Bihar hooch toll hits 12, 2 cops axed

Chhapra: Twelve people died in Bihar's hooch ban from drinking spurious liquor over the last two days, six of them on Friday. It is an unfolding hooch horror in the dry state that landed on alleged tippers behind bars and cost two cops their jobs, reports H K Verma. Many of those in custody

for alleged prohibition law violations include villagers who fell ill after having the poisonous concoction in Bhatha villages. Many of those ill have lost vision. The SHO of the local Moker police station and the chowkidar of Bhatha village have been sacked for "dereliction of duty".

Low property tax tops PM's agenda for Niti meeting

New Delhi: A packet of trash bags costs around Rs 50 on an e-commerce site, almost twice the per capita property tax in a city like Kota (Rs 28) and one-third the rate in Amritsar (Rs 150) in 2017-18. Mumbai, which is at the top, had a per capita mop-up of a little over Rs 4,000, but the average for India is just Rs 600—the cost of a 5kg bag of basmati rice. Given the level of resources that municipal bodies generate, it is no surprise that they find themselves with little funds to meet their developmental needs, an issue that is going to be deliberated in detail at the Niti Azim governing council meeting on Sunday. The agenda for the meeting, to be chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has pointed to the digital revenue of civic bodies and suggested an overhaul, by linking property tax to electricity or water bills. In fact, the agenda flows from a recent meeting the PM had with state chief secretaries. Besides, it will also suggest that municipal bodies be taxed with collecting professional tax instead of states. The issue of professional tax on the non-salaried is an issue that is

close to several states, given that they now have limited sources to raise revenues.

Collection of property tax is one of the major sources of municipalities' own revenue and the municipal bodies often hesitate to increase property tax due to political considerations. There have been several instances when civic bodies have announced waiver of house tax before municipal polls. Currently, property tax accounts for less than half the revenue generated by the municipalities. According to the agenda, the own revenue generated by municipal entities is barely 8.15% of the GDP, compared to 8.6% in developing countries and 2.1% in developed nations. What makes the equation more lopsided is that half the spending is on administrative and establishment expenses, leaving little to spend on development activities. The Centre will also suggest that states bring all properties falling under every municipality under the property tax net by using IT tools, space and GIS technology to improve the tax collection.

Set free undertrials involved in petty crimes: SC to govt

New Delhi: As lower courts are burdened with more than four crore pending cases and 70% of the prisoners languishing in jails are undertrials, most of whom are poor and illiterate, the Supreme Court on Friday asked the Centre to consider dropping trial proceedings against those who are involved in not very serious offences and have spent one-third of the maximum sentence. It asked the Centre to free them as a one-time measure on the occasion of the 75th year of Independence.

SC agrees to examine plea for pan-India lottery

Meghalaya led the charge in the Supreme Court on Friday for permission to states to run pan-India lotteries, reports Dhnanjay Mahapatra. Appearing for Meghalaya, senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi told a bench headed by Chief Justice N V Ramana that the hilly north-eastern states earned a major chunk of their revenue from running lotteries. He said these states have suffered financially during the pandemic and requested the court to lift the restriction imposed by the SC—that a state can run a business in lottery in another state if the latter too was organising lotteries. So, a state which did not organise lotteries can ban lotteries of other states. Appearing for Sikkim, senior advocate A M Singhvi said Lottery (Regulation) Act, 1998 is a central legislation, but under Section 5, the Centre has impermissibly delegated the power to regulate lotteries to states. The bench asked additional solicitor general Sanjay Jain to spell out the Centre's stand in two weeks and posted the matter for hearing on August 17. Rohatgi said only Kerala, Maharashtra, Punjab, Sikkim, Meghalaya, Goa and West Bengal have state-organised lotteries.

A bench of Justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul and M M Sundresh said this occasion is the most appropriate to take such a decision to deal with the chronic problems of pendency in courts and overcrowding in jails.

The court asked the Centre to hold consultations with states and take a call on the issue before August 15. It said out-of-hat thinking was needed to handle these problems or they will continue to haunt the system for thousands of years. The apex court's suggestion came just days after Prime Minister Narendra Modi said more and more of undertrial prisoners be released from jails in the 75th year of Independence and appealed to the district judges, who head the undertrial review committee, to expedite the process for release.

While dealing with a batch of bail petitions of those who have been in jail for years, the bench said first-time offenders involved in petty offences could be let off and criminal proceedings can be dropped if they agree to file bond for good behaviour in society. The court said the government can also put other conditions on them. It suggested that convicts who have been in jail for around 10 years but have not had their appeals heard in high courts due to pendency of cases can be granted bail. "We are celebrating the 75th year of Independence. It is the appropriate time to take decisions for those who are incarcerated for long and are involved in a single offence," the bench said. It said such a decision was needed to unlog the courts and jails as the concept of plea bargaining has not been successful in the country due to the social stigma attached to people accepting guilt. NIA: Accused duo went for biryani dinner after Amravati killing

Mumbai: A special court on Friday remanded Abdul Arbay and Maulavi Musfiqur Ahmed, both Amravati residents, arrested in connection with the killing of Amravati chemist Umesh Kolhe, to NIA custody till August 12. So far, a total of nine accused have been arrested. Seeking 15 days custody, the NIA claimed that they were harbouring the absconding accused. The NIA said that under the UAPA Act they were charged with the offence related to harbouring terrorists. It was further submitted that one of the arrested, Ifan Shaikh, had called Musfiqur after the murder, hence, conspiracy was established. It was also submitted that after the murder the accused even went for biryani dinner and this showed their conduct. 10

Rape in shelter case: Woman to walk free after 10 years in jail

Chandigarh: Jaswant Devi, who was convicted in the 2012 case of sexual exploitation of inmates in Rohtak's Apna Ghar, will soon walk out of prison after spending around 10 years behind bars. The Punjab and Haryana high court has suspended her sentence till the pendency of her appeal against the life sentence awarded to her by a special CBI court in 2020, reports Ajay Sora. "Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the application of Jaswant is allowed and her remaining sentence is suspended, during the pendency of the appeal, subject to her furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned chief judicial magistrate/duty magistrate," said the HC order HC on Thursday evening.

In a first, SC uses desi unit 'arab' for 100 crore

New Delhi: Giving a healing touch to the company reeling from huge service tax demands from authorities on sale of 'Quick Heal' antivirus software, the Supreme Court on Friday ruled that the software is not interactive and hence service tax cannot be levied on its use.

In the ruling, a bench of Justices AS Oko and JB Pardiwala created a first for the SC by resorting to Hindustani counting system and used 'arab' instead of hundred crore. Writing the judgment, Justice Pardiwala referred to Rs 5,00,90,00.30 as "Rs five arab thirty crore ninety-four lakh sixty-six thousand seven hundred and eighty three". The Quick Heal Technologies, engaged in the development of 'Quick Heal' brand antivirus software, which is supplied along with the licence code/product code either online or on replicated CDs/DVDs to end-customers in India, was asked by central tax authorities to pay a service tax of Rs-62.73 crore. The Customs, Excise and Service Tax Appellate Tribunal quashed the levy.

Rejecting the appeal of Commissioner of Service Tax, New Delhi, the bench said, "Once a lump sum has been charged for the sale of CD and sale tax has been paid thereon, the revenue thereafter cannot levy service tax on the entire sale consideration once again on the ground that the updates are being provided." "The artificial segregation of the transaction, as in the case on hand, into two parts is not tenable in law. It is, in substance, one transaction of sale of software and once it is accepted that the software put in the CD is 'goods', there cannot be any separate service element in the transaction," it said.

Vistara flight suffers bird-hit

New Delhi: A Vistara Vistara-Mumbai flight on Friday suffered a bird-hit during take off and the aircraft returned safely to the originating terminal. The Airbus A320XLR (VTTC) plane has been damaged and the aircraft has been grounded in Vietnam, said DGCA officials. This is at least the second bird hit in two days. The incidence of bird hits increases during rainy season as waterlogged ground attracts worms and insects to the surface attracting birds. Following some bird hits this monsoon, the DGCA had on June 30, 2022, asked airport operators to immediately take steps to minimise this risk. Airport operators have been asked to send an action taken report. 10

New portal to help vulnerable migrants get ration cards

New Delhi: The most vulnerable migrants in cities such as the destitute, migrants, security guards and sex workers, who don't have ration cards due to lack of current residence proof, can now get ration cards to avail themselves of subsidised foodgrains under the National Food Security Act (NFSA).

The food ministry on Friday launched a "common registration facility" to enable vulnerable migrants to get themselves registered

anywhere in the country. TOI, on December 26, had first reported the Centre's plan to launch the online facility. "People can register on behalf of the vulnerable persons by providing necessary details. The updates about the registration and the status of application will be sent to the email accounts and mobile phone number of those who applied," said Union food secretary Sudhanshu Pandey. To begin with, it states, including Punjab, Maharashtra, Uttarakhnad, Assam and Meghalaya, will be covered under this initiative. Following this, soon all other states and union territories will be brought in.
