We took giant leap with the Tejas: IAF

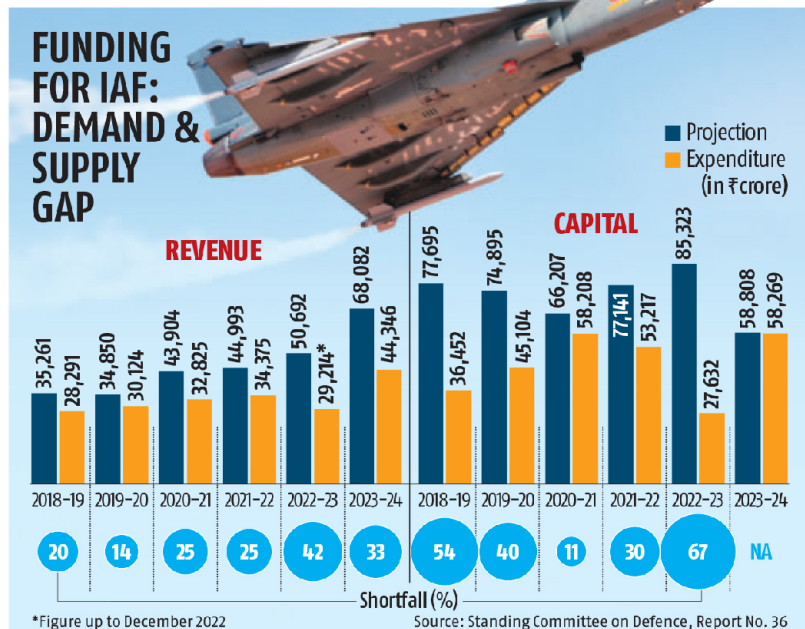

As is the case with the Army and the Navy, the Indian Air Force's (IAF's) Budget allocations for the Financial Year 2022-23 (FY23) are significantly lower than its projections, according to the 36th Report of the 17th Lok Sabha's Standing Committee on Defence.

In five of the last six years, the IAF's revenue allocations were 20-42 per cent less than what it projected as demands for those years.

The situation is even bleaker for the IAF's capital allocations, in which the IAF received 40-67 per cent less than its projected figure. While the defence ministry expects that the IAF's order for 123 Tejas light combat aircraft (LCA) will galvanise the indigenous aerospace manufacturing eco-system, the Standing Committee on Defence asked the IAF if it was comfortable with inducting so many varieties of fighters. The report quotes an IAF officer as responding, "In every air force, we will have a mix of all types of aircraft because every aircraft has a certain role. You cannot have all aircraft of one class. As far as LCA is concerned, it does fit in. We have to remember that it was designed as a replacement for MIG-21. The aircraft has come up quite well. It is meeting those requirements quite well. Yes, if you ask, everybody would like to have an all-fifth generation aircraft. But we have to see what we can get, what is available in the market."

The IAF officer also said there was a need to give a fillip to India's aerospace industry. "We also have to see what will happen tomorrow. If we keep buying (fighter aircraft) from the open market, we will never become self-reliant. So, we need to give a push to our own industry. We need to hold their hands and the IAF is committed towards that. We will



make a happy mix and that is why we are going in for a MRFA (multi-role fighter aircraft) contract for 114 aircraft," said the IAF officer.

On the LCA project delays, an IAF representative told the Standing Committee, "The last (fighter) aircraft that we designed was the Marut (in the 1950s). So, after a gap of over 30 years, we are trying to make a fighter aircraft in-house. We took a giant leap. LCA is a generation four-plus aircraft. We could have gone for a third-generation aircraft with the conventional controls and rudimentary dials and old avionics but we had to catch up with (global) technology. It was a very good step, though we have taken longer than we should have." "We were learning our lessons. We can-

not call them failures but there are a lot of roadblocks. Then, the sanctions came in after our nuclear test (in 1998). That caused a lot of drawbacks. That is where we started thinking that we should have most of the technologies in-house," the IAF pilot said. "But the fly-by-wire system of that aircraft and the entire control laws have been written by Indians in-house. In the avionics, the entire architecture is Indian, and it has been revised once fully. That means what we conceived in the beginning and what we are flying today are two different architectures," the pilot added.

The Standing Committee sought an explanation on the sharp decline in this year's BE projection, compared to the previous year.

"Our projection last year was ₹85,000 crore and we got an allocation of ₹57,000 crore, which we consumed. This year, the projection has been less because of the Russia-Ukraine war," the officer said.

Firms propose ₹1,000 cr to redevelop 5 bus ports

The Uttar Pradesh (UP) government has received private investment proposals worth ₹1,000 crore to redevelop state bus terminals as 'bus ports'.

The proposals have come for five of the 23 state bus stations lined up for the ambitious 'bus port' makeover under the public-private partnership (PPP) model. According to an official source, the bus stations of Ghaziabad, Lucknow, Prayagraj, and Agra districts have netted private sector investment. "The work on these five terminals will begin after getting the nod from the state government," he said.

Moreover, the process of selecting the private partner for the remaining 18 bus stations by the UP State Roadways Transport Corporation (UPSRTC) is underway.

Last year, the Adityanath Cabinet approved the proposal to develop 23 bus stations in big cities as 'bus ports' on the lines of airports so that passengers can avail of modern amenities with the UPSRTC earning higher revenue with the help of private sector investment.

Last month, the 'bus port' tenders were floated for these 23 bus stations (located in Lucknow, Ghaziabad, Agra, Prayagraj, Varanasi, Gorakhpur, and Kanpur districts),

of which developers for five bus terminals are selected. Subsequently, redevelopment plans for 75 districts would be rolled out.

The envisioned 'bus ports' will comprise modern hotels, restaurants, shopping malls, leisure spots, etc, and conform to international standards with special boarding ramps for bus passengers.

UP Transport Minister Dayashankar Singh said the project would completely redefine the surface transport landscape and equip the state bus terminals with passenger-friendly infra and services.

Besides, the UPSRTC is working on its mega plan to add new buses to its fleet before the Maha Kumbh 2025 in Prayagraj. It plans to procure more than 5,000 new buses to replace old vehicles ahead of the mega congregation of humanity.

The project is estimated to cost nearly ₹2,000 crore. The UPSRTC will procure 2,000 buses between April 2023 and March 2024, and another 1,500 between April 2024 and December 2024. The remaining buses would be bought after that. Currently, there are about 11,200 buses in the UPSRTC fleet.

The state government has estimated that 400 million devotees will visit Prayagraj during the Maha Kumbh. In 2019, 240 million visitors arrived for the Prayagraj Kumbh.

RAJASTHAN

'Over 18K got jobs in IT fairs in 2 weeks'

Over 18,000 youngsters have landed jobs during two IT job fairs organised by the Rajasthan government in the capital city of Jaipur and in Bharatpur in the last two weeks, state officials claimed.

At least 70 companies, which were present during the job fair in Bharatpur on March 23-24, selected 5,700 youngsters out of the total 25,000 who took part in the event, the officials said. In Jaipur, 12,500 aspirants landed jobs at the fair — also called Rajasthan 'DigiFest' — between March 20 and 21. According to an official, a youth bagged an offer of ₹36 lakh per annum. "We are getting very good response from youths in these job fairs," a state government official said. Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot recently announced to organise 100 job fairs in one year. As part of this initiative, job fairs will be organized in every district.

"I got a job in an IT company at a job fair organised in Jaipur. I feel more job fairs should be organised," Vijay Meena, a commerce graduate said.

MADHYA PRADESH

6,000 to get first-hand training on drone use

The state government is promoting the use of drones in agriculture as part of farm modernisation and training youths in operating them.

In a recent cabinet meeting, the government approved the implementation of the "Skill Development Scheme" in agricultural mechanisation. Under this scheme, drone schools are being set up to increase the use of modern equipment. In the next three years, 6,000 youngsters from farmer families will be trained to operate large drones in farming.

This will help them to be self-employed. For this, about ₹23 crore has been allotted. The first drone school in the state has opened in Gwalior. Schools are also to start in

Indore, Bhopal, Jabalpur, and Satna. At the inauguration of this school, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan had said: "The use of drones will increase in the future and the schools will open up avenues of employment. The drone is being used very well in agriculture and this can be taken forward."

During the spraying of pesticides and fertilisers in the fields, there is a danger to health. Also, uneven spraying affects crops. Drones are helpful in this. The same amount of spraying can be done in less time."

Agriculture Minister Kamal Patel said: "When I saw the demonstration of spraying nano urea by drones, I realised they could be used for pesticide spraying and other works. Production will increase, and, consequently, the income of the farmers."

CHHATTISGARH

Nagri Dubraj rice variety gets GI tag

The Geographical Indication Registry earlier this week granted Chhattisgarh's aromatic rice, Nagri Dubraj, a geographical indication (GI) tag facilitating the brand to get a unique identity and a wide market.

Union Agriculture Minister, Narendra Singh Tomar in a tweet, said the Morena and Rewa Mango (both Madhya Pradesh) and Nagri Dubraj have been given GI tags. It will give a new identity to the products in the national and international market, Tomar added.

The authorities in Chhattisgarh have been making efforts to get the GI tag for Nagri Dubraj for a long time. The Indira Gandhi Agricultural University played a crucial role in getting the rights as it has been in constant correspondence with the authorities concerned, a state government spokesperson said. It is produced by a women's self-help group, the spokesperson added.

London: Russian and Belarusian players will be able to compete at Wimbledon as neutral athletes after the All England Club on Friday reversed its ban from last year. The players must sign declarations of neutrality and comply with

"appropriate conditions," including not expressing support for Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Australian Open champion Aryna Sabalenka of Belarus and Russian players Daniil Medvedev and Andrey Rublev are among the players who can return.

Taylor backs Indian pace attack

India have the pace attack to trouble Australia in the World Test Championship final in England even if Jasprit Bumrah remains sidelined through injury, feels WTC winner Ross Taylor.

Spin was the key weapon as India beat Australia 2-1 in the recent Test series on home soil but pace bowlers are expected to lead both attacks when the teams clash again in the WTC Final in June.

Mohammad Shami was the pick of India's quicks with nine wickets in the recent series against Australia, while Umesh Yadav took three scalps in two matches and Mohammed Siraj claimed just one victim from 24 overs across three Tests.

Bumrah is in serious doubt for the WTC Final this time after being sidelined with a back stress fracture and last playing for India in September 2022.

Chelsea, Wolfsburg in semis

The Blues will next take on Barcelona in a rematch of the 2021 final

Chelsea goalkeeper Ann-Katrin Berger saved two penalties to help them knock out title holder Lyon 4-3 in a shootout and reach the semi-finals of the Women's Champions League after a suspenseful and hard-fought contest at Stamford Bridge on Thursday.

It was a bad evening for French clubs as Paris Saint-Germain also exited the tournament with a 2-1 loss on aggregate against Wolfsburg.

Chelsea was on the verge of elimination after Sara Dabritz gave the eight-time champions the lead in extra time with a left-footed shot after she connected with a cross from Ada Hegerberg.

But the French team could not hold onto its advantage as it conceded a penalty deep in added time following contact between Lyon forward Vicki Becho on Lauren James on the left of the box.

The penalty was awarded



following a VAR check. After a long delay, Maren Mjelde took the kick and scored to force a shootout. Berger stopped Lyon captain Wendie Renard's effort and then parried away Lindsey Horan's shot, prompting huge celebrations from her teammates.

The Blues will next take on Barcelona in a rematch of the 2021 final.

Lyon headed to London

trailing 1-0 from the first leg and waited until the 77th to level the tie when Vanessa Gilles beat Berger at the near post.

Two-time champion Wolfsburg made it to the last four for the second year in a row. After the German team won 1-0 at the Parc des Princes last week, Alexandra Popp's goal in the 20th minute proved decisive in front of 14,367 fans at

the VW Arena despite Kadidatou Diani's equalizer 10 minutes later for PSG.

Wolfsburg hit the woodwork three times.

"We are mega happy and mega proud, it was a tough fight," Popp told broadcaster DAZN.

"We fought our way in, took the duels. The first goal was extremely important for us."

Unbeaten in eight Champions League matches this season, Wolfsburg will face Arsenal in April's semifinals after the London club advanced Wednesday by beating Bayern Munich 2-0 at Emirates Stadium to overturn a 1-0 deficit from the first leg.
