'PM chanting Ram, Ram, but ignoring real issues'

Kharge Hits Out At BJP As Rahul Kickstarts Yatra

Imphal: Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge on Sunday accused Prime Minister Narendra Modi of chanting the name of Lord Ram for political gains, while ignoring the real issues of the country like the Manipur crisis and joblessness—a jibe that appeared to target BJP's overdrive over the upcoming pran pratishtha of the Ayodhya temple for which the Congress has declined the invitation. Kharge said, "He takes a leisurely walk at the sea shore, and then sits at some places to chant 'Ram, Ram, Ram, Ram'. All we want is that he should not indulge in 'muh mein Ram, bagal mein chhuri' (God on the lips, and dagger hiding in the arm)."

"We all have faith in God and we all remember Him. But please don't do it for votes. One should not indulge in such hypocrisy for gaining

Amroha MP Danish Ali, who was suspended by BSP last month on charges of "anti-party activities", announced on Sunday that he was joining Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra, reports **Harveer Dabas**. Posting a message on 'X', he said: "I would be failing in my duty if I did not join the biggest drive for unity and justice. I was myself at the receiving end of an attack in Parliament, where swear words were used by a member of the ruling party against me and my religion. Rahul Gandhi ji was the first leader to express solidarity with me and stand by me and my family."

Kickstarting the Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra, Rahul told a gathering at Thoubal on the outskirts of Imphal, "Manipur has not remained as we knew it...mothers and siblings died in front of each other's eyes. And till date, the PM has not come here to wipe your tears. It is a matter of

shame. Maybe for Modi, BJP, RSS, Manipur is not part of India. Your pain is not theirs." The theme of "Modi visiting Manipur to ask for votes but staying away from it after ethnic violence" echoed across speeches through the day, but the Congress brass laid out the yatra's agenda of "justice" by targeting the PM over economic injustice.

'Cong must do justice to its leaders, refrain from divisive politics'

New Delhi: BJP on Sunday took a swipe at Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's 'Bharat Jodo Nyay Yatra' and said that the opposition party should first look at doing justice to its own party leaders and refrain from divisive politics before talking about "uniting" the country.

"Rahul Gandhi's campaign is not to unite but divide the country. This is another attempt to launch Congress's famous crown prince Rahul Gandhi, who has failed in every test. This is Rahul Gandhi's second journey of hatred and disintegration. Congress seems to be filled with hatred after construction of Shri Ram temple in Ayodhya," said BJP Rajya Sabha MP **Anil Baluni**.

He said the country had seen in Rahul's first yatra how he had spread hatred in society. "Also, he had taken along those working against the country in his journey. This is the reason why the remaining ground of Congress is also slipping away. We have seen

this in the form of Congress's crushing defeat in the recent assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh," the BJP functionary said. He said Rahul named his journey 'Nyaya Yatra' but first he should do justice to people of his party.

"Today itself, a big leader (Milind Deora) of theirs who was an MP has said goodbye to Congress. Many Congress leaders are continuously resigning. This is because the Congress leaders themselves do not have faith in the leadership of Rahul Gandhi," Baluni said.

Union minister Anurag Thakur said, "Congress's Nyaya Yatra is an illusion. Today, in the Congress where Rahul and Sonia Gandhi talk about providing justice to the people, it is Congress leaders who are not getting justice."

Recounting names, he said Kapil Sibal, Ghulam Nabi Azad, Ashwini Kumar, Himanta Biswa Sarma, Suresh Jadhav, RPN Singh, Anil Antony, Hardik Patel, Jyotiraditya Scindia and now Milind Deora had left Congress.
