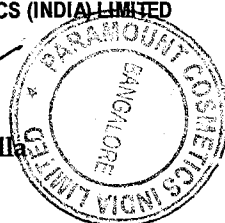

NOTES TO UNAUDITED STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER ENDED ON JUNE 30, 2020:

1. The unaudited Standalone Financial results have been reviewed and recommended by the audit committee at its meeting held on November 10, 2020 and approved by the Board of Directors at its board meeting held on November 10, 2020.
2. The requirement of AS-17th "Segment Reporting" is not applicable to the Company as it is engaged in single business segment.
3. The above unaudited Standalone Financial results have been prepared in accordance with the guidelines issued by the accounting standards as issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) and the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
4. The outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic globally and In India is causing significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activities. COVID-19 has caused interruption in production, supply chain disruption, on availability of manpower, etc., during the last week of March 2020 and thereafter. The management of the company has exercised due care in concluding significant accounting judgments and estimates in preparation of the financial results. In assessing recoverability of trade receivables, the company has considered subsequent recoveries, past trends, credit risk profiles of the customers and internal and external information available up to the date of issuance of these financial results. However, due to COVID-19 pandemic, the company could not obtain balance confirmation from its receivables. In assessing the recoverability of inventories, the company has considered the latest selling prices, customer orders on hand and margins. Based on the above assessment, the company is of the view that the carrying amounts of trade receivables and inventories are expected to be realizable to the extent shown in the financial results. Impact of COVID-19 is highly uncertain and may be different from the estimates as at the date of approval of these financial results and the company will continue to closely monitor any material changes in future economic conditions.

Further, the company has resumed its manufacturing operations at its plant at Shoolagiri, Tamil Nadu and believes that the same will be operated with normal capacity within reasonable period. The company's management has made initial assessment of likely adverse impact on the business and financial risk and believes that impact is likely to be short term in nature. The management does not see any medium to long term risk in the Company's ability to continue as a going concern and meeting its liabilities as and when they fall due.

5. The financial results for the first quarter ended June 30, 2020 has been affected due to COVID-19 pandemic. The management expects better profitability will be made in subsequent quarters for the financial year 2020-2021 from business operations and therefore no adjustments are required to be made in carrying value of the inventories as at June 30, 2020 which is being carried forward from March 31, 2020. The auditors have relied upon and accepted the assumptions and explanations provided by the management.
6. Previous period's figures have been regrouped/re-classified wherever necessary to make the same comparable.
7. The standalone financial results include the results for the quarter ended March 31 2020 being the balancing figure between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published unaudited year to date figures up to the third quarter of the financial year which were subjected to the limited review by the Statutory Auditor of the company.
8. The company is not having any subsidiary, associate or joint venture; therefore, it has prepared only standalone results.
9. Pursuant to the Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019 issued on September 20, 2019, corporate assesses have been given the option to apply lower income tax rate with effect from April 01 2019, subject to certain conditions specified therein. The Company has carried out an evaluation and based

on its forecasted profits, believes it will not be beneficial for the Company to choose the lower tax rate option in the near future. Accordingly, no effect in this regard has been considered in measurement of tax expense for the half year and year ended March 31, 2020. Management, however, will continue to review its profitability forecast at regular intervals and make necessary adjustments to tax expense when there is reasonable certainty to avail the beneficial (lower) rate of tax.

10. As per requirements of regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India, the company is required to publish standalone unaudited financial results. Investors can view the standalone unaudited financial results of the company for the first quarter ended on June 30, 2020 on the Company's website or on , the website of Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE).

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of **Paramount Cosmetics (India) Limited** (the "Company") for quarter ended June 30, 2020 (the "Statement") attached herewith being Submitted by the Company pursuant to the Requirements of Regulations 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the " Regulation"), as amended.
2. Attention is invited to the Note no. 5 of the notes on unaudited standalone financial results with regards to management expectation in respects of the better future prospects of business operations for the remaining quarters of the financial year 2020-21 which does not require any adjustments in carrying value of the inventories as at March 31, 2020.

The Auditors have relied upon and accepted the assumptions and explanations provided by the management in these regards and our opinion is not modified in respect of these matters.

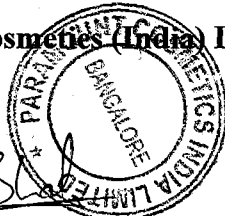


Child abuse: Australian police rescue 46 kids; 14 held

Canberra,

Australian police said that they have rescued 46 children and arrested 14 men after a probe into an international child abuse network. The victims were allegedly subjected to crimes including sexual abuse and other forms of exploitation, the BBC reported.

The investigation also led to three arrests in the US and had identified suspects in Europe, Asia, Canada and New Zealand, authorities said. The case is believed to be one of the biggest of its kind in Australia.

All victims were aged between 16 months and 15 years old, the Australian Federal Police (AFP) said. Sixteen of the victims had attended one childcare centre.

Gujarat sees 1,049 new Covid cases, 5 more deaths

Gandhinagar,

Gujarat on Tuesday registered 1,049 more coronavirus cases, taking its tally to 1,82,719, while the death toll climbed to 3,773 with five new fatalities.

In November so far, the state has added 9,775 cases at a daily average of 977.

A total of 879 patients were discharged, taking the total to 1,66,468, while there are 12,478 active cases. Surat saw 183 new cases, Ahmedabad 178, Rajkot with 128, Vadodara 119 and Mehsana 53. Gandhinagar followed with 51, Jamnagar 44, Banaskantha 39, Patan 36, Amreli 20, Surendranagar 18, Junagadh 17, Morbi 15, Sabarkantha and Kheda 14 each, Kutch and Mahisagar 13 each, Tapi and Panchmahals 12 each, Bharuch 11, Gir-Somnath and Narmada eight each, Navsari and Devbhumi Dwaraka seven each, Anand six, Dahod five, Aravalli and Chhota Udepur three each, Valsad two and Botad and Porbandar one each.

Islamabad,

Tensions are brewing between the Pakistan government and the US embassy in Islamabad after the latter retweeted a post by an opposition lawmaker, alluding to Prime Minister Imran Khan as a dictator and demagogue.

Ahsan Iqbal, a former minister and a leader of the opposition PML-N party, had commented on a post by the Washington Post that said "Trump's defeat is a blow to the world's demagogues and dictators."

"We have one in Pakistan too. He shall be shown the way out soon Inshallah (God willing)," Iqbal had tweeted, without directly mentioning Khan. The US embassy account on Tuesday evening retweeted this, causing an uproar among the local Twitterati. On Tuesday,

The nearly week-long spell of worsened air quality and a fresh surge in coronavirus cases in the national capital have proved "doubly detrimental" to people suffering from respiratory ailments, as their complications have increased and many of them have also contracted Covid-19 infection, experts said on Wednesday. Many doctors and medical experts had earlier cautioned.

secret of winning Bihar election: PM

New Delhi, After a resounding victory in Bihar state assembly election and several bypoll elections, Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday addressed party workers in BJP headquarters in New Delhi. The victory celebration comes amid the Covid-19 pandemic and thousands of workers assembled at the venue.

"Thank you, not just because people voted for us but because we all celebrated this festival of democracy with great enthusiasm... The election may have been held in only some parts of the country but entire country's attention was focused on news channels, Twitter and the election commission's website," he said.

"There is something

that we have almost forgotten. Earlier, a day after polling, we used to get news of repolling, booth capture. But today we only read news of the increase in the percentage of votes, female voters," the PM said.

Thanking JP Nadda for the victory, the Prime Minister said the implications of the results are far-reach-

ing. "From east to west, from north to south, we won. It was an extension of what happened in 2019 Lok Sabha elections. If you are working tirelessly for the development of the country, voters will reward you. They will not be fooled by anything. This is what yesterday's verdict has clearly shown us."

Taking a journey down memory lane, PM Modi said there was a time when the BJP had only two seats. "And we started from two rooms. But today we are everywhere. How did this happen? The answer lies in the verdict of yesterday. People are relying on our development plank. Development will be our only poll issue," PM Modi said. "Good railways, better airports, bridges, internet connectivity, some will say, are not important in elections. People are telling political parties that this is not the case. This is going to be the basis of development. People who did not understand this... have lost their deposits," PM Modi said. In his victory speech, the prime minister attributed BJP's electoral success to BJP's governance."

Family-run parties biggest threat to India's democracy: PM

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday hit out at family-run parties saying they are the biggest threat to the democracy and rued that even a national party had fallen prey to it. Addressing party workers at a felicitation function after the BJP's victory in Bihar elections and various bypolls, he asserted that the only mantra for his party's victory was "Sabka saath, sabka vikas and sabka vishwas".

Modi said the poll results in Bihar and other bye-elections across the country have made it clear that people will now support only those who work honestly for development.

PM Narendra Modi to co-chair virtual India-ASEAN summit on today

New Delhi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi will on Thursday co-chair a virtual summit between India and 10-nation ASEAN that is expected to focus on measures to recover from the economic turmoil triggered by the coronavirus pandemic and ways to further broad base the strategic ties. The Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) said the summit will review the status of ASEAN-India strategic partnership and take stock of progress made in key areas such as connectivity, maritime cooperation, trade and commerce,

education and capacity building. The Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) is considered one of the most influential groupings in the region, and India and several other countries including the US, China, Japan and Australia are its dialogue partners. The summit is taking place amid China's aggressive behaviour in the disputed South China Sea as well as in eastern Ladakh. A number of ASEAN countries have territorial disputes with China in the South China Sea.

Along with PM Modi, the 17th India-ASEAN

summit will also be chaired by Vietnamese Prime Minister Nguyen Xuan Phuc. "The leaders will discuss ways to further strengthen ASEAN-India engagement and in this context will note the adoption of ASEAN-India Plan of Action (2021-2025). COVID-19, post-pandemic economic recovery and important regional and international developments will also be discussed at the summit," the MEA said in a statement.

The 10 member countries of ASEAN are Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore,

Several Wounded In Blast At Cemetery For Non-Muslims In Saudi Arabia: France

Paris, A bomb on Wednesday struck a World War I commemoration attended by European diplomats in the Saudi city of Jeddah, France said, leaving several people wounded amid Muslim anger over French cartoons.

The attack at a non-Muslim cemetery is the second assault in the kingdom in less than a month,

as French President Emmanuel Macron has sought to assuage anger across Muslim nations over satirical cartoons of the Prophet Mohammed.

"The annual ceremony commemorating the end of World War I at the non-Muslim cemetery in Jeddah, attended by several consulates, including that of France, was the target of an IED [improvised explosive

device] attack this morning, which injured several people," France's foreign ministry said. "France strongly condemns this cowardly, unjustifiable attack." There was no immediate comment from Saudi authorities. Roads leading up to the cemetery in central Jeddah were blocked by Saudi traffic police, according to an AFP photographer at the scene.

Inequality continues to rise in India

New Delhi,,

Inequality started to rise in India and China substantially in the early 1990s and 2000s, while it was stabilised in China, it continued to rise in India, according to a report. "In China, the top-1 per cent captured eight per cent of national income in 1990 and rose to 14 per cent in 2019, while in India, the corresponding figures are 11 per cent in 1990 and 21 per cent in 2019," the World Inequality Lab said in the report. It said while inequality started to rise in India and China substantially in the early 1990s and 2000s, it was stabilised in China but continued to rise in India. The report added that this suggests that development and higher growth rates do not necessarily mean more inequality in the distribution of growth. "As a matter of fact, national economic policies matter." In both the countries, inequality increased substantially after the economic liberalisation of the 1980s and 1990s, it said. The report said communist countries like China and Vietnam display lower inequality levels than non-communist countries like India and Thailand.

Officials' talk for disengagement has led to stable situation in Ladakh

Ladakh,

Army chief general MM Naravane has said that he was hopeful that the Indian and Chinese militaries will be able to reach an agreement on disengagement and de-escalation of tension in eastern Ladakh.

In an address at a seminar, the army chief said senior military commanders of India and China are holding talks to iron out modalities for deescalation of tension in eastern Ladakh. The broad contours of the proposal include removal of

armoured personnel carriers within one day of inking an agreement, withdrawal of troops from specific areas on the north and south banks of the Pangong lake in eastern Ladakh and carrying out verification of the disengagement process by both the sides, they said. The specific proposals for the disengagement and restoration of the status quo ante as existed in April were finalised during the eighth round of high-level military talks between the Indian and Chinese armies in Chushul on November 6 on the Indian side of the Line of Actual Control (LAC). The

sources said both the Indian Army and the Chinese People's Liberation Army (PLA) are looking at sealing the pact in the next round of Corps Commander-level talks as the proposals were agreed to by the two sides.

The ninth round of military talks are likely to take place in the next few days. Nearly 50,000 Indian Army troops are currently deployed in a high state of combat readiness in various mountainous locations in eastern Ladakh in sub-zero conditions as multiple rounds of talks between the two sides have not yielded concrete outcome to resolve the standoff.

Arnab Goswami granted interim bail by SC

New Delhi,

The Supreme Court on Wednesday granted interim bail to Republic TV editor-in-chief Arnab Goswami who was arrested last week in connection with a 2018 abetment to suicide case. The court also asked the high courts to exercise their jurisdiction to uphold personal liberty. The bench, headed by Justice Chandrachud, granted Arnab Goswami and two other accused interim bail on a bond of Rs 50,000. The bench directed the Commissioner of Police to ensure the order is followed immediately. Senior lawyer Harish Salve, who was

representing Goswami, argued that the power to re-investigate was being wrongly used. "We are well past the FIR stage. The FIR was lodged on May 5, 2018, and after this matter was investigated.

The Power to re-investigation has been wrongly used, he said. His argument came in the backdrop of Maharashtra home minister Anil Deshmukh ordering a re-investigation on the basis of a fresh complaint by the family of designer interior designer Anvay Naik, who along with his mother Kumud had died by suicide in May 2018. In a suicide note, Naik had alleged non-payment of dues by firms of the accused. A vacation bench of Justices DY Chandrachud and Indira Banerjee expressed concern over state governments targeting

"individuals on the basis of ideology, difference of opinion" and said that they must realise there is an apex court to protect liberty of citizens. The top court observed that Indian democracy is

"extraordinarily resilient" and the Maharashtra government must ignore all this (Arnab's taunt on TV). "Whatever be his ideology, least I don't even watch his channel but if in this case constitutional court's do not interfere today,

Govt allows airlines to raise flight operations capacity to 70%

New Delhi,

As Covid-19 cases have started to decline across the country, the civil aviation ministry on Wednesday allowed airlines to extend their operation to 70% of their capacity. Earlier, the airlines were running at 60% capacity. "Domestic operations recommenced with 30K passengers on 25 May and have reached 2.06 lakhs on 8 Nov. Ministry of Civil Aviation is now allowing domestic carriers to increase their operations from ex-

isting 60% to 70% of the pre-Covid approved capacity," said aviation minister Hardeep Singh Puri on Twitter.

After being grounded for two months due to the Covid-19 pandemic, Indian airlines resumed domestic operations on May 25. At the time, airlines were allowed to operate only up to a third of their total capacity, with the cap later being increased to 45% and then to 60%. Since May, air traffic has picked up, however due to the still

prevailing fear of contracting Covid-19, the bookings are still low. This comes as the number of daily Covid-19 cases began to decline in the country. As of Wednesday morning, the country's Covid-19 caseload was above 8.6 million. While the death toll stood at 1,27,571. Meanwhile, the number of active cases dropped below the five lakh-mark for the first time after 106 days, the health ministry said. The active cases in the country are 4,94,657.

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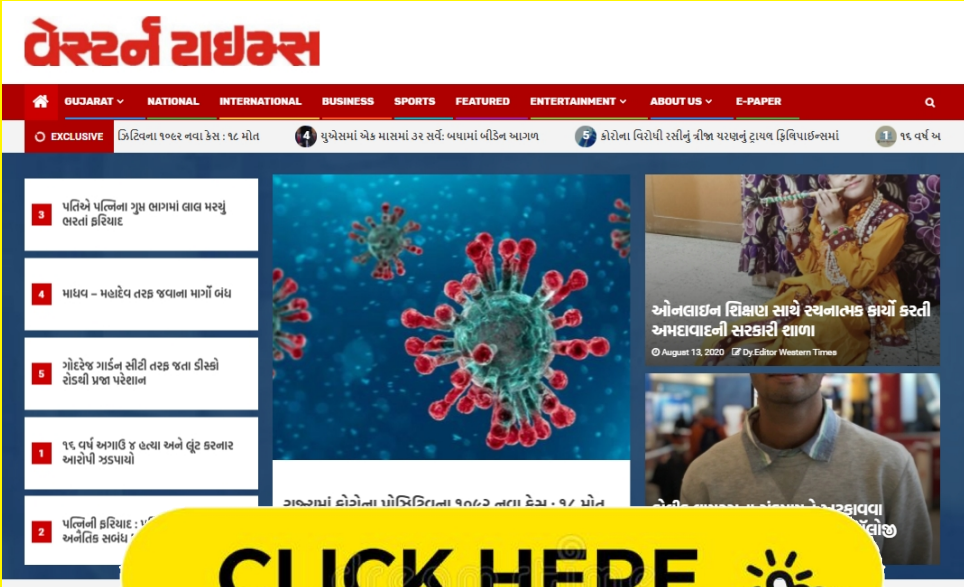

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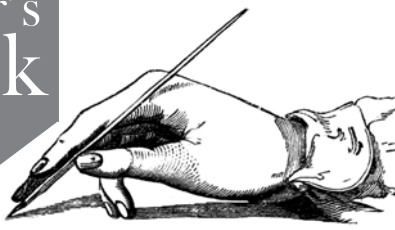

Quality of reciprocity Visit to Nepal by Army chief signals continuity of ties, distance travelled by both countries from summer of discontent.

The visit by the Army chief, General Manoj Mukund Naravane, to Nepal earlier this month was part of a long-standing reciprocal tradition between the two countries' militaries of conferring the rank of general on each other's army chiefs. It is heartening that the custom continued this time despite a bitter map row that has cast a shadow on ties. For sure, General Naravane's visit was not expected to resolve the spat over territory, but it helped to signal continuity in bilateral relations between the two neighbours.

It gave both sides the opportunity to draw a line under the Indian Army chief's statement in May that alluded to a China hand behind Nepal's claims over Kalapani, Lipulekh and Limpiyadhura and triggered anger in Kathmandu. Nepal Prime Minister Khadga Prasad Oli's statement to Naravane reiterating friendly relations between the two countries, and expressing hope that the problems between the two would be resolved through dialogue, was indication that Nepal is as keen as India to turn the page on this chapter.

Behind-the-scenes efforts are already on to resolve the issue. Delhi has reached out to Kathmandu through both the civilian and security establishments. There seems to be a realisation in both capitals that this age-old relationship, powered mainly by people-to-people ties across an open border — unique in the South Asia region — has to be nurtured better. Naravane's visit, and that of R&AW chief Samant Goel days earlier, has helped clear the air. Prime Minister Oli was seen as making a conciliatory gesture by withdrawing school textbooks that carried the revised map of Nepal with Kathmandu's new territorial claims.

It is understood that Oli has to walk a thin line between his domestic political compulsions and Nepal's relations with India. While Oli's map project helped him play to nationalist galleries back home, it, and his China tilt, has not prevented him from sensing that putting all Nepal's eggs in the Beijing basket may not be that popular either among domestic constituencies, and that Delhi is as vital to its interests, especially as the Chinese penchant for map revisionism in the region does not stop at India alone. The India-Nepal Boundary Working Group will reportedly meet soon for a joint survey of the border areas. Both countries have travelled some way from their summer of discontent.

Delhi reports highest single-day spike of 7,830 Covid cases

New Delhi,

The number of Covid-19 cases shattered all records in the national capital as it reported as many as 7,830 new coronavirus cases on Tuesday and an all-time high positivity rate of 13.26 per cent, while 83 people succumbed to the virus in the last 24 hours.

It is the highest ever single-day tally since the pandemic struck the city. With this, the overall case tally has reached 4,51,382 while new cases. Delhi has been recording more than 6,000 Covid-19 cases for the last eight days. Meanwhile, this is the third day in the last five days when the daily infections have crossed the 7,000-mark.

According to new cases, Delhi has been recording more than 6,000 Covid-19 cases in the last 24 hours. Till now, 4,02,854 people have recovered, 41,385 people have active infection, and 6,989 people have died. The case fatality rate stands at 1.58 per cent. Currently, 8,262 out of 16,324 beds are occupied in the hospitals, 836 out of 8,217 beds in the dedicated Covid Care Centres and 279 out of 527 beds in the dedicated Covid Health Centres. Over 24,700 people are in home isolation. The number of containment zones have been raised to 3,947.

The sudden spike in cases comes amid the festive season and rising pollution levels. While Durga Puja celebrations ended on October 25, the next festivals are Diwali and Chhath on November 14 and November 20, respectively.

Knives out in Cong after party fares badly in Bihar

The Congress, which contested the Bihar Assembly polls on 70 seats, has failed to even reach its last performance figure of 27. After the 19-seat win, the Congress leaders are upset with state in-charge Shakti Singh Gohil and Avinash Pandey, who was the chairman of the screening committee.

Former Minister in Bihar, Shakiluzaman Ansari is the first one to attack the central leaders, who were involved in the Bihar elections. He said, "They did not listen to the state leaders and kept the leadership in the dark on the tie-up. They even conceded those seats to the RJD, which could have been won by the Congress and also our strong candidates were denied ticket."

"Avinash Pandey, Chairman of the screening committee, only did whatever he thought and completely ignored suggestions. There was no meeting of the PEC," blamed the Congress leader.

Telangana continues to record more Covid recoveries

Hyderabad,

Telangana continues to see more recoveries from Covid-19 than the new cases. According to the health department, 1,745 people recovered from the infection while 1,196 new cases were detected during the last 24 hours.

The new infections pushed the overall tally to 2,53,651. Five more people succumbed to the virus during the last 24 hours, taking the death toll to 1,390. The state's fatality rate stands 0.54 per cent against the national average of 1.5 per cent.

The health officials said 44.96 per cent deaths were due to Covid-19 and 55.04 per cent due to comorbidities. The cumulative recoveries have now gone up to 2,34,234. The recovery rate now stands at 92.34 per cent, slightly lower than the national average of 92.7 per cent.

Greater Hyderabad reported less than 200 cases. With 192 cases it continues to record the highest number of new infections. The cases in districts also showed a downward trend of cases at 121 followed by Medchal Malkajgiri (101), Nalgonda (89), Bhadrachalam (81), Karimnagar (73), Warangal Urban (51) and Khammam (42).

The state now has 18,027 active cases, of which 15,205 are in home or institutional isolation.

Cong got 19 of 70 contested, leading to Grand Alliance's loss

New Delhi,

The Congress contested on 70 seats in the Bihar Assembly polls, but could win only 19 seats which led to the failure of the Grand Alliance to reach the magic figure of 122, say party insiders.

The Congress insiders feel that instead of fielding candidates in 70 seats, the party could have contested on a lesser number where it had a strong presence. The local Congress leaders say they have been cautioning the party's central leaders about directly contesting against the BJP.

Shakiluzaman Ansari was the first one to caution the party after the exit polls that situation is grim for the Grand Alliance after the AIMIM ate into the votes in the Muslim dominated seats.

The NDA has returned to power in Bihar, though by the slimmest of margins, as results on the Election Commission site indicate. NDA — the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), Janata Dal (United), VIP and HAM — crossed the majority mark of 122 seats.

The opposition Mahagathbandhan ended up with 110 seats, with the Rashtriya Janata Dal winning 75 seats, the Congress 19 and the Communist Party of India-Marxist-Leninist (Liberation) winning 12.

The Communist Party of India and the Communist Party of India-Marxist won two seats each.

The remaining seats were divided among Asaduddin Owaisi's AIMIM which won five, while the Bahujan Samaj Party won one seat, and an Independent was also elected to the Assembly.

Local train services resume after 8 months in Bengal

The Eastern Railway (ER) also urged all commuters to maintain strict guidelines, like using hand sanitisers, wearing masks and maintaining physical distancing norms while travelling by local trains.

Officials in the South Eastern Railway (SER) also said that necessary arrangements have been made to sanitise coaches on a daily basis to ensure safety of the passengers. They also deployed railway and civil forces to monitor passengers' movements, sources said.

The Kolkata Metro also resumed their operations with an increased number of daily trains on weekdays up by 25 per cent from Wednesday. The Metro Railway decided to run trains every seven minutes during the morning and evening peak hours. A total of 190 trains will operate on a daily basis on weekdays.

Services from Dum Dum in the north and Kavi Subhash in the south will start at 8 a.m. and the last train from these stations will depart at 9 p.m. everyday.

Green Climate Fund invests \$23.1M for vulnerable Mongolians

New Delhi,

A UNDP-supported seven-year project is going to benefit close to one million vulnerable people in Mongolia where climate change is threatening natural resources and fragile ecosystems.

At the 27th meeting of its board, the Green Climate Fund (GCF), the world's largest fund dedicated to climate finance, on Tuesday approved a new \$23.1 million grant towards strengthening the climate resilience of herder communities.

Approximately 26,000 households (130,000 people), living across four of the country's most remote and vulnerable Western and Eastern aimags (provinces) are set to benefit, with a further 160,000 households (800,000 people) to benefit indirectly — around one quarter of Mongolia's national population.

The project brings together climate-informed natural resources management and sustainable livestock practices, building on traditional cooperative approaches among herders while also introducing innovative technologies for

traceability of sustainably sourced livestock products.

It will enhance the generation and use of climate prognosis data in decision-making; rehabilitate degraded land and catchment areas; improve herders' water and grazing land management practices; and strengthen herders' access to markets for sustainably sourced livestock products.

Crucially, it will also support the policy transformations needed to promote sustainable livestock and pasture management practices.

Mongolia is subject to a range of natural disasters, including harsh winters, drought, snow and dust storms. Climate change is multiplying the challenges: over the last decade, the magnitude and frequency of such disasters have increased several fold, with estimated economic costs around \$10-15 million annually.

The disasters take a heavy toll on livestock and rural livelihoods.

Increased temperatures, coupled with decreased precipitation, have resulted in a drying trend affecting

pastures and water sources, and shifting natural zones — in turn impacting the natural resources on which herders and livestock rely.

Covid-19 has further exposed the vulnerability of the livestock sector to shocks, with the fluctuations in demand compounding existing challenges, and reinforcing the importance of green recovery and resilient growth.

"The impacts of climate change are a major concern in Mongolia, contributing to land degradation and desertification," said Minister for Environment and Tourism, Sarangerel Davaajantsan.

"With the grant from the Green Climate Fund complementing \$56.2 million from the government, this project will contribute to a paradigm shift towards more climate-resilient sustainable development, particularly with focus on disaster risk reduction.

"It will reap multiple benefits, including supporting vulnerable herder families' livelihoods by offering more options but also improved access to markets in which they can sell their

products — a significant socio-economic benefit.

"At the same time, it will also bring considerable long-term environmental benefits, including more resilient rehabilitated land and river basin areas, and improved conservation of water resources while strengthening disaster management and development planning to build forward Mongolia better."

Developed over several years with the support from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and in close consultation with the government of Mongolia, communities, development partners and academia, the project will be led by the Ministry of Environment and Tourism, with the Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Light Industry as a key partner.

The GCF was set up by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) in 2010. It drives climate finance to where it is needed most: in the Least Developed Countries, Small Island Developing States, and African States.

- The unaudited Standalone Financial results have been reviewed and recommended by the audit committee at its meeting held on November 10, 2020 and approved by the Board of Directors at its board meeting held on November 10, 2020.
- The requirement of AS-17th "Segment Reporting" is not applicable to the Company as it is engaged in single business segment.
- The above unaudited Standalone Financial results have been prepared in accordance with the guidelines issued by the accounting standards as issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) and the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013.
- The outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic globally and in India is causing significant disturbance and slowdown of economic activities. COVID-19 has caused interruption in production, supply chain disruption, on availability of manpower, etc., during the last week of March 2020 and thereafter. The management of the company has exercised due care in concluding significant accounting judgments and estimates in preparation of the financial results. In assessing recoverability of trade receivables, the company has considered subsequent recoveries, past trends, credit risk profiles of the customers and internal and external information available up to the date of issuance of these financial results. However, due to COVID-19 pandemic, the company could not obtain balance confirmation from its receivables. In assessing the recoverability of inventories, the company has considered the latest selling prices, customer orders on hand and margins. Three held for killing friend over debt

Ahmedabad, Infocity police of Gandhinagar on Tuesday arrested three men -- one from Mehsana and two from Ahmedabad city -- for allegedly stabbing their friend to death at Bhat village on October 31.

The trio dumped the body of the deceased, Jayesh Koshti, 25, a resident of Asopalav Society in CTM, in some bushes in Bhat village after killing him as he did not return Rs 7 lakh which he had borrowed from them around a year ago.

DSP of Gandhinagar M L Rana said the accused were Dhaval Rabari, 24, a resident of Ambaliyasan in Mehsana, Sandip Rabari, 22, a resident of Bhagoyadaynagar near CTM Cross roads and Happy Rabari, 22, a resident of Varvabhaj Chawl in Amraiwadi.

Rana said that they had got a message at the control room on October 31 that a body had been found in Bhat village.

Police ascertained the identity of the deceased and began an investigation after registering a case of murder at Infocity police station.

On questioning people known to Koshti and checking his call details records, police learned that Dhaval, Sandip and Happy had a fight with Koshti over money and they took him with them in a car on the morning of October 31.

When police went to the accused person's homes, they had fled. On Monday evening, police got an input that the accused persons were near Uvansad Crossroads, headed towards Adalaj from Mehsana.

A team kept a watch and nabbed the accused. They were later taken for Covid-19 tests and booked for murder.

Poacher arrested in Nalsarovar

Ahmedabad, The forest department team on Monday apprehended one person Rajesh Bhuvara a resident of Shiyal village of Bavla Taluka in Ahmedabad district, for allegedly involved in poaching activity in Nalsarovar.

Brijeshkumar Chaudhary, deputy conservator of forests (DCF) said that during patrolling the team saw a man who was carrying a polythene bag. The person was intercepted and then the bag was opened they found 10 dead and alive Garganey birds -- small dabbling duck.

Chaudhary said, poachers put up nets on the banks of various villages situated on the periphery of the Nalsarovar lake and ones the birds are tapped they collect them in the night and will vanish from the spot in the morning before the morning staff reports for work/

A senior officer said that this is a very old practice and hence the department had formed teams which carry out patrolling in the night in the nearby villages and also in Nalsarovar.

The officials said that this is the second such incident reported in 2020. In January two persons including a woman were caught for poaching.

Ex-minister, dies of nCov infection

Anand, Former minister of state (MoS) for industries, mines and minerals, finance and former BJP MLA from Anand assembly seat, Rohit Patel succumbed to Covid-19 infection in Shree Krishna Hospital in Karamsad in Anand on Tuesday.

Sources said he was admitted for more than a fortnight but could not survive due to heart ailment.

The 74-year-old industrialist was chairman and managing director (CMD) of Milcent Group of Companies, that had introduced household grain grinding concept in the country with the launch of domestic electric flour mill in 1960s.

Patel had emerged as a dark horse in 2014 bypolls for the Anand assembly seat which had got vacated after BJP's former MLA Dilip Patel (Mani) won the Parliamentary elections.

He was appointed junior industries minister in Vijay Rupani government but was later dropped.

12-ft croc walks on village road

Vadodara, When residents of Vadsar village were about to hit the bed on Sunday night, a visitor took them by surprise.

A 12-foot long crocodile, who was out for a walk, was spotted by the locals when it was crawling through the village. As the word spread, people gathered to catch a glimpse of the giant reptile but walked by unmindful of commotion.

"The reptile had ventured out of Vishwamitri River that flows near the village. It entered the drain and then crawled into the village on Sunday night," said Siddharth Amin, who runs Life With Wildlife.

It took them 30 minutes to rescue the reptile. "Villagers have often spotted crocodiles in Vishwamitri, the home to hundreds of reptiles, flows close to Vadsar. But crocodiles don't come on main road through the lanes," said Amin.

Police inspector shifted

Ahmedabad, City police commissioner Sanjay Srivastav on Monday ordered transfer of Inspector Y B Jadafe of Vastrapur police to special branch who was allegedly involved in two cases of irregularities. Sources in police said that Jadafe was accused of providing "extra services" to Raman Patel and Dashrath Patel of Popular builders who were accused of violence by their daughter-in-law at the Vastrapur police station by allegedly taking "extra charges" from Patel family.

Bihar voted for development, says Modi

New Delhi, After the good show of NDA in the Bihar Assembly elections, where it held an edge over the Mahagathbandhan till late on Tuesday night, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that the voters of the state had voted for development.

In a series of tweets, Modi said, "Bihar has taught the first lesson of democracy to the world. Today, Bihar has shown the world how democracy is strengthened. A record number of poor, deprived and women of Bihar have voted for development."

"Every voter in Bihar has clearly stated that he is an aspirant and development is his priority. They have once again showered their blessings on the 15 years of good governance by the NDA, which clearly shows what are their expectations," he said in another tweet.

The Prime Minister further said that the youth of Bihar have made it clear that the new decade belongs to Bihar and 'Aatmanirbhar Bihar' is the roadmap for it. The youth of Bihar have relied on their strength and resolution of the NDA. This will encourage the NDA to work even harder, he said.

Modi said that the sisters and daughters of Bihar came out in record numbers and showed that they will play an important role in making Bihar Aatmanirbhar. "We are really happy that the NDA got an opportunity to give confidence to the women of Bihar in the past few years. This confidence will give us strength to develop Bihar," Modi said in another tweet. The Prime Minister further said that every section of the state has shown confidence in the NDA's 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Sabka Vishwas' campaign.

"Once again, I assure every citizen of Bihar that we will continue to work dedicatedly for the balanced development of every person and every region," the Prime Minister said.

Common veggies no small potatoes

Ahmedabad, Prices of onions, potatoes, and tomatoes -- used in most dishes -- have risen to the Rs 60-95 per kg mark in retail markets. The wholesale price has touched the Rs 50 mark.

If the prices of 1kg of each of the three essential vegetables are added, the bill will be Rs 200 in the retail market. App-based purchases will cost Rs 175.

The shortage of vegetables, especially of onions and potatoes, has pushed up vegetables prices in the city. To make matters worse, the prices of at least five other vegetables have crossed the Rs 100/kg mark. These vegetables include cluster beans, French beans, capsicum and chilli. Even the price of brinjal in retail has crossed the Rs 75/kg

mark. A senior officer of the APMC (Agricultural Produce Market Committee) said that there was already a shortage of potatoes and onions and hence prices were increasing and were expected to rise further. He said retailers have been swelling medium -- or low-quality onions at double the rate. For example, medium-size onions are sold at Rs 30 per kg in the wholesale market but at Rs 80 in retail. App-based sellers are specifically mentioning that the onions on offer are medium sized.

Deepak Patel, the secretary of the APMC, said: "There was a shortage of potatoes and onions. And due to the delayed monsoon and subsequent heavy rains, there was a delay in

sowing of tomatoes crop." Patel added: "Hence the supply of local crops is still awaited. At present, the city is getting tomatoes from Bengaluru and Nashik; so prices are high."

Another office-bearer of the APMC said: "The supply of locally produced vegetables has been delayed. Besides, monsoon sowing of vegetables is resulting in high prices." The office-bearer added: "But the gap of about 100% in retail and wholesale markets is seen because of retailers' markup." He said that if the best quality ladyfinger costs Rs 45 per kg, retailers were selling at Rs 75-90. "Moreover, retailers charge for the best quality produce but add medium-quality vegetables into the mix to maximize profits," he said.

HC upholds PASA for extorting, beating people

Ahmedabad, The Gujarat high court has upheld the invocation of PASA laws with the observation that acts of extortion and assaulting people on public roads amounts to a breach of public order.

Justice Bela Trivedi rejected a petition filed by one Vijay Dabhi alias Chino, who was detained under the Prevention of Anti-Social Activities Act (PASA) after he was facing two FIRs at Isanpur police station. He was booked for theft, attempted murder and assault. City police slapped PASA against him on the basis of two statements made by the complainants in these FIRs.

The anonymous victims made videographed statements that they were beaten on a public street by Dabhi and the incident drew crowds. However, nobody came forward to rescue them in two separate

incidents. They did not get help because people were afraid of Dabhi.

Before the high court, Dabhi questioned the PASA order arguing that while he was named in one FIR only and the accusations revealed that the offences were against individuals and not against society. These could be said to be incidents of breach of law and order and not public order, for which he can be

Red tape chokes Pirana-clearing machines

Ahmedabad, The order of the NGT (National Green Tribunal) to take immediate measures to eradicate the Pirana dump seeds to have been ensnared by red tape. The health committee of the AMC has kept in abeyance the new tender for the installation of Trommel machines to process solid waste at Pirana.

The health committee, which met on Monday, has refused to clear the new tender and has sought some replies from the administrative wing. The committee wants to know how many Trommel machines will be installed, what will be the duration of the tender, and what will be the expenses incurred by the AMC. A senior officer in the AMC said

that these questions could have been answered in the meeting and noted down in the minutes. The officer said the information could have been incorporated in a note sent to the standing committee for the final approval.

The officer pointed out that the elected wing was buying time till the local body elections or till its term ends next month. That way, the 12 machines that were installed as recently as July can continue to operate in the absence of a new tender. The officer said that the contract for the 12 machines has a political link, and was awarded at Rs 6.40 lakh per month per machine. There is a condition in the tender that a reduction or an increase in price can come into effect during the period of the contract.

Officials said that for the new tender, the lowest price quoted was Rs 3.11 lakh per month per machine. Hence if the new contract was awarded, the contractors, hired in July this year will have to agree to the Rs 3.11 lakh cost. Paresh Patel, the health committee chairman, said "We are meeting after Diwali and if all our queries are answered, the tender will be allotted."

Eating joint on SB Road razed by AMC

Ahmedabad, One of the prominent eating joint SBQ Social located on Sindhu Bhavan Road was razed to rubble after a team of municipal estate department's demolition squad found that the structure had no permission from the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC). Sources in the AMC's estate department claim that the large area purportedly belonged to Popular Builders. The AMC razed the 52 food stalls and cleared some 14,000 sq feet of ground area for which SBQ Social did not have building use permission nor had they placed a plan before the AMC for approval. "It was a large prominent site on Sindhu Bhavan Road and residents around complex had started approaching the AMC zonal office over the construction activities at SBQ Social," says a senior estate department official at AMC.

A temporary structure raised on iron bars was also pulled down. "In all some 30,000 sq feet of constructed space including a floor on the top of the temporary structure was razed," says the senior AMC official. Sources in the Town Planning department add that all construction activities over the last one and half years are being identified.

Snag hits Ro-Pax vessel two days after launch

Surat, Kumar Doshi, a Bhavnagar businessman, wanted to reach Surat as early as possible due to a medical emergency in Surat. Some, he preferred to go via the newly launched Ghogha-Hazira Ro-Pax service as he would reach within four hours.

On Tuesday, he reached at 10:30 am to catch the 12 O'clock scheduled ferry service from Ghogha to Hazira. "We have to travel up to Pune. There is no sight of the ship. We can't keep waiting endlessly. Can we cancel the ticket?," a woman was seen inquiring at the ticket window.

Travellers complained that though they had purchased on-line tickets and arrived on time, there was no update via announcement about the delay. "We reached the Ghogha Ro-Pax terminal at around 11am to board the ferry at 12pm. Despite our repeated enquiries, the officers were not responding to our queries about the long delay in departure. There was no water for the passengers sitting in the terminal building for hours. This was a nightmarish experience," said Beena Rao, a social activist from Surat.

Officials of Indigo Seaways Private Limited that manages and operates Ro-Pax ferry service said there was a leakage from the CNG tank of a car brought from Hazirant about the delay. "We reached the Ghog to Ghogha. Since there was a serious threat to the vessel and passengers on-board, the priority was to remove the car safely to the ground, which took about an hour.

"There was a dual problem when the vessel reached Ghogha First was the CNG leakage in the car and the second was the breakdown of the diesel generator (nt about the delay. "We reached the GhogDG) set of the vessel. The generator set, which required three to four hours of cleaning. Without a generator we could not operate the vessel and the radar. The work is still going on to fix the breakdown of the generator set at the vessel," said Chetan Contractor, chairman and managing director of Indigo Seaways.

GPCC president offers to resign after debacle

Gandhinagar, State BJP president C R Paatil and CM Viay Rupani had all the reasons to kickstart early festive celebrations. The duo managed to reverse the trend of voters rejecting turncoats at the hustings and cement their own position in the organization and government.

On the other hand, the state Congress leadership is bearing the brunt of not putting up a spirited fight against the BJP to retain the eight assembly seats which the Congress had won in the 2017 assembly election. State Congress chief Amit Chavda offered to resign, owing to responsibility for the party's dismal show in the assembly by-polls. Meanwhile, buoyed by

the election results, Rupani sought to put to rest all speculations of a looming cabinet reshuffle or expansion, saying that no such thing is being planned as of now. The CM, however, hinted at possible appointments in boards and corporations soon.

With all its candidates facing defeat in the assembly bypolls, the Congress finds itself in an unenviable position. It's MLAs in the assembly have fallen from an impressive 77 in 2017 to 65 now. The BJP, which finished in double digit numbers (99) in the 2017 assembly election, now has strength of 111 MLAs in the assembly. After the poor show by the Congress in the assembly byelection, losing all

eight seats which it won in 2017, party workers are putting the blame of the defeat on state party chief Chavda, leader of opposition (LOP) Paresh Dhanani and AICC Gujarat in-charge Rajiv Satav.

Party foot soldiers say the leadership showed very little intent in putting up a fight on J.P. which finished in double digit numbers (99) in the 2 the eight seats, which are considered to be party bastions. A veteran Congress leader said, "We chose weak candidates. There was lack of planning and execution. If the national leadership does not take a call on changing the state leadership, the Congress may not be able to repeat its 2017 assembly election performance."

When she asked him about the woman, he first tried to hide the relationship but later told her that she was his second wife. Dhara protested and told her in-laws about the woman but they sided with Dharmesh and told her to keep quiet. As she kept raising the issue, her husband thrashed her.

US State Department approves F-35 jets sale to UAE

Washington, The US State Department approved F-35 fighter jets sale to the United Arab Emirates (UAE), an arms sale which was questioned by some congressional Democrats. In a Tuesday statement, Secretary of State Mike Pompeo announced a massive arms sale package with an estimated price tag of US \$23.37 billion, which includes up to 50 F-35 jets worth US \$10.4 billion, 18 MQ-9B drones worth US \$2.97 billion, and US \$10 billion of munitions. "The proposed sale will make the UAE even more capable and interoperable with US partners in a manner fully consistent with America's longstanding commitment to ensuring Israel's Qualitative Military Edge," said the statement. Israel's Qualitative Military Edge refers to a US legal standard that Israel maintains a military technologic edge over other regional countries. Reports said that the F-35 deal between the United States and the UAE was a part of the US-brokered agreement to normalize ties between the UAE and Israel that had been signed in September. Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu initially opchanged after the United States pledged to ensure Israel's military edge in the region. The State Department informally notified Congress of the F-35 sale two weeks ago, leading to concerns among CommitOctober that Congress must analyze all of the ramifications of the export of F-35. "Rushing these sales is not in anyone's interest."

UN chief calls for stronger ties with SCO to fight climate crisis

United Nations, United Nations Secretary-General Antonio Guterres has called for stronger ties with the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) in tackling climate crisis and geopolitical tensions amid Covid-19 recovery. The Covid-19 pandemic "has exacerbated vulnerabilities, inequalities and fragilities across the world. The recovery will require global cooperation to protect lives and livelihoods, and to keep economies and businesses afloat. We count on the strong engagement of SCO member states, and we stand ready to share good practices and provide technical expertise to your pandemic recovery plans," the UN chief said in his video message to the 20th meeting of the Council of Heads of State of Member States of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization on Tuesday, Xinhua news agency reported. The climate crisis, like the pandemic, is a global threat that knows no borders. "Ambitious multilateral action is urgently needed to save lives and livelihoods. The Paris Agreement and the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development underpin the work of the United Nations and should be central to national decision-making too," said the UN chief. "The tide is turning. The European Union, Japan, the Republic of Korea, together with more than 110 other countries, have committed to net zero emissions by 2050, and China before 2060," Guterres elaborated. "I call on more governments to join this net zero coalition and to align their Covid-19 recovery plans and 2030 Nationally Determined Contributions with this objective. And I urge all governments to bring concrete policies and plans to the Climate Ambition Summit I will co-host with several member states on December 12," the Secretary-General added. "I welcome the support of the SCO, as a leading player in regional diplomacy in Eurasia, for my appeal for a global ceasefire. I look forward to your further advocacy and action to end hostilities around the world before the end of this year," the UN chief said. The Secretary-General warned that "when people fight each other, the only winner is the virus. We have seen this most recently in Armenia and Azerbaijan, where the pandemic has taken on new ferocity since the conflict re-ignited." Guterres stated that regular exchanges between the United Nations and the SCO "provide us with ways to enhance our cooperation on regional issues." He expressed his gratitude to the members of the SCO for their "firm commitment."

Indian engineering student found dead in Sharjah

Sharjah, A 21-year-old Indian engineering student was found hanging from the ceiling fan in his family apartment in Sharjah's Al Rolla, police said. The deceased identified as Jyot from Dubai was found dead on the night of November 2. The student is believed to have committed suicide, a police official told Gulf News. He said police and forensic teams rushed to the scene after receiving information about the incident. Investigations were on but no foul play was suspected so far, he added. The case is now with Public Prosecution. Niral, the brother of the deceased told Gulf News that the family was still grappling with Jyot's unexpected and untimely death. The second of the two siblings, Jyot was a fourth-year computer engineering student studying in Dubai. He was alone at home when the incident happened. "My parents had gone to Al Ain," said Niral, who broke open the door to find his brother lifeless. "We do not know what was going on in his mind... It was very unexpected. He had not left behind any note and we have not come across anything later. We are trying our best to figure out what was going on in his mind and what was troubling him," he said. A friend said: "We checked with the college. They said he was doing wonderful in his studies and everything was going fine. He was a favourite among the faculty and they said he was good in his studies." A friend from school said, "I do not know much about the incident. He was my close friend from school in Sharjah. I am really disturbed."

WHO chief calls for 'fair allocation' after Pfizer Covid vax news

Geneva, WHO Director-General Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus has called for "fair allocation" of a Covid-19 vaccine after drugmakers Pfizer and BioNTech this week said that their vaccine candidate was found to be more than 90 per cent effective in preventing the disease in interim analysis of data. Addressing the member states at the 73rd World Health Assembly on Tuesday, the WHO chief said that the UN health agency welcomes Pfizer's "promising news" and expects additional effective vaccines in near future along with advances in testing and therapeutics. "I called on Member States to reiterate their commitment to fair allocation of a #COVID19 vaccine. We mustn't leave any country behind in the response," Ghebreyesus said. Based on current projections, Pfizer and BioNTech expect to produce globally up to 50 million vaccine doses this year and up to 1.3 billion doses in 2021. The issue of challenges of distributing a potential vaccine such as the one being developed by Pfizer and BioNTech was also raised by Matshidiso Moeti, WHO's Regional Director for Africa. "The exciting news yesterday (Monday) of a possible effective vaccine becoming available presages significant cold chains challenges for African countries by the type of vaccine that that is. Which will need to be factored into the support to be provided," Moeti said. In his opening speech at the World Health Assembly on Monday, the WHO chief said that a vaccine is needed urgently to control the pandemic. "But as you know, it will not fix the vulnerabilities at its roots," he said. "A vaccine cannot address the global under-investment in essential public health functions and resilient health systems, nor the urgent need for a 'One Health' approach that encompasses the health of humans, animals and the planet we share." "There is no vaccine for poverty, hunger, climate change or inequality," the WHO chief said.

Global Covid-19 cases surpass 51.3mn: Johns Hopkins

Washington, The overall number of global coronavirus cases has topped 51.3 million, while the deaths have surged to 1,270,170, according to the Johns Hopkins University. As of Wednesday morning, the total caseload and death toll stood at 51,377,200 and 1,270,171, respectively, the University's Center for Systems Science and Engineering (CSSE) revealed in its latest update. The US is the worst-hit country with the world's highest number of cases and deaths at 10,242,754 and 239,628, respectively, according to the CSSE. India comes in second place in terms of cases at 8,591,730, while the country's death toll soared to 127,059. The other countries with more than a million confirmed cases are Brazil (5,699,005), France (1,857,309), Russia (1,802,762), Spain (1,381,218), Argentina (1,262,476), the UK (1,237,198) and Colombia (1,155,356), the CSSE figures showed. Brazil currently accounts for the second highest number of fatalities at 162,802. The countries with a death toll above 20,000 are Mexico (95,027), the UK (49,861), Italy (42,330), France (41,062), Spain (39,345), Iran (39,202), Peru (34,943), Argentina (34,183), Colombia (33,128) and Russia (30,899).

Russia to deploy peacekeepers in Nagorno-Karabakh after ceasefire

Moscow, Russia will deploy peacekeepers in the Nagorno-Karabakh region as a "complete ceasefire" starting Tuesday was reached by Azerbaijan and Armenia, Russian President Vladimir Putin said. Putin said in a televised address that Azerbaijani President Ilham Aliyev, Armenian Prime Minister Nikol Pashinyan and he signed a statement on Monday declaring a "complete cessation of fire and all hostilities" in the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict zone from 00.00 GMT Monday, Xinhua news agency reported on Tuesday. Azerbaijan and Armenia agreed to stop at their positions they have held, Putin said. Russia has started deploying 1,960 peacekeepers to Nagorno-Karabakh, the Russian Defense Ministry was quoted by local media as saying on Tuesday. A Russian peacekeeping contingent is being deployed consisting of 1,960 military personnel, 90 armored personnel carriers, 380 vehicles and pieces of special equipment, the ministry said. Meanwhile, Azerbaijan and Armenia will exchange war prisoners, other detained persons and bodies of the dead, while all economic and transport links of the region will be unblocked, according to the Russian leader. Internally displaced persons and refugees will return to the territory of Nagorno-Karabakh and its surrounding areas under the care of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, Putin said. "We presume that the agreements will create the necessary conditions for a long-term and full-format settlement of the crisis around Nagorno-Karabakh on a just basis and in the interests of the Armenian and Azerbaijani peoples," he said. Armenia and Azerbaijan have been at loggerheads over the mountainous region of Nagorno-Karabakh since 1988. Peace talks have been held since 1994 when a ceasefire was reached, but there have been sporadic minor clashes.

Don't poke the bear: Why Republicans are backing Trump during lame duck

By Nikhila Natarajan home, Georgia might be lost and so too the Senate. So far, the tally in the 100 member Senate is a dead heat. Republicans and Democrats have 48 seats each. If Democrats get 50 seats, they will effectively have control because the Vice President has the tie-breaking vote. That VP will be Kamala Harris in 2021. Republicans absolutely need 51 seats to retain control. Trump, despite his electoral college loss to Biden, pulled in a record number of votes - more than 71 million at last count. A lot of the down ballot races benefited from Trump on top of the ballot. There is real fear now that the support may wane if Trump is decidedly off the ticket. For as long as possible before the January 5 runoffs in Georgia, Republicans want to keep their voters riled up with claims of victory or seen to be supporting Trump, at the very least. Based on dispatches from a leaky White House and rattled Republicans, these are the calculations animating the sometimes comical, often bizarre support for Trump's claims of a rigged election. For Trump, the lawsuits are an off ramp that allow him a wronged man avatar before the eventual exit. Republicans are also looking to lean into Trump's grievances in a bid to keep the Trump base loyal for as long as possible. Even if they privately relish the prospect of a Donald Trump-less Washington, Republicans are not poking the bear ahead of two crucial January runoffs in Georgia, which will determine US Senate control and, in effect, the balance of political power in America. The post election autopsy is already showing that Republican incumbents in runoffs may not get the same enthusiasm from voters if Trump is seen as a president who has accepted the Biden victory and is well and truly into his lame duck days. If Republicans distance from Trump and Trump takes his base and goes

"Almost every day during the past several months, I've been dreaming of returning to the court and playing matches," the world number one women's singles player said after winning the World Cup title on Tuesday, reports Xinhua news agency.

The ITTF Women's World Cup began last Sunday in Weihai, east China's Shandong province, ending an eight-month hiatus of international table tennis due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

A total of 21 players from 15 countries and regions participated in the three-day Women's World Cup. It was the first international sports event hosted in China featuring overseas athletes.

The last tournament held before the World Cup was the ITTF World Tour Platinum Qatar Open, which ended on March 8.

"At first we expected that suspension of table tennis activities would last one or two months. But when it turned to June or July, the pandemic was still not over. We didn't know when it would be either," recalled ITTF CEO Steve Dainton.

The Men's Cup and the ITTF Finals will also be held in China later this month, as the ITTF called the series as #RESTART.

Tendulkar, Lara easily best two batsmen I've played with or against: Warne

New Delhi,

Former Australia leg-spinner Shane Warne has heaped praise Sachin Tendulkar and Brian Lara, saying the duo were the 'best two batsmen' he played with or against during his illustrious career.

"These two guys were clearly and easily the best two batsmen I played with or against and the best of my generation too (1989-2013) Sachin Tendulkar and Brian Lara. Did you like watching the three of us play and do battle out on the field?" wrote Warne along with the picture which he posted on his Instagram account on Tuesday.

Tendulkar made his debut against Pakistan in Karachi in 1989 as a 16-year-old. He went on to play 200 Tests for India, scoring 100 centuries across Tests and ODIs. In 463 ODIs, Tendulkar scored 18,426 runs including 49 tons and in Tests, he has 15,921 runs to his name, including 51 centuries.

Lara, on the other hand, remains the only batsman in world cricket to score 400 runs in an innings in Test cricket. The left-handed batsman played 131 Tests and 299 ODIs for West Indies, scoring 11,953 and 10,405 runs respectively.

Warne, one of the greatest spinners of all time, scalped 708 wickets in 145 Tests for Australia. In 194 ODIs, he picked 293 wickets.

I should've sacrificed my wicket for in-form Suryakumar: Sharma

Dubai,

Mumbai Indians (MI) captain Rohit Sharma admitted that he should have sacrificed his wicket for an in-form Suryakumar Yadav in the final of the Indian Premier League (IPL) on Tuesday.

Suryakumar ran out of his crease at the non-striker's end intentionally, after Sharma started running towards his end. The MI skipper eventually scored 68 runs while Suryakumar made 19 and end the season on 480 runs.

"The kind of form he was in, I should have sacrificed my wicket for Surya. Throughout the tournament he has played some incredible shots," said Sharma in the post-match presentation ceremony.

Suryakumar and Ishan Kishan belied their uncapped status to score more than 400 runs in the season. Rahul Chahar, who missed out on the final, took 15 wickets.

"Rahul missed out today, and we need to make sure we put an arm around him and assure him that he didn't do anything wrong and that it was a tactical move. We made sure Ishan and Surya had confidence — just have to let Ishan loose — and Surya is a more matured player," said Sharma.

Rahul walks away with Orange Cap, Rabada takes Purple Cap

Dubai,

Kings XI Punjab (KKIP) captain KL Rahul and Delhi Capitals (DC) fast bowler Kagiso Rabada won the Orange Cap and Purple Cap respectively following their superb performances in the 13th Indian Premier League (IPL) on Tuesday.

Rahul ended up as the highest run scorer, as he tallied a whopping 670 runs, scored at an average of 55.83, with five half-centuries and one century. His extraordinary form in the group stage meant that he remained on top of the charts despite KKIP not making it to the playoffs.

Delhi Capitals (DC) opener Shikhar Dhawan finished the season in second place with 618 runs after

being dismissed on 15 runs in the final against Mumbai Indians on Tuesday. He scored four half-centuries and two centuries, both of which came on the trot and made him the first Indian player to do so.

SunRisers Hyderabad captain David Warner was third with 548 runs, including four half centuries. He is the first player to score more than 500 runs for six consecutive seasons in the IPL.

DC captain Shreyas Iyer finished fifth with 519 runs while Mumbai Indians' Ishan Kishan rounds off the top five with 516 runs.

Rabada, who took one wicket in the final, finished the season with 30 wickets. His tally was second only behind Dwayne Bravo's 32

in the 2013 IPL for most wickets ever in a single season.

MI's Jasprit Bumrah went wicketless in the final and that meant that he ended up with 27 wickets — the most any Indian player has managed in a single season. His teammate Trent Boult came third with 25 wickets, 16 of which came in the powerplay overs. He thus finishes level with Mitchell Johnson's record for MI in the 2013 season for most wickets to come in powerplays during a season.

DC's Anrich Nortje was fourth with 22 wickets while Royal Challengers Bangalore's Yuzvendra Chahal rounded off the top five with 21 wickets.

Forward Gurjant Singh Hope to prove his mettle ahead of Olympics

Bengaluru,

Forward Gurjant Singh, who was part of the Indian men's team for the FIH Hockey Pro League earlier in the year, feels a little more accuracy in his game can help him be a regular in the team.

"Playing against top teams like Belgium and Netherlands was a great exposure for me. I feel there is more that I can do in order to improve and execute my role to perfection. These next few months will be important for me and I hope I can prove my mettle ahead of the Olympic Games," Singh said.

The team's core probable group has been living in a bio-secure environment at the Sports Authority of India (SAI) facility since August this year after a six-

week break. Living in a bubble where the players are not permitted out of particular zones can be difficult but Gurjant highlighted that the effort has been made easy with teammates.

"It is not easy going about a set routine and living in a bio-bubble where moving around out of the permitted zones within the campus is prohibited. The rules are followed to the T and these circumstances can be challenging for any player," said Singh, who was part of the FIH Junior Men's World Cup winning team in 2016. "We couldn't have done it without the team-bonding we share and the support we have received from the coaching staff who themselves have not stepped out of the campus

since the last nine months. They have become our family away from home," he added.

The forward further emphasised that this period has given him an opportunity to learn from his seniors and also understand the areas which he needs to pay more attention.

"I think as chief coach Graham (Reid) says, we need to make the most of the situation and utilize this time off competition to introspect about our own game. I have in these past months tried to pin point the areas I am not up to the mark and I have also been speaking to other forwards in the group about right positioning and timing. Players like Sunil, Akashdeep, Rameendep have all been quite helpful in this regard," he said.

Football Association chairman resigns after remark about black players

London,

Football Association chairman Greg Clarke has stepped down from the post after using "unacceptable words" for referring to black players.

Clarke, in a statement, said he was "deeply saddened" for the offence he had caused by using the term "coloured footballers".

The comments came when he was talking about the racist abuse of players by trolls on social media to the Department for Digital, Culture, Media and Sport (DCMS) select committee

via video link in the Parliament on Tuesday.

According to a report in BBC Sport, during the parliamentary hearing, Clarke apologised for his words after being prompted to say sorry by MP Kevin Brennan.

Brennan said Clarke's language in reference to black players was the kind that did not encourage inclusion, while fellow committee member Alex Davies-Jones called it "abhorrent".

"My unacceptable words in front of Parliament were a disservice to our game and to those who watch, play, ref-

eree and administer it. This has crystallised my resolve to move on," said Clarke in a statement.

"I am deeply saddened that I have offended those diverse communities in football that I and others worked so hard to include," he added.

"We can confirm that Greg Clarke has stepped down from his role as our chairman," said an FA statement.

It further confirmed that Peter McCormick will step into the role as interim FA chairman.

Australian team to wear indigenous jersey for India T20Is

Melbourne,

The Australian men's cricket team wear an indigenous jersey for the upcoming three-match T20I series against India beginning November 27, the design of which was unveiled by Cricket Australia on Wednesday.

The shirt continues the storytelling of the first ever Australia team to tour overseas when in 1868, a group of Aboriginal cricketers played 47 matches in the UK having made a three-month journey.

The jersey has been designed by Kirrae Whurrong woman Aunty Fiona Clarke, great-great-granddaughter of Grogarrong (Mosquito), who was one of the members of the team that played in England in 1868, designed the original Walkabout Wickets artwork that will feature on the front of the playing shirt.

It has been co-designed by Courtney Hagen, Butchulla and Gubbi Gubbi woman and Cricket

Australia's Indigenous Engagement Specialist.

The artwork represents past, present and future Aboriginal cricketers, with the large circle representing

Lord's and the smaller circles signify the team's various meeting places during that tour.

Australia's women's team wore a shirt with similar artwork earlier this year, while the Walkabout Wickets logo has been a feature on Test shirts and Indigenous shirts have featured in the WBBL and BBL, according to a report in ESPNcricinfo.

India's tour of Australia will commence with the three ODIs at the Sydney Cricket Ground (November 27, 29) and Manuka Oval, Canberra (December 2). That will be followed by the three T20Is at Manuka Oval, Canberra (December 4) and the SCG (December 6, 8).

The two teams will then compete in the Border-Gavaskar Trophy starting with the pink-ball Test in Adelaide from December 17. It will be followed by Tests at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (December 26), the SCG (January 7) and the Gabba (January 15).

BHU to reopen in phased manner

Varanasi, The Banaras Hindu University (BHU) will soon reopen in a phased manner. The university has been closed since March when the national lockdown was announced to check the spread of Covid-19 pandemic.

A decision to this effect was taken at a high-level meeting held under the chairmanship of Vice-chancellor Prof. Rakesh Bhatnagar at the central office of the BHU on Tuesday evening.

It was decided that separate committees will be formed at the university, faculty, department and hostel levels to formulate SOPs and monitor their compliance to prevent the spread of Covid-19 global epidemic and ensure the safety of students.

Based on the report of these committees, the university will be opened in a phased manner after the dates for reopening are decided.

The concerned departments have been directed to complete the sanitation and cleanliness work of the hostels which have been closed for a long time. The classes, meanwhile, will also continue in the online mode.

In this regard, departments can make their requirements known to the university administration, the BHU spokesman said.

Kanpur boy develops air purifier robot

Kanpur (Uttar Pradesh),

With concerns over air pollution increasing by the day, a Class 11 student from Kanpur has developed a unique robot that soaks up pollutants from the air and acts as a purifier.

Pranjal, and his classmate Aarendra, have invented an 'Air Purifier Robot' that comes with an air purifier machine installed within it.

"With rising air pollution, I thought of building a robot that could purify the air in the environment and soak pollutants at the same time. We have installed a purifier within the device for this purpose," said Pranjal.

When operational, the robot can filter the polluted air and clean air would be released in the atmosphere whereas the polluted particles will remain behind in the air filter inside.

With over 44K new corona infections, India records 86.4L cases

New Delhi,

With 44,281 new coronavirus infections and 512 deaths in the past 24 hours, India's overall tally stood at 86,35,921 on Wednesday as the toll touched 1,27,571, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare said.

Currently, there are 4,94,657 active cases, whereas 80,13,783 patients have been cured and discharged so far.

The recovery rate stands at 92.69 per cent, and the fatality rate is 1.48 per cent, the Ministry said.

The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) conducted 11,53,294 sample tests on Tuesday, taking the total tested samples to 12,07,69,151.

UN peacekeeping chief tests positive for COVID-19

United Nations,

UN Undersecretary-General for Peace Operations Jean-Pierre Lacroix has tested positive for coronavirus, Stéphane Dujarric, spokesman for UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres said.

Dujarric told reporters at the regular noon briefing on Tuesday that the diagnosis was made while Lacroix was in Portugal, where he was scheduled to attend a meeting on Security Council Resolution 1325, Xinhua news agency reported.

"As soon as he received a positive result, he notified local authorities and isolated himself in Lisbon. He is asymptomatic and will remain isolated for the required number of days as per standard medical guidance. Contact tracing was immediately implemented accordingly," said the spokesman.

"We are grateful for the Portuguese Government for their testing and logistical support. Mr. Lacroix is in fine spirits, as I can report," Dujarric added.

Speaking of contact tracing, Dujarric said that Lacroix was last in the UN headquarters in New York "more than a month ago."

"As you know, he had

been on a trip to Africa. I think he'd been in Ethiopia and Central African Republic, to name a few, with his counterpart in the African Union, Smail Chergui, and so we've been in touch with the African Union," he said.

"All the contact tracing has been done... He has not physically seen the secretary-general in more than a month," said the spokesman, adding that the UN peacekeeping chief "had been planning to go back to Africa to a number of peace operations, and those trips have been postponed."

The UN peacekeeping

chief said earlier on Twitter, "I've tested positive for #COVID19. I'm asymptomatic and isolating in Lisbon, working remotely."

"Contact tracing was immediately implemented. My thanks to Portuguese Govt for testing & logistical support and to everyone for their messages of support," Lacroix added on Twitter.

Guterres expressed on Twitter his wish of "a swift and complete recovery" for Lacroix. "As we continue our fight against the virus, let's keep supporting each other," said the secretary-general.



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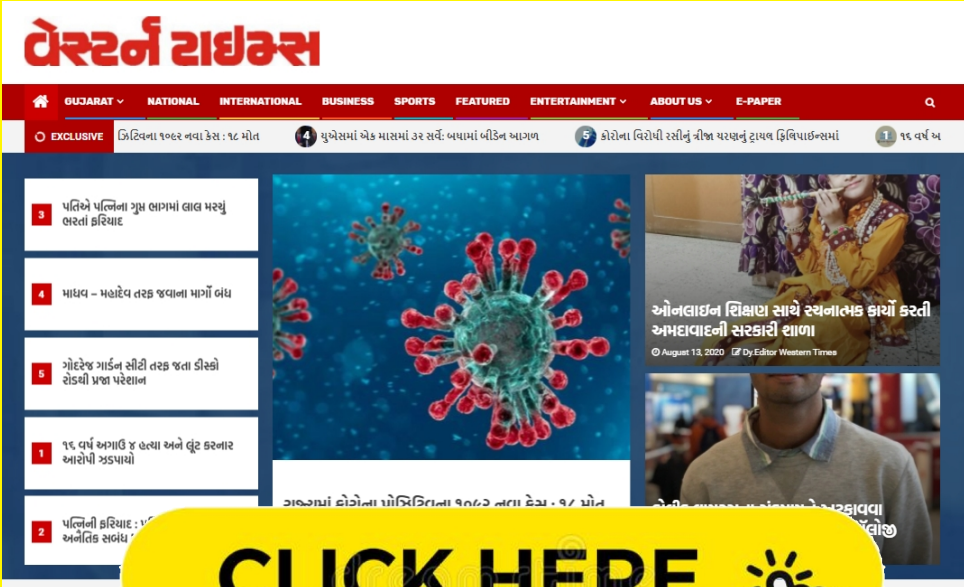

વર્તમાન સમયમાં સમગ્ર વિશ્વમાં કોરોના નામના રોગથી હાહાકાર ઉત્પન્ન થયો છે. આ રોગ ચેપી છે એટલે સર્વત્ર વ્યાપક પ્રમાણમાં ફેલાયો છે. સામાન્ય રીતે જોઈએ તો આ રોગની ચોક્કસ દવા ઉપલબ્ધ નથી. વળી આ રોગનો ફેલાવો થયો ત્યારથી જ રોગ પ્રતિકારક શક્તિ નામનો શબ્દ પ્રયોગ સમગ્ર વિશ્વમાં થવા લાગ્યો છે અર્થ એ છે કે જેના શરીરમાં રોગ પ્રતિકારક શક્તિ ઉત્તમ હોય છે તેને કોઈપણ રોગ થતો નથી. આયુર્વેદમાં વ્યાપકમાત્રા વિશે જણાવવામાં આવ્યું છે. વ્યાપકમાત્રા એ જ રોગ પ્રતિકારક શક્તિ છે આયુર્વેદ કહે છે કે પ્રાકૃત કંક એ બળ અથવા ઓજ છે અને વિકૃત કંક એ પાપ સમાન છે. કોરોનાએ કંકજન્ય વિકૃતિ છે અને તે અતિ કષ્ટસાધ્ય છે. આયુર્વેદ અનુસાર જોઈએ તો આપણા શરીરમાં ૧૩ પ્રકારનાં અંગિન હોય છે. તેમાં જ જરૂરિયાત સર્વોપરી છે. જરૂરિયાત સમપ્રમાણમાં હોય તો તેનાં કારણે શરીરમાં આમદોષ ઉત્પન્ન થતાં નથી અને શરીરની અન્ય ધાતુઓને પોષણ મળે છે. શરીરમાં સાત ધાતુઓ હોય છે અને તે દરેકના અલગ-અલગ અંગિ હોય છે તે તમામ સમપ્રમાણમાં હોય તો છેલ્લે ઓજની ઉત્પતિ થાય છે. આ ઓજ એ જ વ્યાપકમાત્રા કે રોગ પ્રતિકારક શક્તિ છે. કાળા મરી વિશે જોઈએ તો તે તીળા, તીક્ષ્ણ

અને દીપ્ત છે તે કંક અને વાયુ દોષને મટાડે છે. તે ઉષ્ણ પિત્તને ઉત્પન્ન કરનાર અને રુક્ષ છે તે દમ, શૂળ અને કૃમિનો નાશ કરે છે. સામાન્ય રીતે કાળા મરી સ્નાતકો એટલે કે વહન માર્ગમાં ઉત્પન્ન થયેલ અવરોધને દૂર કરે છે. પાચન વિષયક વિકૃતિઓને દૂર કરે છે. તે લાલશાવને ઉત્પન્ન કરે છે. દીપ્ત એટલે જઠરાગ્નિને પ્રદીપ્ત કરે છે અને ખોરાકનું પાચન કરે છે તે યકૃતને ઉત્તેજક કરનાર, વાયુનું અનુલોચન કરનાર અને કૃમિનો નાશ કરનાર હોવાથી મંદાગ્નિ, અજીર્ણ, યકૃતના રોગો, આકરો, પેટનો દુ:ખાવો, અનુચિ, કોલેરા અને કૃમિ રોગને મટાડે છે. મરી સ્વાદમાં તીષ્ણ તથા તીક્ષ્ણગુણ ધરાવે છે તેથી તે કંકનો નાશ કરે છે તથા કંકને બહાર કાઢે છે તેથી તે સળેખમ ઉધરસ અને દમને મટાડે છે. વર્તમાન સમયમાં ભારત સરકારના આયુષ વિભાગ દ્વારા કોરોનાગ્રસ્ત રોગીઓને તથા સ્વસ્થ વ્યક્તિઓને ઉકાળો પીવાનો આગ્રહ કરે છે. આ ઉકાળામાં કાળા મરીનો સમાવેશ કર્યો છે જે અતિ યોગ્ય નિર્ણય છે. ઉકાળામાં રહેલ મરીને કારણે આમદોષનો નાશ થાય છે. સ્નાતકોની શુદ્ધિ થાય છે. જરૂરિયાત પ્રદીપ થાય છે અને તેથી રોગ પ્રતિકારક શક્તિ ઉત્પન્ન થાય છે. મરીનો ઉપયોગ કરવાથી તાવ, શરદા, ઉધરસ અને દમ મટે છે તેથી વર્તમાન સમયમાં સૌએ કાળા મરીનો ઉપયોગ કરવો જોઈએ.

ચિનાઈ માટીની કીટલી ચિનાઈ માટીની ચા ભરવાની કીટલી સારી રીતે સાફ કરવી હોય તો કીટલીમાં થોડું મીઠું અને ભરફના ટુકડા નાખીને બરાબર હલાવવાથી અંદર ખાંચાઓમાં જામી ગયેલો મેલ દૂર થઈ જાય છે. અને કીટલી પણ ચોખ્ખી થઈ જાય છે. કઢીનો ઉભરો કઢી બનાવતી વખતે તેમાં ઉભરો આવતો હોય છે. ક્યારેક ધ્યાનચુકથી કઢી ઉભરાઈ ન જાય તે માટે કઢીના વાસણમાં ઉભરો આવે તે પહેલાં એક ખાલી વાટકી તરતી મુકી દેવામાં આવે તો કઢી ઉભરાતી નથી. ઊલેલા બટાકા શાક કે બીજા કોઈ વાનગી બનાવતી વખતે બટાકા જરૂર કરતાં વધારે છોલાઈ ગયા હોય તો વધારાના બટાકાને એક વાસણમાં પાણી ભરી તેમાં ડુબાડી દેવા અને પાણીમાં થોડાં ટીપાં સરકી નાખી દેવો. આમ કરવાથી બટાકા ચાર-પાંચ દિવસ એવા ન



બરફી નરમ લાગે તો બરફી ઠંડાં પછી જો સહેજ નરમ લાગે તો તેને થોડી વાર ફીજમાં રાખી મુકવાથી તે કઠણ થઈ જાય છે. ચાની કીટલી વાસ ચાની કીટલીનો ઉપયોગ કર્યા પછી એને તરત ધોઈ નાખો જેથી કીટલીમાંથી વાસ જતી રહે છે. લસણની સાચવણી લસણ સામટું ખરીદી લીધું હોય તો તેને લાંબો સમય સુધી એવું ને એવું રાખવા માટે કોરા માટલામાં બરાબર ઢાંકીને મુકી રાખવું જોઈએ. અંધારી જગ્યામાં લસણ લાંબો સમય સુધી એવું ને એવું રહે છે. જુના માટલા જુના માટલાને જાડા દળાયેલા મીઠાથી ઘોવાથી માટલું ચકચકીત થઈ જાય છે. અને સફેદ ડાઘા પણ જતા રહે છે. કંકમુળ કંકમુળને છાલ સાથે જ બાકવા જોઈએ, આમ કરવાથી તેનાં પોષકતત્વો યથાવત જળવાઈ રહે છે.

રવા કોકોનટ ઘૂઘરા



સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ મેદો, ૨ ટેબલસ્પૂન ઘી મોણ માટે, તળવા માટે ઘી. સ્ટર્કિંગ : ૧ વાટકી બારીક રવો, ૧ વાટકી સુકા કોપરાનું ખમણ, ૧ વાટકી દળેલી ખાંડ, ૧ ટી. સ્પૂન એલચી પાઉડર કિસમિસ, થોડા કાજુ-બદામના ટુકડા (નાખવા હોય તો) રીત : મેદામાં ઘીનું મોણ નાખી સાધારણ કઠણ લોટ બાંધવો. રવાને ગુલાબી શેકવો.

કોપરું પણ થોડું શેકી લેવું. ઠંડું થાય એટલે ખાંડ, એલચી, કિસમિસ તથા કાજુ-બદામ નાખી બધું બરાબર મિક્સ કરવું. હવે મેદાના લોટમાંથી થોડો લોટ લઈ નાની પૂરી વણી તેમાં વચમાં ૧ ટે. સ્પૂન તૈયાર પૂરણ મૂકી, પૂરીને ડબલવાળી કિનારને દબાવીને નખીયા વાળીને પછી બન્ને છેડાને પકડીને જોઈટ કરી દેવા એટલે ગોળ રીંગ જેવા ઘૂઘરા તૈયાર થશે. તેમાં વચ્ચેવચ એક લવિંગ ભરાવીને મધ્યમ તાપે ઘીમા ઓછા ગુલાબી તળવા.

ડ્રાયફ્રૂટ ઘૂઘરા

સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ મેદો, ૨ ટેબલસ્પૂન ઘી મોણ માટે, તળવા માટે ઘી. સ્ટર્કિંગ : ૧૦૦ ગ્રામ બદામ, ૧૦૦ ગ્રામ કાજુ, ૨૫ ગ્રામ પિસ્તા, ૨૫ ગ્રામ કિસમિસ, એલચી, કેસર તથા જાચકળ પાઉડર પ્રમાણસર, ૧૦૦ ગ્રામ દળેલી ખાંડ. રીત : મેદામાં ઘીનું મોણનાખી મિડિયમ કઠણ લોટ બાંધવો. પિસ્તાના બારીક ટુકડા કરવા. હવે કાજુનો ભૂકો, બદામનો ભૂકો, પિસ્તા, કિસમિસ, એલચી જાચકળ, કેસર તથા ખાંડ બધું મિક્સ કરી પૂરણ તૈયાર કરવું. મેદાના લોટમાંથી નાનો ગોરણો લઈ પૂરી વણવી. પૂરીને હાથમાં લઈ વચ્ચે એક ટેબલસ્પૂન સ્ટર્કિંગ મૂકી પૂરીને ડબલ વાળી કિનારને જરાક પાણીવાળી આંગળી કરીને દબાવીને નખીયા વાળવા. નખીયા વાળવા ન ફાવે તો કિનારને



દબાવીને પકી વાળી દેવી. આવી રીતે બધા ઘૂઘરા વાળી લ્યો. પછી લોયામાં ઘી ગરમ મૂકી મધ્યમ ધીમા તાપે ઓછી ગુલાબી અંચ પડે તેવા ઘૂઘરા નાખવા. ઠંડા થાય એટલે એરટાઈટ ડબામાં પેક કરીને રાખી દેવા.

મેથીના મુઠિયાં

સામગ્રી : ૧ કપ ચણાનો લોટ, ૧/૩ કપ એકદમ ઝીણી સમારેલી મેથી, ૧ ચમચી રવો, મીઠું સ્વાદ મુજબ, ૧ કપ તેલ, ગ્રેવી માટે સામગ્રી : ૧ ડુંગળી વાટેલી, ૨ ચમચા આદુ-લસણની પેસ્ટ, ૧/૨ કપ ઘઉં દહીં, ૧ ૧/૨ ચમચી મીઠું, ૧ ચમચી લાલ મરચું, ૧/૨ ચમચી હળદર, ૨ ચમચા ધાણા, ૪ ચમચા તેલ, ૧ ચમચી જીરું. રીત : મુઠિયાં બનાવવા માટે તેલ સિવાયની બધી સામગ્રી મિક્સ કરી દો. તેમાં ૨ મોટી ચમચી તેલ નાખીને મસાળો અને પાણીથી કડક બાંધી લો.

રોલ પણ સાથે જ બનાવી લો. ઉકળતા પાણીમાં રોલ નાખી દો. ૧૫ મિનિટ પછી તે ઉપર તરવા લાગશે ત્યારે બહાર કાઢીને ૧ ઈંચના જાડા ટુકડામાં કાપીને ગરમ તેલમાં તળી લો. મુઠિયાં પાણીનો ગ્રેવીમાં ઉપયોગ કરો. વાસણમાં તેલ ગરમ કરો. જીરુનો વધાર કરી વાટેલી ડુંગળી, આદુ-લસણની પેસ્ટ નાખીને સાંતળો. દહીં અને મસાલો નાખી તેલ છૂટું પડે ત્યાં સુધી સાંતળો. મુઠિયાંનું ઘઉં પાણી તેમાં નાખી ઊભરો આવવા દો. મુઠિયાં નાખીને ૧૦ મિનિટ સુધી રંધાવો દો. છેલ્લે સમારેલી કોથમીર અને ગરમ મસાલો નાખી ઉતારો.



દિવાળીમાં બનાવો અવનવી મિઠાઈ

અનાર દિલરુબા

સામગ્રી : મોટી સાઈઝના લાલ દાણાવાળા બે દાડમ, ૧ પ્યાલો ઠંડું દૂધ, (યાના કપનું માપ) ૮ થી ૧૦ ટુકડા પાંઉ, ત્રણ ચમચા ખાંડ, ત્રણથી ચાર ટીપાં લાલ રંગ, થોડુંક ગુલાબજળ, ૮ થી ૧૦ પેપરકપ. રીત : સૌપ્રથમ દાડમની છાલ કાઢીને દાણા કાઢી લો. એક પ્યાલો દાણા અલગ રાખી બાકીના દાણાનો રસ કાઢી લો. એ રસમાં થોડાક લાલ રંગના ટીપાં નાખી ખાંડ ભેળવીને ફિજમાં ઠંડુ થવા દો. ધારદાર ચાકુથી બ્રેડની સ્વાઈસની કિનારીઓ કાપી નાખો. દાડમના રસમાં થોડુંક ગુલાબજળ તથા ઠંડું દૂધ ભેળવો. ત્યારબાદ બ્રેડની સ્લાઈસને એ રસમાં ડુબાડી બંને હથેળીઓ વચ્ચે રાખી સહેજ દબાવી રસ નિયોવી દો. પછી એ પાઉંની સ્વાઈસમાં થોડાક દાડમના દાણા મૂકી બીજા હાથ વડે હળવા હાથે દબાવીને ગોળ ટિકીઓ જેવા આકારનો બનાવો. આ રીતે બધી જ દાડમ (અનાર) દિલરુબા બનાવો, પછી એક એક કરીને પેપર કપમાં ગોઠવી, ઉપર દાડમના દાણા છૂટા છૂટા નાંખી સુશોભિત કરી પીરસો.



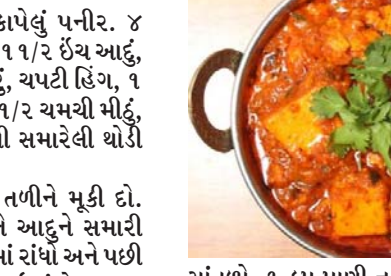

ખટમીઠું પનીર

સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ ટુકડામાં કાપેલું પનીર. ૪ ગાજર, ૪ ટામેટાં, ૧ ડુંગળી, ૧ ૧/૨ ઈંચ આદુ, ૩/૪ કપ તેલ, ૧ ચમચી જીરું, ચપટી હિંગ, ૧ મોટી ચમચી સોયા સોસી, ૧ ૧/૨ ચમચી મીઠું, ૧ ચમચી લાલ મરચું, ઝીણી સમારેલી થોડી કોથમીર. રીત : પનીરને તેલમાં તળીને મૂકી દો. ટામેટાં, ગાજર, ડુંગળી અને આદુને સમારી ૧/૨ કપ પાણીની સાથે કૂકમાં રાંધો અને પછી કાઢીને ઠંડુ કરી વાટી લો. કઢાઈમાં તેલ ગરમ કરો. હિંગ અને જીરાનો વધાર કરી વાટેલાં શાકની ગ્રેવી, સોયા સોસ અને મસાલા નાખીને



પનીર ખીર વિથ બેબી રસગુલ્લા

સામગ્રી : દૂધ - ૨ કપ, કન્ડેન્સ્ડ મિલ્ક - ૧ કપ, પનીરનું છીણ - અડધો કપ, કેસરનાં તાંતણા - ૮-૧૦ ખાંડ ૧ ચમચી, એલચીનો પાઉડર - ૫ ચમચી, મિક્સ સમારેલાં ડ્રાયફ્રૂટ - ૩ ચમચી, બેબી રસ ગુલ્લા - ૧૦-૧૨ નંગ. રીત : એક નોનસ્ટિક વાસણમાં દૂધને ઉકળવા ધીમા તાપે ઉકળવા મૂકો. જ્યારે દૂધ ઉકળવા માંડે ત્યારે તેમાં એક ચમચી ખાંડ અને કન્ડેન્સ્ડ મિલ્ક ઉમેરો. ૪-૫ મિનિટ પછી પનીરનું છીણ ઉમેરી સતત હલાવતા રહો. હવે તેમાં એલચીનો પાઉડર અને રસગુલ્લા ઉમેરી દેવા. ગેસ પરથી ઉતારી લેવી અને બાઉલમાં આ ખીર રેડી કે રનારડી કે રનારડા તાંતણા અને સમારેલાં ડ્રાયફ્રૂટ ઉમેરીને સર્વ કરવું.



રબડી પૂરી



સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ મેદો, ૧ પાકું કેળું, એક ચમચી ઘી મોણ માટે, ૧૫૦ ગ્રામ ખાંડ, ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ દૂધની રબડી, ૧/૪ ચમચી વાટેલી એલચી, ૨૦૦ ગ્રામ ગળ્યા પેદા, ૮ થી ૧૨ રાસબરી, ઘી તળવા માટે. રીત : સર્વ પ્રથમ ખાંડને એક કપ પાણીમાં ઓગળી મેલ દૂર કરો. કેળાને છોલી એને છૂંટી લુગટી બનાવી દો. ત્યારબાદ મેદામાં ઘીનું મોણ નાંખી કેળું ભેળવી ખાંડના ઓગળેલા પાણીથી કઠણ લોટ બાંધો. ૧૦-૧૫ મિનિટ સુધી રાખી નાના નાના લુઆ પાટી પૂરીને માફક વણી લો. ત્યારબાદ ઘી ગરમ કરી આછા તાપે સોનેરી લાલાશ પડતી પૂરી તળી લો. રબડીમાં (બાસુંદી પણ વાપરી શકાય). પિરસતા પહેલાં ઊંડી ડિશમાં એક એક પૂરી ગોઠવી તેમાં એક એક છીણ રબડી રેડો, ત્યાર પછી પેદાની છીણ ભભરાવો સોથી ઉપર રાસબરી મૂકો અથવા કોઈપણ ઋતુ અનુસાર ફળના ટુકડાથી પણ સજાવી શકાય. આમ તૈયાર થયેલ રબડી-પૂરી સજીવજીને માંમાં પાણી લાવશે.

માવા મગજના ઘૂઘરા

સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ મેદો, ૨ ટેબલસ્પૂન ઘી મોણ માટે, તળવા માટે ઘી. સ્ટર્કિંગ સામગ્રી : ૨૫૦ ગ્રામ માવો, ૧૨૫ ગ્રામ દળેલી ખાંડ, ૧૦૪ ગ્રામ મગજતરીના બી, એલચી પાઉડર. રીત : મેદામાં ઘીનું મોણ નાખી મધ્યમ કઠણ લોટ બાંધવો. માવાને ખમણીને એક વાસણમાં લઈ ગેસ પર ગુલાબી શેકવો. પછી ઉતારી લેવો. ઠંડા થાય એટલે તેમાં ખાંડ નાખવી. મગજતરીના બીને ઘીમા તાપે શેકીને તેમાં નાખવા. બધું બરાબર મિક્સ કરી એલચી પાઉડર નાખી બરાબર મિક્સ કરવું. હવે તૈયાર લોટમાંથી થોડો થોડો લોટ લઈ નાની નાની પૂરી વણવી. હવે એક પૂરી લઈ તેમાં વચ્ચે એક ટેબલસ્પૂન સ્ટર્કિંગ મૂકી ઉપર બીજી પૂરી મૂકી કિનારીને દબાવીને બંધ કરી નખીયા વાળવા. આ રીતે બધા ઘૂઘરા તૈયાર થાય એટલે મધ્યમ તાપે આછા ગુલાબી તળવા. બે-ત્રણ દિવસ બહાર રહેશે, વધારે દિવસ માવા હોય તો ફિજમાં રાખવા.



સૂરણ વટાણાની ભાજી

સામગ્રી : ૫૦૦ ગ્રામ સૂરણ, ૧ કપ વટાણાના દાણા, ૧ કપ છીણેલી ડુંગળી, ૨ મોટા ટામેટા ઝીણા સમારેલા, આદુનો ટુકડો, લીલાં મરચાં ઝીણાં સમારેલાં, ૧ ચમચી મીઠું, ૧/૪ કપ સમારેલી કોથમીર, ૧ કપ તેલ. રીત : સૂરણને છોલી નાના નાના ટુકડા કરી લો. કઢાઈમાં તેલ ગરમ કરીને તેને સોનેરી રંગ સાંતળી લો. કઢાઈમાંથી વધારાનું તેલ કાઢીને ડુંગળી, આદુ અને મરચાં નાખીને સાંતળો. તેમાં મસાલા અને ટામેટાં નાખો. ટામેટાં ચડી જાય ત્યાં સુધી હલાવતા રહો. ત્યારબાદ સૂરણ અને વટાણા નાખી ૧/૨ કપ પાણી પણ રેડી. શાક બરાબર રંધાઈ જાય પછી ઉતારીને કોથમીર નાખો.

એ લોવેરા જેલ : ઘૂંટણના દુખાવાથી છુટકારો પામવા એરોવીલા જેલ લગાડવું. તે હાડકાઓ અને માંસપેશિઓને મજબૂત કરે છે. એલોવેરા જેલથી ઘૂંટણ પર હળવા હાથે મસાજ કરવું. આ જેલ ત્વચાના રોમ્બોઈડોમાં જઈને ત્વચાની અંદરની કોષિકાઓ સુધી પહોંચીને પીડા ઓછી કરે છે. જો એ લોવેરા જેલ ન હોય તો તાજા એલોવેરાને લઈને જેલ તૈયાર કરીને ઘૂંટણ પર મસાજ કરી શકાય છે. શ્વાસની દુર્ગંધ દૂર કરવા : શ્વાસની દુર્ગંધ જાહેરમાં લોકોને શરમિંદા કરે છે તેને દૂર કરવા માટે એક રામબાણ ધરગથ્થુ ઉપાય છે પાણીમાં લીંબુ અને મીઠું ભેળવી સેવન કરવું અથવા તો કોળા કરવા.
