Delhi Government offers Rs 50,000 Tax Break for Scrapping Old Vehicles

NEW DELHI: In a bid to promote the retirement of old vehicles, the Delhi government plans to provide a subsidy of up to Rs 50,000 in road tax for new cars with better emission standards. Transport department officials have crafted a draft policy on scrapping vehicles, which is expected to be shared with the public soon for their input. The proposed policy is currently under review by the finance department for approval, considering it involves the use of public funds as a subsidy, as reported by a senior government official. The policy highlights the issue of numerous vehicles past their lifespan still operating on city roads, contributing to pollution. While the transport department had previously impounded such vehicles for scrapping, the effort was halted due to Delhi High Court intervention. Following the court's guidance, the government has formulated a draft policy on vehicle scrapping, with potential varying discounts for commercial and private vehicles. Under existing regulations, petrol vehicles older than 15 years and diesel vehicles older than 10 years



are not allowed to operate in the national capital region. According to the Statistical Handbook - 2023, around 55 lakh vehicles were deregistered in Delhi in 2021-22 and 2022-23, but only 1.4 lakh were scrapped. Instead, owners obtained a no-objection certificate from the transport department to register 6.3 lakh vehicles outside the NCR. "This shows that people are still holding on to their aged vehicles, contributing to air quality issues, or parking them in residential areas or lots," explained an official. "The new policy aims to motivate people to scrap old, polluting vehicles and invest in new ones," the official added. Upon scrapping their vehicles, individuals will receive a "certificate of deposit," which needs

DELHI GOVERNMENT RUN ITS RECORD AN IMPRESSIVE 72.3% PLACEMENT FOR THE YEAR 2023-24
NEW DELHI: The transformative initiatives spearheaded by the Kejriwal Government to enhance employment opportunities for students in Delhi's Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) have yielded exceptional results. According to the latest placement report, government-run ITIs in Delhi have recorded an impressive 72.3% placement this year. Among the 19 ITIs under the Delhi Government, ITI Vivek Vihar and ITI Dheerpur have recorded 97% and 94% placement with students securing positions in renowned companies across India. Some of these companies include Hero, LG, Lnt, Bharat Electronics, Tata Group, etc.

Delhi government-run Industrial Training Institutes have recorded a 72.30 per cent placement for the year 2023-24, officials said on Wednesday. Out of 14,800 students in 19 ITIs run by the Delhi

government, 10,700 students secured placements in different companies, whereas ITI Vivek Vihar and ITI Dheerpur recorded the highest placement, they said. Delhi Education Minister Atishi said the placement numbers of Delhi ITIs are the result of focused placement strategy of the government for these institutes. "The Delhi government is preparing students for excellent job opportunities with world-class technical education and a splendid placement ecosystem in its ITIs. We are dedicated to nurturing a skilled and employable workforce by aligning education with industry demands," she said. She said that to ensure better placement opportunities and industry exposure for ITI students, the government has formed the centralised placement and industry outreach cell. "This cell has adopted a transformation strategy for placement, aiming to modernise the placement approach by focusing on academia-industry collaboration, career services, flexible learning options, entrepreneurship support, and more," the Delhi Minister said.

Delhi Metro to begin services at 4 am on R-Day

NEW DELHI: The Delhi Metro will commence services at 4 am on all its lines to facilitate the public to reach Kartavya Path for the Republic Day parade on January 26, DMRC officials said on Wednesday. Services will be available at a headway of 30 minutes till 6 am and the regular timetable will be followed after that for the rest of the day, they said. "People who will be in possession of bona fide e-invitation cards or e-tickets for attending the Republic Day ceremony will be issued coupons on production of government-issued identity cards at stations, which will be valid for exits from Central Secretariat and Udyog Bhawan stations only to reach Kartavya Path," a Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) statement said. The same coupon will be valid for return



journeys from these two stations. The officials further said passengers with invitation cards marked for enclosures 1 to 9 and V1 and V2 should deboard at Udyog Bhawan. "Similarly, those (with invitation cards) marked for enclosures 10 to 24 and VN are advised to deboard at Central Secretariat. Regular announcements will also be made inside the trains to inform passengers about the same so that they deboard at the designated stations in order to reach their enclosures smoothly," the DMRC said.

DELHI POLICE CRACKS MAN'S MURDER USING AI

NEW DELHI: In a first, Delhi Police identified a dead body and solved a murder case using Artificial Intelligence (AI), an official said on Wednesday. According to police, the body of an unidentified man was found under Geeta Colony flyover on December 10. "The autopsy of the deceased revealed that he had been strangled, however, there were no marks on his body," said an official. A 30-member team was formed and Delhi Police employed AI technology to solve the case as the man's face was beyond recognition because of decomposition. As per officials, using AI, they digitally reconstructed the victim's face and created about 450 posters which were then distributed strategically in the national Capital and shared digitally via WhatsApp groups till January 12.

14,000 personnel to guard R-Day parade, says Delhi Police

NEW DELHI: About 14,000 security personnel will be deployed in and around Kartavya Path where the Republic Parade will take place on January 26, Delhi Police officials said on Wednesday. Extensive arrangements have been made for the safety and security of the 77,000 invitees expected at Kartavya Path to watch this year's parade, they said. During a press conference at the Delhi Police headquarters, Special Commissioner of Police (Security) Dependra Pathak said professional, robust and flawless security arrangements have been put in place all around Delhi for Republic Day. The police has ensured that peace prevails in Delhi's "vulnerable" areas following Monday's consecration ceremony at the Ram temple in Ayodhya. Peace is being maintained in the border areas with help of interstate coordination, he said.



Special Commissioner of Police (Law and Order, Zone II) Madhup Tiwari said at least 77,000 invitees are expected at the parade. "We have divided the New Delhi district, where the parade will take place, into 28 zones to ensure security. These zones are headed by senior officers; Tiwari said. Missing persons booths and separate facilitation booths where the visitors can deposit their vehicle keys before the parade have been set up, he said. Tiwari also requested

the people to reach the venue on time and cooperate with the security personnel during the thorough checking that will take place.
