3 Gujarat cops accused of trying to extort money after freezing bank accounts for 'probe'

AHMEDABAD, JAN 27 /--/ A case of extortion was registered in Gujarat's Junagadh district on Friday against two police inspectors and an assistant sub inspector (ASI) for allegedly trying to extort Rs 25 lakh from a Kerala resident for unfreezing his bank account.

The First Information Report was registered after internal probe revealed

that the accused trio had frozen some 335 bank accounts on the pretext of investigation and tried to extort money from one of the account holders when he approached them, said a police official here. Based on a complaint filed by inspector S N Gohil from the office of Inspector General (IG) of Junagadh Range Nilesh Jajadia, Junagadh 'B' Division police registered the FIR against town police inspector Taral Bhatt, inspector with the

cyber crime cell of Junagadh Special Operations Group (SOG) A M Gohil, and ASI Dipak Jani. Indian Penal Code sections 167 (public servant framing an incorrect document with intent to cause injury), 465 (forgery), 385 (putting a person in fear for extortion), 120b (criminal

conspiracy) besides relevant sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act were invoked in the FIR, said inspector S N Gohil, the complainant.

"Both A M Gohil and Jani have already been suspended from service. No arrests have been made yet," he said. As per the FIR, Kartik Bhandari, a resident of Kerala, learnt in December 2023 that his bank account had been

frozen by the bank. (PTI)

Meritocracy has replaced autocracy: Dhankhar to NSS volunteers

NEW DELHI, JAN 27 /--/ Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar on Saturday said meritocracy has replaced autocracy and nepotism in the country and youngsters today have more opportunities to achieve their goals. Interacting with National Service Scheme (NSS) volunteers here, he also said that equality before the law has now been truly established, unlike in the past where some people thought they were above it. The ecosystem of corruption and middlemen has been dismantled and youngsters have immense opportunities to realise their potential, Dhankhar said. "The autocracy of corruption has been replaced with the meritocracy of democracy," he said. The NSS volunteers were part of an all-women contingent that participated in the Republic Day parade on Friday. Describing youngsters as the foot soldiers who will help India become a developed country by 2047, he urged them to be innovative and focus on research and entrepreneurship. (PTI)

LS polls: Election department begins preparations in Rajasthan with first level checking of EVMs

JAIPUR, JAN 27 /--/ With the first level checking of the electronic voting machines, the Election department has started the preparations for the upcoming Lok Sabha elections in Rajasthan, an official said on Saturday. Chief Electoral Officer Praveen Gupta in a statement said the Election department has started the process of preparations for the Lok Sabha elections in the state with the first level checking (FLC) of the electronic voting machines (EVMs). He said the first level checking of the EVMs is necessary for fair, free and transparent elections. Gupta said that as per the instructions of the Election Commission of India, the first level checking work of EVM/VVPAT machines for the Lok Sabha elections has been started by the engineers of the Bharat Electronics Limited, Bengaluru, from January 27 in all the districts of the state. This work is likely to be completed on February 20, he added. Gupta said this work will be done in the presence of recognised national and state political parties. EVM refers to Ballot Unit (BU), Control Unit (CU) and VVPAT. About 83,000 BU, 73,000 CU and 73,000 VVPAT machines will be checked (FLC) by 274 engineers in the districts of the state. (PTI)

Telangana govt to take up caste census soon: CM Revanth Reddy

HYDERABAD, JAN 27 /--/ Telangana Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy on Saturday said the state government would soon take up the caste census as promised to people before elections.

Reddy, who held a meeting on issues concerning minorities, backward classes and tribal welfare departments, directed officials to take steps for carrying out the caste census, an official release said. The CM also asked officials to prepare budget estimates for implementing 'Kalyanamastu' scheme of providing one tola gold in addition to financial assistance of Rs one lakh to girls from BPL families at the time of their marriage. He directed officials to prepare estimates on the funds required for all types of government welfare hostels being run by the government. He said funds would be released in 'green channel' (expeditious release of funds) as per the estimated expenditure. He instructed officials to furnish details on the government residential schools which are being run in rented buildings and also to identify lands for construction of own buildings. He said the funds required for construction of buildings can also be estimated. The CM also suggested officials study the proposals for establishment of a coaching centre for backward classes for one Parliamentary constituency. He also told officials to set up an 'integrated education hub' comprising SC, ST, BC welfare residential educational institutions instead of having them separately. This would help in better maintenance and supervision, the release added. (PTI)

Clash over statue in MP: 19 held so far, situation peaceful: Police

UJJAIN, JAN 27 /--/ Police have so far arrested 19 persons in connection with a clash over a statue in Madhya Pradesh's Ujjain district, and the situation is peaceful in the area amid heavy presence of cops, an official said on Saturday. Members of two communities had clashed and pelted stones at each other after a statue of former deputy prime minister Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel was pulled down by unidentified persons in Makdona tehsil on Thursday morning. A total of 19 persons have been arrested so far in connection with the clash,

Additional Superintendent of Police (ASP-Rural) Nitesh Bhargava. They have been booked for rioting and using criminal force to deter a public servant from performing their duty. He said markets are open in Makdona, and the situation is normal in the town. There is peace between both groups, but the police are keeping an eye on the situation, he said, and added that the status quo remains intact at the disputed site. No injuries were reported in Thursday's clash. However, it prompted authorities to deploy police personnel in large numbers in the Makdona

area, located about 50 km from the district headquarters. In a video of the incident, which went viral on social media, a group of people was seen pulling down the statue with a tractor. They wanted a statue of social reformer and the Constitution's chief architect Dr B R Ambedkar to be installed at the site, instead of Patel's, police sources had said. The statue of Patel was installed at a site close to the Makdona bus stand on Wednesday night, they said. Bhargava said on Friday that they were still trying to find out when the statue was installed. (PTI)

Derogatory content against PM, Centre in stage show on R-Day: 2 Kerala HC officials suspended

KOCHI, JAN 27 /--/ The Kerala High Court has suspended two of its officials from service for allegedly showing derogatory content and criticising Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Central government in a stage show performed on Republic Day. The Registrar General of the High Court said that both the officials - one an Assistant Registrar (higher grade) and the other a Court Keeper (higher grade) - shall be on suspension, with immediate effect, pending an enquiry into the incident and resultant disciplinary action. "They (the two officials) shall return all government properties held by them, if any, including the identity card issued to them," the Registrar General said in the order issued on Friday. The order also stated that the Chief Justice had directed the Registrar (Vigilance) to carry out a detailed enquiry about the incident and submit a report at the earliest. "The Registrar (Administration) is directed to furnish a detailed explanation as to the circumstances in which the above said incident took place," it said. During the period of suspension, the two shall be paid the subsistence allowance and other allowances admissible as per the relevant rules in practice, the order said.

On Saturday, the High Court issued a statement saying that the committee in charge of the conduct of the Republic Day

celebrations had given clear instructions that the stage show should be "one based on national integration and that it should convey the message of national unity. The committee further reiterated that it should be one upholding the spirit and essence of the day of national importance. "The High Court having noticed that the show has been performed in total disregard to the instructions given by the committee, disciplinary actions have been initiated against the members of the staff who were part of the show," the statement said. The action against the two officials was taken following a complaint to the Kerala High Court Chief Justice A J Desai by the Ernakulam Legal Cell. The complaint stated that staff of the High Court and the Advocate General's (AG) office performed a skit "with an intention to defame the country". "The dialogues of the skit, mainly aiming to criticise the leaders and administrative heads of the country, especially depicting the words and style of the Prime Minister, is highly derogatory. "The skit further misrepresents the dignity of the country. The nature of the connotations is highly condemnable," it said and demanded strict action against the erring staff. Visuals of the skit on a TV channel showed one of the performers acting as the prime minister. The stage show was performed on Republic Day in the High Court Auditorium here. (PTI)
