High command to decide on Raj Cabinet reshuffle: Gehlot

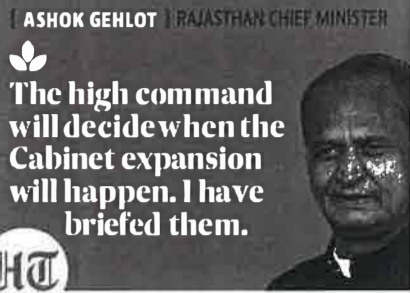

JAIPUR: Rajasthan chief minister Ashok Gehlot on Thursday said he has left the decision on the much awaited Cabinet reshuffle in the state to the Congress' central leadership, which will decide when will it happen.

The statement came a day after Gehlot met Congress leaders Priyanka Gandhi Vadra, Ajay Maken, who is also the party's Rajasthan in-charge, and KC Venugopal. Gehlot on Thursday met Congress chief Sonia Gandhi.

"The high command will decide when the Cabinet expansion will happen. I have briefed (the high command), Ajay Maken... keeps coming to Rajasthan. He had all the information," Gehlot said.

He added that Maken will speak to former Congress chief Rahul Gandhi and others about the decision.

"We are providing good governance in Rajasthan and the B.P. (Bharatiya Janata Party) has been being wiped out... it came third and the fourth in the by-polls to two seats," Gehlot said.

The Cabinet reshuffle has been awaited since Gehlot's former deputy, Sachin Pilot, revolted against him last year.

Congress functionaries aware of the matter said Pilot's associates are likely to get at least four ministerial berths and those close to Gehlot five. There are nine vacancies in the council of ministers.

Gehlot said the situation in the country is serious and that democracy and the Constitution are in danger as the judiciary and central agencies are being misused by the Union government.

He asked the Centre to further reduce the excise duty on petrol and diesel.

The Union government reduced the excise duty on petrol and diesel by ₹5 and ₹10 a litre on Diwali-eve.

Following this, many states ruled by the BJP and a few others followed suit. Rajasthan is among the states that hasn't done so. Gehlot has pointed out that the state levy is anyway an arduous one, and that the reduction by the Central government also means a reduction to some quantum in state levies.

On Thursday, he said that the share of states in duties on fuel have reduced (many of the central levies are cesses, which are not shared with the states) over the years and said he wants a "further reduction in excise duty on fuel prices. This will automatically reduce VAT."

Victim's father accuses cops of intimidation

AGRA: The father of a 22-year-old man, who died in police custody in Uttar Pradesh's Kasganj town, denied on Thursday that he had willingly affixed his thumbprint to a document saying his son was depressed and died by suicide. The 22-year-old, identified as Altaf, was called for interrogation at the Kasganj police station in an abduction case and died on Tuesday evening with his family members alleging that he was killed by police personnel. But the police claimed that Altaf, who was accused of eloping with a minor Hindu girl, had strangled himself using a string from his jacket hood in the washroom of the police lock-up.

Late in the evening, police produced a hand-written note that absolved the police of all blame in the case. The note, written in Hindi, said Altaf was depressed and had the thumb-

print of his father, Chand Mian, Kasganj superintendent of police Ratan Prasad Botre also referred to the note to say that the family had no complaints with the police.

But Mian said he was threatened by officials that his son's body will not be handed over to him if he spoke against the police. "I did what I was told to do by the police," he said.

"He said he was illiterate and couldn't read what was written before placing his thumbprint. I was neither in good health nor in a proper frame of mind when I

gave the statement and placed my thumb impression without knowing the content on the paper. Being in an unstable condition, I did what I was asked by the police to do," he said.

Taken aback by Mian's statements, the Kasganj police avoided comment on it. "Better ask father of deceased as to why he is changing his stand from one statement to another. What can police say about this?" stated ASP Kasganj, AK Singh.

Altaf, a resident of Ahiroli village of Kasganj district, worked as a tile fixer and was accused on November 8 of abduction and eloping with a minor Hindu girl by her family.

A case was registered at the Sadar Kotwali police station of Kasganj under Sections 363 and 366 (kidnapping, abduction) of the Indian Penal Code against Altaf. Police said he was taken in for questioning on Tuesday morning while family said it was on Monday evening.

"During interrogation, the accused went to the washroom at the police station, where he hanged himself to death from the tap," said AK Singh, additional superintendent of police.

"The accused was wearing a jacket with a hood and used its string which he tied to the tap in the toilet and hanged himself," he added.

Fatima, Altaf's mother, appealed to the government for a fair probe.

"There should be a Central Bureau of Investigation probe into the case as the suicide note narrated by the police is baseless. In any case, how can a man commit suicide by hanging himself from a 3-ft-high tap. We do not trust the post-mortem report, which cites 'hanging as the cause of death,'" said Fatima. HT has a copy of the post-mortem report which says there were no injury marks on the body and asphyxiation as the cause of death.

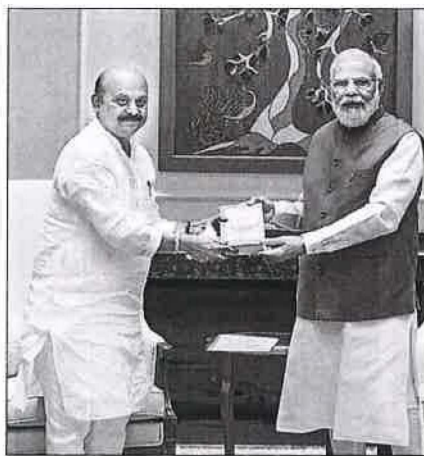
SRINAGAR: A terrorist was killed in south Kashmir's Kulgam district during an encounter on Thursday, police said.

Police said that on a specific information joint troopers of Army's 9 Rashtriya Rifles, Police and CRPF launched an operation at Chawalgam village. Defence spokesperson said that joint operation was launched in Chawalgam, Kulgam Thursday afternoon, based on specific inputs.

"As the cordon was laid and contact established. Terrorists opened fire forcing Security Forces to retaliate. Firefight ensued. The operation is in progress," said the defence spokesperson.

A senior police officer said that one terrorist has been killed in the operation.

K'taka CM meets PM Modi in Delhi

BENGALURU: Karnataka chief minister Basavaraj Bommai on Thursday met Prime Minister Narendra Modi in New Delhi. After the meeting, Bommai said the Prime Minister asked him "not to worry" about the Bitcoin case that has rocked the state and instead focus on developmental work.

"When I tried to speak to him about the issue (Bitcoin case), he said don't break your head over it. You (Bommai) work honestly and with dedication for the people and everything will be alright," Bommai said.

His statement comes against the backdrop of the Congress mounting an attack on the chief minister over the case. Speaking on condition of anonymity, a senior Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) functionary said the controversy has been stoked by the Congress but there is no evidence to suggest that the "CM or anyone linked to him has anything to do with the scam," HT

Congress seeks privilege motion against minister

NEW DELHI: The Congress has sought to move a privilege motion over Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader Tarun Vijay's appointment as the National Monuments Authority (NMA) chairman, saying the appointment does not meet the criteria laid down under a law passed by the Parliament for the post.

Congress's chief whip in Rajya Sabha Jairam Ramesh wrote a letter on Thursday to Venkaiah Naidu, the chairman of Parliament's Upper House on the privilege motion. He pointed out that Vijay, a former editor of the weekly Panchajanya of Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh, the BJP's ideological fountainhead, is ineligible for the post. Ramesh said the appointment makes a mockery of the law.

Ramesh cited the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains (Amendment and Validation) Act's Section 20F and said that it stipulates that the chairman to be appointed should have proven experience and expertise in

archaeology, town planning, architecture, heritage, conservation, or the law.

"For the first time, I find that the government of India has appointed a chairperson whose education and professional background does not, in any way whatsoever, meet the requirement of the law as stipulated mandatorily by Parliament," Ramesh said in the letter, a copy of which HT has seen.

Since Ramesh is seeking to move the privilege motion now, it has to be against the current minister. The Congress maintained the details of his appointment came into light later. Culture minister's office didn't wish to comment.

Lawsuit over workers' exploitation filed in US

WASHINGTON: A lawsuit alleging sub-human working conditions and meagre wages for workers from India at a temple built, maintained and run by a prosperous Hindu community has spread to four other US states from the first accusations that were levelled against a New Jersey temple in May.

Similar wages of \$120 an hour were paid to workers at this community's temples in Chino Hills, a Los Angeles suburb in California; Bartlett, a Chicago suburb in Illinois; Stafford, a Houston suburb in Texas; and Lilburn, an Atlanta suburb in Georgia.

The initial lawsuit was filed about the temple in Robbinsville, New Jersey, which is said to be the largest Hindu temple in the United States. The expanded lawsuit was filed in October, as first reported by the New York Times.

These temples belong to an organisation called the Bochasanwasi Shri Akshar Purushottam Swaminyan Sanstha, Inc

(BAPS), which is run by members of a Hindu community called the Swaminarayan Sanpradaya. The sect has 3,350 centres around the world. They have hosted and co-hosted Diwali celebrations on Capitol Hill, home to the US Congress, that have been attended by a large number of lawmakers. White House officials and Congressional aides.

The New Jersey temple was raided by the FBI in a "court-authorized action" under the lawsuit filed in May by six workers by name and 200 in all.

The lawsuit says that temple officials' actions constitute forced labour, trafficking with respect to forced labour, document servitude, conspiracy, and confiscation of immigration documents in the course of and with the intent to engage in fraud in foreign labour contracting.

The lawsuit brings claims under the Trafficking Victims Protection Act ("TVPA") and the Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organizations Act ("RICO"), which has been used by US authorities to bust the American Mafia.
