**Bahrain to Provide COVID-19 Vaccine Free of Charge to All Citizens - State Media**

Doha: Bahraini King Hamad bin Isa Al Khalifa has tasked the health authorities with carrying out a free COVID-19 vaccination campaign for all of the kingdom's citizens and residents, the state-run BNA news agency reported on Thursday. The order was announced following a meeting of the government executive committee to combat the coronavirus chaired by Crown Prince and Prime Minister Salman bin Hamad Al Khalifa. The committee has discussed plans and preparations to provide 27 medical centers across the country with a free COVID-19 vaccine. The health authorities initially intend to inoculate 5,000 individuals per day over the age of 16. UK then expand the program up to 10,000 per day.

**AstraZeneca accepts cooperation offer from Russian Covid vaccine developers**

Moscow: UK-Swedish pharmaceutical company AstraZeneca accepted cooperation offer from developers of Russian coronavirus vaccine Sputnik V to study Covid-19 vaccine combination. AstraZeneca said Friday, "Today we announce a clinical trial programme to assess safety and immunogenicity of a combination of AZD1222, developed by AstraZeneca and Oxford University and Sputnik V, developed by Russian Gamaleya Research Institute. It will begin enrolling adults aged 18 years and older in the UK. Swedish company said, "The new chapter of vaccine cooperation has started today. We made an offer and AstraZeneca accepted it. It all happened here on Twitter" the official Twitter account of Russia's Sputnik V vaccine said.

**COVID-19 not changing plans for Russia's far East development - Deputy Prime Minister**

Vladivostok: The crisis triggered by the coronavirus pandemic has partially affected the work of enterprises but will not change plans for the development of Russia's Far East, Russian Deputy Prime Minister Yuri Trutnev, who also serves as the presidential special envoy in the Far East region, said on Friday. "We do not plan to slow down the pace of the region's development. The epidemiological crisis affects the work of enterprises, affects the economy, but all the challenges the state faces must be solved. Investments projects are being implemented. They face difficulties, we help them. But I do not see anything so dramatic that we would change the direction of development or its pace," Trutnev told reporters.

**Over 10,000 Russian Servicemen Vaccinated Against Coronavirus - Defense Ministry**

Moscow: Over 10,000 Russian servicemen have already been vaccinated against the coronavirus, with no refusals registered to receive the Sputnik V vaccine, the Defense Ministry's spokesman Major Igor Konashenkov said. "Given that the Russian Defense Ministry has received 14,500 vaccines, over 10,000 servicemen have been vaccinated, as of December 10," Konashenkov said. Successful clinical trials and the fact that all the servicemen have developed immunity after vaccination serve as a guarantee of Sputnik V safety and efficacy. A spokesman added, "So, there have been no refusals to receive the Sputnik V vaccine among the servicemen, even taking into account that vaccination is voluntary." Konashenkov went on to say,

**US FDA advisory panel approves Pfizer Corona vaccine for Americans**



Washington (UNI)

A US Food and Drug Administration advisory panel approved Pfizer's coronavirus vaccine for use on Americans to try and curb the spread of a pandemic that had infected more than 15 million people in the country and killed almost 300,000 of them.

"We do have a favorable vote," Kathleen Hayes, the official who tallied the votes cast at the meeting, said in a live-stream of Thursday's event held to determine if the vaccine jointly developed by Pfizer and Germany's BioNTech was safe for use.

The advisory panel members were asked to consider the question: "Based on the totality of the scientific evidence available, do the benefits of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine outweigh its risks for use in individuals 16 years of age or older?"

They overwhelmingly voted 17-4 in favor of the vaccine. Earlier, during the meeting, the advisory panel requested data on severe allergic reactions to the vaccine. The request came after two allergic reactions reported by UK health-care workers given the shot developed by Pfizer and BioNTech. The United Kingdom's Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency had also updated its guidance on Wednesday to advise people who have a history of "significant" allergic reactions to forgo the vaccine.

"I believe most of us are going to be revisiting some of these issues in about a week," Arnold Monto, the epidemiologist who chaired Thursday's panel meeting, said before concluding. Pfizer did not immediately react to the FDA's approval of its vaccine and bid to gather more data on the allergic reactions reported in Britain. The Pfizer vaccine is the first immunization against the coronavirus greenlighted by the FDA. It is also considering for approval a similar shot developed by Moderna Inc.

The Pfizer vaccine is expected to be rolled out as soon as Friday to healthcare workers and long-term nursing home residents under a massive mobilization effort carried out by the US Army under the Trump administration "Operation Warp Speed" project. People who get one of the two COVID-19 vaccines should get their second shot 21 or 28 days after the first one, according to the manufacturers.

**France to replace Corona lockdown with curfew starting next week**

Paris (UNI)

The Covid lockdown in France will be replaced with a dusk-to-dawn curfew from starting from December 15, as the country struggles to contain the second wave of Covid-19 pandemic. French Prime Minister Jean Castex said, "We will introduce a curfew from December 15, but it will be stricter. It will be in effect from 20.00, not from 21.00, as mentioned earlier," the prime minister told reporters, adding that there would be no curfew exceptions on New Year's Eve. The prime minister added that the second wave of the coronavirus pandemic in the country was not over.

"We are on a plateau, the number of new infections is no longer falling, but slightly increasing over recent days," the prime minister said.



Cultural institutions, including museums, cinemas, theaters, which the French authorities expected to open from December 15, will remain closed for at least three more weeks, according to Castex. The current stay-at-home state order at a national level came into effect on October 30, and the government announced its three-stage lockdown relief strategy for next month. To date, national health authorities have confirmed 2,337,966 COVID-19 cases, 56,940 related fatalities and 174,658 recoveries.

**Swedish holds 2020 Nobel Prize award ceremony online**

Stockholm (UNI): The online ceremony for the 2020 Nobel Prize award in Literature, Physics, Chemistry, Physiology or Medicine and Economic Sciences in Memory of Alfred Nobel was held in the Swedish capital of Stockholm. This year's event took place in an unconventional format due to the COVID-19 pandemic, so the laureates received their awards remotely.

The award ceremony is traditionally held on December 10, the day of Nobel Prize founder Alfred Nobel's death. The event was held at the Stockholm City Hall and was broadcast by the Nobel Prize channel.

This year, the Nobel Prize in physics was awarded to Roger Penrose, Reinhard Genzel and Andrea Ghez for the discovery of a supermassive compact object at the center of the galaxy. The 2020 Chemistry Prize went to Emmanuelle Charpentier and Jennifer Doudna for the development of a method for genome editing.

**China's Gender imbalance reaches almost 20 percent among Young people under 20**

China has almost 20 percent more men than women among young people under the age of 20, the latest data by the National Bureau of Statistics (NBS) on Friday showed.

According to the NBS' latest data on China's population structure, the country's boys-to-girls gender ratio reached 119.1 percent among those aged 10-14 and 118.39 percent among those aged between 15-19 by the end of 2019.

The gender imbalance among the age group of 20-24 stood at 114.61 by the end of 2019, the latest data showed. More than 40 years after China's "One Child Policy" was introduced in the early 1980s, the country's gender imbalance continued to worsen in recent years. Because Chinese families traditionally favored boys over girls, the

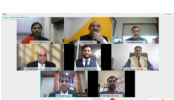
**Rajasthan forms panel to probe death of 12 infants**

Jaipur, The Rajasthan government on Friday constituted a four-member committee to investigate the death of 12 newborns at JK Lon Hospital in Kota in 48 hours, officials said. Nine newborns, all of them between one and four days old, died at the hospital on Thursday, within a span of hours, a year after the same facility had hit national headlines over the deaths of at least 100 infants in a month. On Friday, three more newborns - two born just a day ago and another one old - died at the hospital, said its Superintendent Suresh Chand Dulara. According to state health minister Raghu Sharma, the committee, which includes medical education commissioner Shivangi Swarnakar and other officials, will visit the J K Lon Hospital and investigate every case of infant death at the health facility. Sharma said

the committee will look into over-arrangements at the hospital, the requirement and availability of medical staff, availability of medical equipment, and medicines. It will submit its report to the state government in three days, he said. The Rajasthan health minister also directed all principals of all medical colleges of the state to take special care towards treatment of newborn children, according to a release. Rajasthan Human Rights Commission secretary B L Meena and registrar Om Purohit will visit the JK Lon hospital on December 14.
