The consolidated unaudited financial results include the Interim financial information of joint venture company consolidated up to 24 May 2019, which has not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information reflect share of loss of the group of Rs. 450 up to the date of consolidation. According to the information and explanations given to us by the Management, this interim financial information is not material to the Group. Our Conclusion on the Statement is not modified in respect of our reliance on the interim financial information results certified by the Management in respect of this joint venture company.

Expenses incurred by the Company, amounting to Rs. 28,577.56 (Rs. in1000s), in connection with the IPO have been adjusted towards the securities premium in accordance with Section 52 of the Companies Act, 2013.

IPO proceeds not of IPO related expenses which remain unutilised as at December 31, 2019 temporarily invested in short term liquid funds Rs.1,21,427.96 (Rs. in 000s) and with banks Rs.1,353.79 (Rs. in 1000s).

 Prepaid rent of Rs. 552.25 (Rs. in 1000s) has been reclassified to right-to-use asset pursuant to transition to Ind AS 116.

The company has adopted modified retrospective approach as per para C8 (c)(ii) of IND AS 116 - Leases to its leases, effective from annual reporting period beginning 1stApril, 2019. This has resulted in recognizing a right of use assets (an amount equal to the lease liability, adjusted by the prepaid lease rent) of Rs.10,095.30 (Rs. in 1000s) as at 1st April. 2019 In the statement of profit and loss for the current period, operating lease expenses has changed from rent to depreciation cost for the right of use assets and finance cost for interest accrued on lease liability. To this extent performance for the current period 31\*December, 2019 is not comparable with previous period results.

- 5. The recent Supreme Court ruling on 28 February, 2019, held that 'allowances', paid by employer to its employees, will be included in the scope of 'basic wages' and hence subject to Provident Fund contributions. Further, a review petition has been filed by Mrs Surya Roshni before the Supreme Court contesting that past circulars issued by Employee Provident Fund Department confirm that many of the allowances are not basic wages. The result of the review petition is awaited. The Company is waiting for the outcome of the review to provide for. The quantum of potential liability on account of the above said ruling as at December 31, 2019 is of Rs. 61.04 (Rs. in 1000s).
- 6. The Company is required to disclose segment information based on the 'management approach' as defined in Ind AS 108. Operating Segments, which in how the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM) evaluates the Company's performance and allocates resources based on the analysis of the various performance indicators. In the case of the Company, the CODM reviews the results of the Company as a whole as the Company is primarily engaged in the business of software development services. Accordingly, the Company is a single CGU, hence single segment. The information as required under Ind AS 108 is available directly from the financial results, hence no separate disclosure on segment information is given in these standalone financial results.
- The principal business of the company is to provide technology services and solutions, the company does not fall into the definition of Non-Banking Finance Company as per the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934.
- 8. The Company does not have any exceptional items to report for the above periods.

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- The Board of Directors at their meeting have not recommended any dividend.
- 10. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs vide notification dated October 11, 2018 has amended Schedule III to the Companies Act, 2013 in respect of certain disclosures. The Company has incorporated appropriate changes in the above standalone financial results.

The recent Supreme Court ruling on 28 February, 2019, held that 'allowances', paid by employer to its employees, will be included in the scope of 'basic wages' and hence subject to Provident Fund contributions. Further, a review petition has been filed by M/s Surya Roshni before the Supreme Court contesting that past circulars issued by Employee Provident Fund Department confirm that many of the allowances are not basic wages. The result of the review petition is awaited. The Group is waiting for the outcome of the review to provide for. The quantum of potential liability on account of the above said ruling as at December 11, 2019 is of Rs. 61.04 (Rs. in 1000s).
