Amid Bihar shuffle of cards, Kishor gears up to pull an ace

His party may contest 2025 Bihar polls

IN THE portico of Sheikhpura House of Patna's Bailey Road, young men with notepads and pens sit on neatly arranged chairs, waiting anxiously. Bihar is in the midst of a political upheaval with Chief Minister Nitish Kumar forming a new alliance with the RJD. Only a few kilometers away, top leaders of the BJP are protesting at their party office at Birchand Patel Path.

Minutes later, the doors of the bungalow open and Prashant Kishor, arguably India's most-sought-after election strategist in recent times, walks out. He addresses the eager youngsters for the next hour and a half even as media persons wait inside for his views on the political developments in the state. It's a busy day for the former JD(U) national vice president.

In fact, his days have been packed since May with Kishor working on building his own party -- the newest player in a state whose politics has for long revolved round the faces who came up during the JP Movement.

According to sources, Kishor's political party -- expected to

come into existence latest by mid-2024 -- is likely to contest the 2025 Bihar Assembly elections.

"We have been watching Bihar politics from above, now it is time to land," a Kishor team member told The Indian Express.

Through a movement named 'Jan Suraj' launched in May this year, Kishor has already embarked on shaping his party, which, he has claimed, is an attempt to give Bihar a political alternative that can rise above caste politics and address some of the core issues behind Bihar's underdevelopment.

As part of the party-building exercise, Kishor has already held about 150-200 public meetings in various districts of Bihar, along with a padyatra beginning October 2, during which he will criss-cross the entire state, reaching every panchayat and block to meet people. The padyatra, according to Kishor, is expected to be completed within a year and a half, following which the party will be launched.

BIHAR CABINET EXPANSION

Nitish set to retain Home, keep most ministers; RJD may get Finance, Health

RJD could get 15 ministerial berths, JD(U) 12, and Cong two

THE BIHAR Cabinet expansion is likely to take place on Tuesday, with the Janata Dal (United) of Chief Minister Nitish Kumar likely to retain most of its ministers, barring a name or two, and the Rashtriya Janata Dal's (RJD) appointments reflecting an attempt to move beyond the party's Muslim-Yadav (MY) core constituency and match its "A to Z" slogan on the politics of assimilation.

Sources in the RJD said the party might get 15 ministers, ally Congress two ministerial berths, and the JD(U) 12 ministers. The Nitish Kumar-led party may also seek a ministerial berth for independent MLA Sumit Kumar Singh from Chakai in Jamui district who was the science and technology minister in the previous Cabinet. The Bihar government can have a total of 36 ministers.

The JD(U) is likely to keep the portfolios of Home (it was with Nitish in the previous administration), Vigilance, Education, Building Construction, Minority Affairs, Social Welfare, and Water

Resources and the RJD may get Finance, Commercial Taxes, Health, Road Construction, Disaster Management, and Environment and Forest. The RJD-JD(U) agreement on ministries is likely to be similar to the one Nitish had with the BJP.

The list of probable ministers from the RJD includes Tej Pratap Yadav, Surendra Yadav, Ramanand Yadav, Bhavi Virendra, Lalit Yadav, Anita Devi, Kumar Sarjeyat, Alok Mehta, Mohammed Shamim, Shahnavaz Alam, Sudhakar Singh, and Samir Mahaseth or Sanjay

Gupta. Though there is likely to be a dominant Yadav presence in the Cabinet from the RJD quota, the party is also trying to accommodate non-Yadav OBC leaders and Dalits in the ministerial council.

Sources said Sanjay Jha, former water resources minister, was openly named at a meeting as one of the four persons responsible for taking Nitish back to the NDA in 2017. At present "though there is still no clarity if Jha will be retained, what cango in his favour is the key role he played in bringing Ganga water to Nalanda and Gaya".

MAHARASHTRA PORTFOLIO ALLOCATION

Fadnavis gets Home, Finance; CM retains Urban Development

MAHARASHTRA CHIEF Minister Eknath Shinde allocated portfolios to his 18 Cabinet ministers on Sunday, a week after they were sworn in.

Governor Bhagat Singh Koshiyari approved the portfolio distribution in the evening.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) ensured that the majority of important portfolios were allocated to it with Fadnavis managing to keep both Home and Finance departments. CM Shinde kept the Urban Development Department (UDD), which he handled in the previous MVA government. He will handle Information and Technology, Public Works (Public undertakings), Transport, Marketing, Social Justice, Relief and Rehabilitation, Disaster management, Soil and water conservation, Environment and Minority Affairs.

Apart from Home, and Finance, Fadnavis has Law and Judiciary, Irrigation, Housing, Power and Protocol.

The portfolio distribution shows that despite nine ministers each from both sides, the BJP has managed to hold on to the majority of important departments. Shinde has restarted the tradition of CM holding the UDD portfolio, which was stopped by then CM Uddhav Thackeray. Thackeray had appointed Shinde as the UDD minister, unlike his predecessors. He has also kept Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation, which is involved in some of the biggest projects, including multi-thousand crore Nagpur-Mumbai super communication highway.

Among the 18 Cabinet ministers, Radhakrishna Vikhe-Patil will handle Revenue, Animal Husbandry and Dairy development. Maharashtra BJP's ex-president Chandrakant Patil will be Higher and Technical Education, Textile and Parliamentary Affairs minister while former finance minister Sudhir Mungantiwar will be Forest, Cultural Affairs and Fisheries minister.

Dy CM gets the keys to Cabinet with portfolios from his previous term

EVEN AS Eknath Shinde is the Chief Minister of Maharashtra, with both the BJP and Shinde faction of the Shiv Sena gets an equal allocation of nine ministerial berths each, Sunday's portfolio allocation sends out a clear signal: that the keys of this cabinet will be held by BJP leader and Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis.

Apart from Urban Development, which has been retained by the CM, all other important portfolios -- Home, Finance, Energy and Housing -- have gone to Fadnavis. For any coalition government, the tussle is usually confined to the top four portfolios -- Urban Development, Home, Finance and Revenue. Of these four, Shinde only got Urban Development. The remaining three are with the BJP -- two with Fadnavis and the third, Revenue, with senior BJP leader Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil, considered a key Fadnavis hand.

Sources said Vikhe Patil, the former Opposition leader from the Congress who joined the BJP in July 2019, has been rewarded with the Revenue portfolio for his "loyalty to Fadnavis". Revenue is usually the most desired post after CM and

Deputy CM. A crucial ministry that monitors developments across 355 talukas covering 40,000-plus villages in Maharashtra, it is considered the backbone of any government as it helps control state administration at the grass roots.

Fadnavis, who was forced to settle for the Deputy CM post, has been entrusted with greater responsibilities. The BJP, which has 106 MLAs, has managed to convince the Shinde Sena that it has the rightful claim over plum portfolios. The party has got Home, Finance, Housing, Energy, Revenue, Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development, Forest, Culture, Fisheries, Higher and Technical Education, Textile, Parliamentary Affairs, Rural Development, Panchayati Raj, Medical Education, Sports and Youth Welfare, Tribal Welfare, Labour, Public Works Department, Food and Civil supplies, Cooperative, OBC Welfare, Tourism, Skill Development, Women and Child Development, and Protocol.

Minister to govt staff: Answer calls with Vande Mataram, not hella

Mumbai: Maharashtra's new cultural affairs minister Sudhir Mungantiwar wants government employees to answer their phone calls with 'Vande Mataram' and not with the foreign word 'hello'.

"This is the 75th year of Indian independence and to mark the achievement, all officers and employees in government offices

will start the telephonic conversations by saying 'Vande Mataram and not hella', said Mungantiwar, hours after cabinet portfolio distribution was announced.

"Vande Mataram is our national song. It is not just a word but a symbol of the sentiments of Indians towards Mother India," he said.

Manipuri warrior shown as tribal freedom fighter, comic publisher issues apology

AMAR CHITRA Katha Executive Editor Reena Puri on Sunday issued an apology for including Manipuri military hero Paonam Brajabasi in their collection "Tribal Leaders of the Freedom Struggle" as part of the Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebration.

The apology comes two days after four Imphal-based student bodies -- AMSU, MSF, KSA and

SUK -- banned the comic book, objecting to the inclusion of Brajabasi in the edition.

Brajabasi was a military officer in the Manipuri kingdom of Kangleipak and fought against the British in the Anglo-Manipur war of 1891. It is believed that Brajabasi received an offer to work for the British and when he refused, he was executed.

"The 1891 war has nothing to do with the Indian freedom struggle. The Manipuri military was defending our kingdom. Then how could it be included in this book? Manipuris are not tribals, so how could the government include

Brajabasi's story in a book about tribal freedom fighters?" Joint Students Coordination Committee convener S Bidyannanda told The Indian Express.

In the apology, Puri said: "Amar Chitra Katha regrets the use of the story of the Manipuri warrior, Paonam Brajabasi, in their collection... The name of the warrior was inadvertently placed in the list of tribal warriors. We have removed the story from the collection and apologise for any distress caused..."

PROPHET ROW

Aide of JeM operative held

Lucknow: The Uttar Pradesh Anti-Terrorist Squad (ATS) on Sunday took in its custody an associate of a 24-year-old man who was arrested two days ago for allegedly having been ordered by terror group Jaish-e-Mohammed (JeM) to eliminate former BJP spokesperson Nupur Sharma.

On Friday, the agency had arrested Mohammad Nadeem from Saharanpur, claiming that he was in contact with several terror groups and was planning to attack government buildings and police premises. Nadeem confessed that he was asked to eliminate Sharma, the ATS claimed. The agency has decided to seek Habibul's custody remand to zero in on his links in India and abroad.

Maratha leader Mete killed in accident

ONE OF the leading Maratha voices demanding reservation for the community, former MLC Vinayak Mete, 59, died in a road accident on the Mumbai-Pune expressway early on Sunday.

Mete was on his way to Mumbai to meet Chief Minister Eknath Shinde to discuss issues concerning the community when his vehicle met with an accident around 5 am near Madap tunnel

close to Khalapur toll plaza. who was accompanying Mete, the driver lost control over the wheel

after a truck changed lanes. The left side of the car hit the truck. The impact was such that the entire left side of the car was damaged. Kadam claimed that he tried to call for medical help but had to wait for an hour. Chief Minister Shinde ordered an inquiry into the allegations. Mete was from Rajegاون village in Beed district's Kej thesil and belonged to a family that did not have any background in politics. He became a leader of the Maratha Mahasangh and entered the state legislative council in 1995.
