HC grants 'last opportunity' to Centre to respond to pleas on Jamia violence

The Delhi High Court on Tuesday granted "one last opportunity" to the Centre to submit its response to a plea seeking transfer from Delhi Police to an independent agency the investigation into the cases related to

violence on the Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) campus in December 2019. Police personnel had entered the campus to control students' protests against the Citizenship (Amendment) Act. A Bench of Justices Siddharth Mridul and Talwant Singh asked the Centre to file within a week its reply to the application seeking the setting up of a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to probe alleged police atrocities during the protests.

The court was hearing a batch of petitions moved by lawyers, students of JMI and residents of Okhla in south Delhi against "erring police officers". It posted the matter for next hearing on December 13. Delhi Police had earlier defended its decision to enter the university, saying it was done to control the "aggravated form of unlawful assembly".

Trilokpuri murder: FSL team searches house for samples

A team of the Forensic Science Laboratory (FSL) reached Trilokpuri in east Delhi on Tuesday to collect samples from the refrigerator and bathroom of the house where a 45-year-old man was allegedly stabbed to death by his wife and stepson in May this year.

The accused, who were arrested on Saturday last, had allegedly dismembered the body of the victim, Anjan Das, into 10 pieces and stored them in their fridge before dumping them in a field less than a kilometre from their house. The mother-son duo had allegedly drained

the blood of the victim in their bathroom. A senior police officer said the FSL team will analyse the samples collected from the house and provide a report to police on whether they match with

the DNA sample of Anjan's children from his first wife in Bhagalpur, Bihar. Sources said the police have still not recovered the weapon of offence used by the accused to stab and dismember Anjan's body.

Mehrauli murder: Aftab's narco test likely tomorrow

Murder accused Aftab Poonawalla was subjected to the fifth round of polygraph test on Tuesday, and is likely to undergo a narco-analysis test on Thursday, police officers said.

Assistant Director of Forensic Science Laboratory, Rohini, Sanjeev Gupta said Aftab came to the FSL office around 10 a.m. and returned to Tihar jail by around 3 p.m. "He cooperated in the tests; we will send the report to the Delhi police in two to three days," Mr. Gupta said.

Check past records of drivers, police tell Uber

Delhi Police on Tuesday asked Uber to verify the past records of drivers before onboarding them and suggested that a mechanism be put in place to check their alcohol consumption levels.

Mr. Bharadwaj said a mechanism should be put in place to determine whether or not a driver is drunk. "We do the testing through an alcohol meter. Can Uber fix something closer to steering so that if a driver is drunk a notification for the same is received," he said.
