The senior management team will represent LTH on the call.

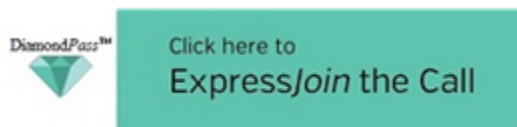
