Will get activist Navlakha medically examined, says Maharashtra govt; HC seeks NIA's reply on his plea for house arrest

MUMBAI, SEPT 2 --/ The Maharashtra government told the Bombay High Court today that it will take jailed activist Gautam Navlakha, an accused in the Elgar Parishad-Maoist links case, for a medical check-up to the Tata Memorial Hospital in neighbouring Navi Mumbai on Friday.

The state's counsel, public prosecutor Sangeeta Shinde, made the statement before a bench of Justices S S Shinde and N J Jamadar after Navlakha moved the HC earlier in the day, seeking directions to authorities of the Navi Mumbai-based Talaja prison, where he is currently lodged, to get him examined for a lump developed in his chest in March this year while in prison.

In his plea, Navlakha, 69, also sought that he be placed under house arrest as part of his judicial custody, owing to his advanced age and a host of medical ailments that he suffers from. Navlakha cited the Supreme Court's order issued in May this year, whereby the apex court had dismissed his default bail plea, but found merit in treating house arrest as an alternative form of detention, especially for such undertrials who are aged or suffering from serious medical ailments.

In his plea, Navlakha also said that with 15 people accused in the case, the

charge sheet spanning over 30,000 pages and over 150 witnesses to be examined, to continue to subject him to incarceration till the completion of the trial would be extremely "unjust, harsh, and cruel". The activist said he had always cooperated with the probe into the case and that he was a fit candidate for house arrest.

Navlakha's counsels Yug Chaudhry and Payoshi Roy also told the HC that they had already written to the Talaja prison authorities seeking a medical check up for the lump in his chest, but were yet to hear anything from them. They told the HC that Navlakha also suffered from hypertension that he developed while in prison, and several other ailments. The activist in his plea claimed the Talaja prison was grossly inept at treating serious medical ailments suffered by inmates. He also claimed the Talaja prison staff had been callous towards the health and other needs of inmates in the past. The Talaja prison authorities had repeatedly acted in a "callous manner in the past, endangering the lives of the inmates, including the petitioner's co-accused in the case," Navlakha said in the plea. "Because of the negligence and stubborn refusal of officials of the Talaja prison, the ailments and medical concerns of inmates go

undiagnosed and untreated for long periods of time," the plea said.

Navlakha's counsel Chaudhry urged the HC to allow the activist to be examined at the Mumbai-based Jaslok Hospital, a private medical facility, where his sister was an employee. Chaudhry said all expenses of the examination at the private hospital will be borne by Navlakha and his family. His request, however, was opposed by Additional Solicitor General Anil Singh, who appeared for the National Investigation Agency (NIA), which is conducting a probe into the Elgar Parishad-Maoist links case.

Singh said that accused persons must not insist on going to a hospital of their choice and suggested that Navlakha be taken by the prison authorities to a state-run hospital. The state government then proposed to take Navlakha to the Tata Memorial Hospital at Kharghar in Navi Mumbai, which is closer to the Talaja prison. While Chaudhry said the NIA was being "vindictive", the HC pointed out that Navlakha had not made a special pleading in the petition for getting examined at the Jaslok Hospital. The bench gave Chaudhry the option of filing an additional application, seeking that Navlakha be taken to the Jaslok Hospital. (PTI)

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Chhattisgarh: Govt schoolteacher suspended for 'hurting' religious sentiments

RAIPUR, SEPT 2 --/ A government schoolteacher has been suspended for allegedly beating up students for observing fast on Janmashtami festival and making objectionable comment against a Hindu god in Chhattisgarh's Kondagaon district, officials said today.

The suspension order of the teacher, Charan Markam, posted at Government Middle School in Bundapara under Girola village panchayat, was issued on Wednesday based on a preliminary inquiry into a complaint against him, Kondagaon Collector Pushpendra Kumar Meena said. The village panchayat and local villagers had complained that Markam had allegedly thrashed some students of Classes 7 and 8 in the school on Tuesday for observing fast on Janmashtami and also made objectionable comments against Lord Krishna, he said. The villagers had submitted audio and video evidence in support of their allegations, Meena said.

The suspension order of the teacher, Charan Markam, posted at Government Middle School in Bundapara under Girola village panchayat, was issued on Wednesday based on a preliminary inquiry into a complaint against him, Kondagaon Collector Pushpendra Kumar Meena said. The village panchayat and local villagers had complained that Markam had allegedly thrashed some students of Classes 7 and 8 in the school on Tuesday for observing fast on Janmashtami and also made objectionable comments against Lord Krishna, he said. The villagers had submitted audio and video evidence in support of their allegations, Meena said.

Subsequently, a government official was sent to conduct an inquiry and based on his report, the teacher was suspended with immediate effect, he said. A report in this regard has been forwarded to police for further action in the matter, the collector added. The suspension order stated, hurting religious sentiments and spreading hatred in the society comes under the

category of serious misconduct. Your (Markam) act is against the Chhattisgarh Civil Services (Conduct) Rules 1965. Another official said, Janmashtami was celebrated on Monday and the next day when students reached school, Markam asked how many of them had observed fast and performed rituals during the festival. Those students who raised their hands indicating affirmation were separated from others and were allegedly beaten up by him, he said.

According to the police, it has received a complaint and a report in connection with the incident and necessary action will be taken. A separate police complaint, lodged by a tribal organization, alleged Markam was assaulted by local residents. We have received a report of the district administration and a complaint by local villagers against the teacher. Besides, a counter complaint has been received from the Sarva Adivasi Samaj, an association of tribal communities, claiming the teacher was manhandled by locals," a senior police official said and assured necessary action. (PTI)

Maharashtra govt has given documents to CBI for probe against Anil Deshmukh: HC told

MUMBAI, SEPT 2 --/ The Maharashtra government has handed over to the CBI the documents pertaining to a report submitted by senior IPS officer Rashmi Shukla on alleged corruption in police transfers and postings for its probe against former state home minister Anil Deshmukh, the central probe agency today told the Bombay High Court.

Additional Solicitor General Anil Singh, appearing for the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), told a division bench of Justices S S Shinde and N J Jamadar that the documents have been provided as assured by the state government. Singh said the central agency would go through the documents and check if the court orders have been complied with. The court was hearing an application filed by the CBI, claiming that the government was not cooperating by refusing to hand over certain documents which the investigation against Deshmukh over alleged corruption and misuse of official position. The state government had initially refused to hand over the

documents claiming that the papers sought by the CBI did not have any relevance to its probe against Deshmukh.

However, the bench had last month asked the government to reconsider and directed it to tell if it was willing to share some of the documents. The state government then agreed to sharing some of the documents with the CBI. After hearing Singh, the court on Thursday adjourned the matter for further hearing after two weeks. The court reiterated that such matters with regard to sharing of information for investigation purposes should be solved between the two agencies instead of bringing them to court.

The documents sought by the CBI included the letter submitted by Shukla to the Director General of Police - Maharashtra, which included a report on alleged corruption in police transfer and postings, annexures of the report and the panchnama that showed how the documents had been transferred from one department to another. The CBI, in its application filed last month, had said that it

had written a letter to the State Intelligence Department (SID) seeking details of a communication sent by senior IPS officer Rashmi Shukla on the issue of corruption in police transfers and postings, but the SID had refused to provide them claiming it was part of an ongoing investigation.

The high court had on July 22 held that the CBI can inquire the allegations of corruption in transfers and postings of police personnel limited to its nexus with Deshmukh and had dismissed a petition filed by the Maharashtra government seeking that some parts of the central agency's FIR against the NCP leader be quashed. On April 21, the CBI had registered an FIR against Deshmukh on charges of corruption and misuse of official position. The FIR was filed after the agency conducted a preliminary inquiry against the state's former home minister following an order from the high court on April 5. Deshmukh had resigned from the post of state home minister the same day, but denied any wrongdoing. (PTI)

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Priyanka attacks BJP, calls for increasing sugarcane price to benefit farmers

NEW DELHI, SEPT 2 --/ Congress leader Priyanka Gandhi Vadra hit out at the ruling BJP today over the rising prices of cooking gas, petrol and diesel, and also

alleged that there has been no increase in the price of sugarcane procurement from farmers in the last three years.

While she did not clarify whether her attack was aimed at the Uttar Pradesh government or the Centre, the Narendra Modi dispensation last week increased the minimum price that the sugar mills pay to sugarcane growers by Rs 5 to Rs 290 per quintal for

the next marketing year starting October 2021. The Congress general secretary said the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) government is increasing the price of LPG cylinders every month, and petrol and diesel prices have been hiked 60 to 70 times in three-four months.

"But the sugarcane price for farmers has not increased for three years?" she tweeted in Hindi with the hashtags "mehegne din" (expensive days) and "ganne ke daam badhao" (increase the prices of sugarcane). Priyanka Gandhi had raised the issue last week also, stating that despite a regular increase in the prices of diesel and electricity for farmers in Uttar Pradesh, the price of sugarcane in the state has not seen any rise for three years.
