

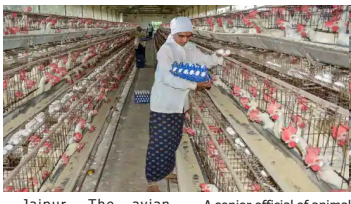

Bird flu: Samples found positive from 2 more Rajasthan districts



A senior official of animal husbandry department said that since December 26,

Jaipur, The avian influenza (bird flu) has spread to a total of 13 districts in Rajasthan with the samples of dead birds from Sirohi and Pratappgarh found positive on Sunday. The samples from districts such as Jhalawar, Kota, Baran, Sawai Madhopur, Jaipur, Chittorgarh, Banswara, Hanumangarh, Dausa, Pali and Jaisalmer have already been confirmed with bird flu. The test report identifies avian influenza subtype H5N8 in the birds, which according to experts is less infectious. The death of birds continues to be reported across Rajasthan but no case of bird flu has been found in chickens yet. Fatalities in birds is spreading at an alarming rate across the state - the cumulative tally reached 2950, with 428 deaths reported today.

around 2,166 birds have died with majority of them being crows (2289) followed by peacocks (170), pigeon (156), and 335 other birds. A total of 226 samples have been sent from 24 districts, he said, adding that the random samples of migratory birds and chickens are taken as a precaution. "No confirmation of bird flu diseases is found in chickens," he said. The first-ever incident of bird flu in Rajasthan is a serious concern of the government, especially when the people are already struggling with Covid-19 pandemic. Bird flu (avian influenza) caused by the virus is contagious and fatal.

Random bird deaths trigger Bird Flu concerns in Patna, authorities cautious

Patna, An owl was found dead near Rajeev Gandhi Park on Friday, a day after a crow was found dead; triggering concerns among residents amid the Bird Flu outbreak in several states. "An owl death has been reported today in Rajeev Nagar locality. Prima facie, it doesn't indicate a bird flu case. We have collected samples which will be sent to virology labs for detailed examination," said Dr MA Shabbir, district animal husbandry officer of Patna. On Thursday, a crow was found dead inside the Bihar Working Journalists Union campus, at Lodipur in the state capital.

Dr Umesh, director of the Institute of Animal Health and Production, said, "The carcass of the crow was old. So it was difficult to ascertain the reason of death. Collected samples were sent for a test. Results are still awaited. So far, there is no confirmed case of bird flu in Patna."

Youth suspected of killing mother, her live-in partner in Jaipur rural

Jaipur, A couple in a live-in relationship were allegedly shot dead in Jaipur rural area on Saturday morning. Rajasthan police suspects the duo was killed by the son of the murdered woman (40) as he was unhappy with his mother's relationship with a married man (41) with five children. The killings took place in a house located in Shiv Colony near Kotputli town. Senior policemen including Jaipur rural superintendent of police (SP) Shankar Dutt Sharma, along with a dog squad and a forensics team, reached the spot soon after the incident. "Body of the couple with bullet shots on their head was recovered from a room of the house. We suspect that the 20-year-old son of the lady is behind the murder and we have formed teams to nab him," said Sharma.

Ahmedabad defies trend to witness 7% price growth in Dec quarter: PropTiger report

Ahmedabad, Even though new launches and home sales numbers have fallen to see any improvement in Ahmedabad, in the October-December period of 2020 which is the much-touted festive season, the city has defied a general trend to witness value appreciation, shows Real Insight: Q4 2020, a quarterly analysis of India's right prime residential markets by brokerage firm PropTiger.com. "While the government and the RBI have been launching several measures to improve the overall health of housing markets, some markets are going to take longer than the other because of various factors. Even though the Ahmedabad housing market has yet to see the full benefit of a low interest rate regime and increased policy support, we expect the demand to improve as soon as normalcy is restored post the arrival of the coronavirus vaccine in India," says Mani Rangarajan, Group CMO, Housing.com, Makaan.com and PropTiger.com. A total of 3,003 fresh units were launched in Ahmedabad during the quarter, reflecting a 4% quarterly and 10% annual decline. Ahmedabad was in fact the only city that witnessed a quarterly decline in launch numbers. In the national launches, Ahmedabad contributed only 6% to the overall share. A similar trend was visible on the demand side, too. With the sale of 3,125 units, housing sales declined by 6% QoQ while plunging 48% annually. In the national sales, the city contributed only 5%. While Gota, Bopal, and Chandkheda were the most prominent localities that witnessed maximum new supply in 2020, Bopal, Chandkheda, Nava Naroda, Vatva and Vastral were the most prominent areas in terms of sales during the quarter.
