency session of the legislative assembly and inept handling of the ongoing unrest in the state which has so far claimed over 160 lives.

Addressing a press conference at the COCOMI office here on Sunday, Jeetendra Ningomba said he was disappointed with the government for not heeding to its demand for an emergency assembly session before August 5 to

seek a peaceful resolution to the current turmoil. He said COCOMI will not cooperate with any activities initiated by the state government. "We had demanded an emergency session of the assembly. But the state government failed to act on our request. This compelled us to boycott it," Ningomba said. The COCOMI convenor also condemned the recent incident at Kwakta in Bishnupur district where three people lost their lives.

"It's unfortunate that the central government remained silent on such a heinous act that claimed innocent lives," Ningomba said. As violence continued in the state, 15 houses were set on fire at Langol Games village in Imphal West district on Saturday

evening, officials said. The incident happened as a mob went on a rampage, they said. Security personnel fired several rounds of tear gas shells to disperse the mob and bring the situation under control, they added. A 45-year-old man was shot during the violence. He was admitted to the Regional Institute of Medical Sciences (RIMS) with bullet wounds on his left thigh, and is stated to be out of danger at present, officials said.

The situation improved on Sunday morning, but restrictions remained in place, they said. Fresh violence was also reported from Imphal East district's Checkona area where a large commercial establishment was torched on Saturday, officials said. (PTI)

Forest (Conservation) Amendment Bill anti-tribal, assembly session needed to denounce it: NPF

KOHIMA, AUG 6/--/The Naga People's Front (NPF) has termed the Forest (Conservation) Amendment Bill cleared by Parliament recently as "anti-tribal" and demanded that an emergency session of the Nagaland Assembly be convened to pass a resolution against the Bill.

The Forest (Conservation) Amendment Bill 2023 seeks to exempt land within 100 km of the country's borders from the purview of conservation laws and permit the setting up of zoos, safaris and eco-tourism facilities in forest areas. It was passed by the Lok Sabha last month and the Rajya Sabha on August 2. NPF Legislative Party Leader Kuzhuluzhi Nienu asserted that the provisions of the Bill, after becoming law, will make precious forest land "more vulnerable to damage and destruction". Besides, he claimed, the Bill comes into conflict with the constitutional safeguard guaranteed to Nagaland on land and its resources under Article 371(A) providing special

provisions for the northeastern state. He said that the NPF demands that the NDPP-BJP government of the state should immediately pass an act or a resolution rejecting the "anti-tribal and anti-constitutional bill". For that, the government must convene a special session or take up this issue in the upcoming Assembly session scheduled next month, Nienu said. He claimed that the Bill gets clearance from both Houses of Parliament despite objections raised from different corners of the country. Pointing out that the Act exempts projects related to economy and security of national importance within 100 km of international borders, he claimed that such projects would no longer require forest clearance as it removed the Forest (Conservation) Act's restrictions on creating infrastructure in the reserved forest areas. The Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 says that de-

reservation of reserved forests, use of forest land for non-forest purposes, assigning forest land by way of lease or otherwise to private entity and clearing of naturally grown trees for the purpose of reforestation requires prior permission of the central government. Acknowledging that infrastructural and industrial developments are inevitable, he said, "By allowing such activities such as creation of check posts, fire lines, eco-tourism facilities, safaris, exploration, dams, seismic surveys, etc.,... they (forests) are just made more vulnerable to damage and destruction."

Forest and wildlife concerns can be politicised for other national and commercial interests, the NPF leader said adding that tribal land in the Northeast is surrounded by international borders. The senior MLA also asserted that this Bill undermines the power of the state government as it

gives the Centre the first and last say on everything related to forests. The Bill makes the entire Nagaland vulnerable since a large

stretch of the state is covered with greeneries, Nienu said. (PTI)

Nagaland: Century-old Dimapur Railway Station to be redeveloped

DIMAPUR, AUG 6/--/Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Sunday laid the foundation stone for redevelopment of the century-old Dimapur Railway Station in Nagaland. It is among the 508 stations across the country that will be modernised under the 'Amrit Bharat Station Scheme'. The foundation stone for redevelopment of Dimapur Railway Station was laid virtually by the PM. In his address, the PM said all state capitals of the northeast will soon be connected by railway network. Work is underway on doubling lines, gauge conversion, electrification and new routes, Modi said. "Commissioning of new railway lines in the region has increased three times," he added. A total of 56 railway stations in the northeast will be modernised under the 'Amrit Bharat Station Scheme'.

Speaking on the occasion, Nagaland Governor La Ganesan said the Dimapur Railway Station is the second busiest in the northeast, and it is also integral for the security of the region as it facilitates easy movement and deployment of personnel. The redevelopment will entail a cost of Rs 283 crore, and work is likely to be completed in two-and-a-half years, a senior official said. The proposed main station building in Dimapur will have an area of 17,484 square metre from the existing 5,160 square metre, said P K Kshatriya, Chief Administrative Officer (Construction) of Northeast Frontier Railway.

Other features include spacious waiting areas with modern facilities for passengers, food plazas, green buildings, solar panels and rainwater harvesting, he said. (PTI)

Act East policy has changed the face of northeast: Tripura CM

AGARTALA, AUG 6/--/Tripura Chief Minister Manik Saha on Sunday claimed that the Act East policy of the Modi government has changed the face of Northeast as the region has witnessed a much needed connectivity boost over the past few years. The people of Tripura could not dream that the rail would reach Sabroom, the state's southern-most border town through Agartala when a metre gauge railway station was opened at Dharmanagar in North district in the 1960s, he said.

"Now, it is a reality with trains running between Agartala and Sabroom everyday that too broad gauge. Currently, 10 to 12 express trains are coming to Agartala. This has been possible because of visionary leader like Prime Minister Narendra Modi", he said at Agartala railway station as the prime minister virtually laid foundation stone for redevelopment of 508 railway stations across the country including three in Tripura.

"The Act East policy has changed the face of the Northeast as the region witnessed a much needed connectivity boost since 2014. The chief ministers of Northeastern states during their conclave said now the Northeast has become part of India in true sense", he said. Saha said the day is not far when the people of landlocked Tripura will be able to reach Kolkata in 10 hours with our war footing to



complete Indo-Bangla (Agartala-Gangasagar) railway. The Indo-Bangla railway link is expected to be commissioned by the end of this year. Under the Amrit Bharat Stations project, as many as 91 stations of the northeast will be redeveloped with modern facilities, he said, adding Rs 96.60 crore will be spent to face-lift three railway stations in Tripura - Udaipur, Dharmanagar and Kumarghat.

Claiming that the people of northeastern state are receiving the benefit of having a double engine government, Saha thanked the prime minister and Railway Minister Ashwani Vaishnav for incorporating three railway stations of Tripura into the Amrit Bharat Station project. (PTI)
