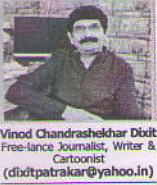

Don't we think there is an urgent need to highlight the important contributions that older people make to society and raise awareness of the issues and challenges of ageing in today's world. In many parts of the world elder abuse occurs with little recognition or response. Until recently, this serious social problem was hidden from the public view and considered mostly a private matter. Even today, elder abuse continues to be a taboo, mostly underestimated and ignored by societies across the world. It is a time not only to highlight their valuable contribution to the globe but also to stress their basic human rights. Many older persons are unaware of their rights and how to enforce them, due to a variety of reasons. WEAD aims to provide an opportunity for communities around the world to promote a better understanding of the abuse older people suffer by raising awareness of the cultural, social, economic, and

demographic processes affecting them. Elder abuse is one of the least investigated types of violence and does not get addressed in national action plans as frequently as other key social issues.

Today the elderly persons are important in raising global awareness as a huge advocacy effort to call for more enhanced international thinking and actions on elderly rights. Today the life expectancy has risen sharply due to medical advancement, improvements in nutrition, sanitation, medical science, health care, education and economic well-being. Ageism is widespread and an insidious practice which has harmful effects on the health of older adults. The ageing process is a biological reality and affects every human being on earth. Ageism rests on the assumption that discrimination against older persons is the norm and acceptable. Article 1 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights states that "All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights". We must do everything possible to ensure that our elders can lead a life of dignity, enjoy the best of medical attention, economic security as well as emotional stability.

The Older persons make wide-ranging contributions to economic and social development. They should be encouraged to get out of their retirement mentality and think about old age as second innings and opportunity to complete so



many unfinished tasks and expand horizons to look beyond the family and work for the community. As per WHO, there are around 600 million persons world-wide aged 60 years and over and this total will double by 2025 and it is estimated to reach virtually two billion by 2050 - the vast majority of them in the developing world. The elderly ones should be given protection and respected all around the world. People should stop abusing elders and start understanding their problems and take care of them. The World Elder Abuse Awareness Day as the name says should be used to remind everyone to create awareness to protect elderly people. We need to look at creating a more enabling and inclusive environment that is supportive and inclusive to people of all ages, including older people. The failure to tackle ageism undermines older persons' rights and hinders their contributions to social, economic, cultural and political life. "The younger generation should know how the world addresses the elderly. The problem of old age should be seen as a societal issue rather than an individual's problem. A day will come when we all will be old and we will be facing the similar situation as faced by our elders today. ## Insurance firm ordered to pay Rs 10 lakh death claim to Gujarat family

AHMEDABAD: "A Below Poverty Line (BPL) ration card is not conclusive proof of a person's income," a district consumer commission has said and has ordered an insurance company to pay Rs 10 lakh death claim to the family of an insured person. The family had been denied the insurance amount

on the grounds that it held a BPL card. In this case, Kanubhai Solanki from Kappadvani town of Kheda district had obtained a Rs 10 lakh life insurance policy from Birla Sun Life Insurance Co Ltd in July 2012. He died of cardiac arrest in January 2019. His family members sought the insurance amount, but the company rejected the death claim on the grounds that Solanki had declared false income. He had showed Rs 1.80 lakh yearly income, but his family was holding a BPL card, the company said. The insured had not supplied the BPL card to suppress the facts about his income, the company said. The family sued the insurer with the Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Ahmedabad (city), and submitted that Solanki had never applied for a BPL card, but the government had issued BPL cards to the whole area. The family got a BPL card after Solanki had obtained the insurance policy, the family said. The family argued that a BPL card cannot be the basis for the assessment of income and it cannot be said that a poor person will always remain so. The family said that Solanki was not poor and was a garment merchant. It said that the rejection of his death claim represented deficiency in service. The company reiterated that the claim on the basis of a BPL card and had obtained the policy fraudulently. After hearing the case, the commission opined on August 18 that the declaration of correct income is not a material fact for the issuance of a policy. Solanki had paid three premiums and the policy was in force at the time of his death. The insurer cannot deny the claim on the basis of a BPL card, the commission said. "The BPL ration card cannot be considered conclusive proof of income of the card holder."

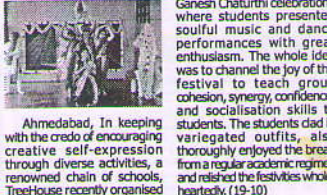
## Repos launches Repos Pay: its tech tool called DATUM
