Edelweiss reports ₹2,281.5-cr loss due to jump in impairments

Mumbai, July 5

Edelweiss Financial Services on Saturday reported a consolidated net loss of ₹2,281.5 crore in the March quarter due to 1,277% year-on-year (y-o-y) increase in impairments.

The total impairments stood at ₹2,549 crore, compared to ₹185.11 crore in the same quarter last year. The jump in impairments happened due to revision in the Expected Credit Loss (ECL) model and impact of Covid-19. The firm had earlier announced to revise ECL model in December quarter. Its total income dropped 35.3%

y-o-y to ₹1,965.8 crore in the March quarter.

"In this quarter, we have taken three conscious decisions based on our experience and that of our board: The markdown and sell-down of our corporate asset book, accelerating to capital light model in retail credit, and the proposed equity raise at Edelweiss and in our wealth & asset management business," said Rashesh Shah, chairman and chief executive officer, Edelweiss Financial Services.

The company said that it has recently finalised a sell-down transaction of ₹4,000 crore with two global investors for its wholesale loans and plans to sell another ₹3,000 crore of such

loans in the financial year 2021 (FY21). The firm is planning equity capital raise of ₹1,500-2,000 crore in FY21, it said.

Edelweiss also said that it has assessed Covid-19 impact on liquidity at ₹4,000 crore in the first six months of FY21. "The impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on group's results, including credit quality and provisions, remains uncertain and dependent on the current and further spread of Covid-19, steps taken by the government and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to mitigate the economic impact and also the time it takes for economic activities to resume and reach the normal levels," Edelweiss said.

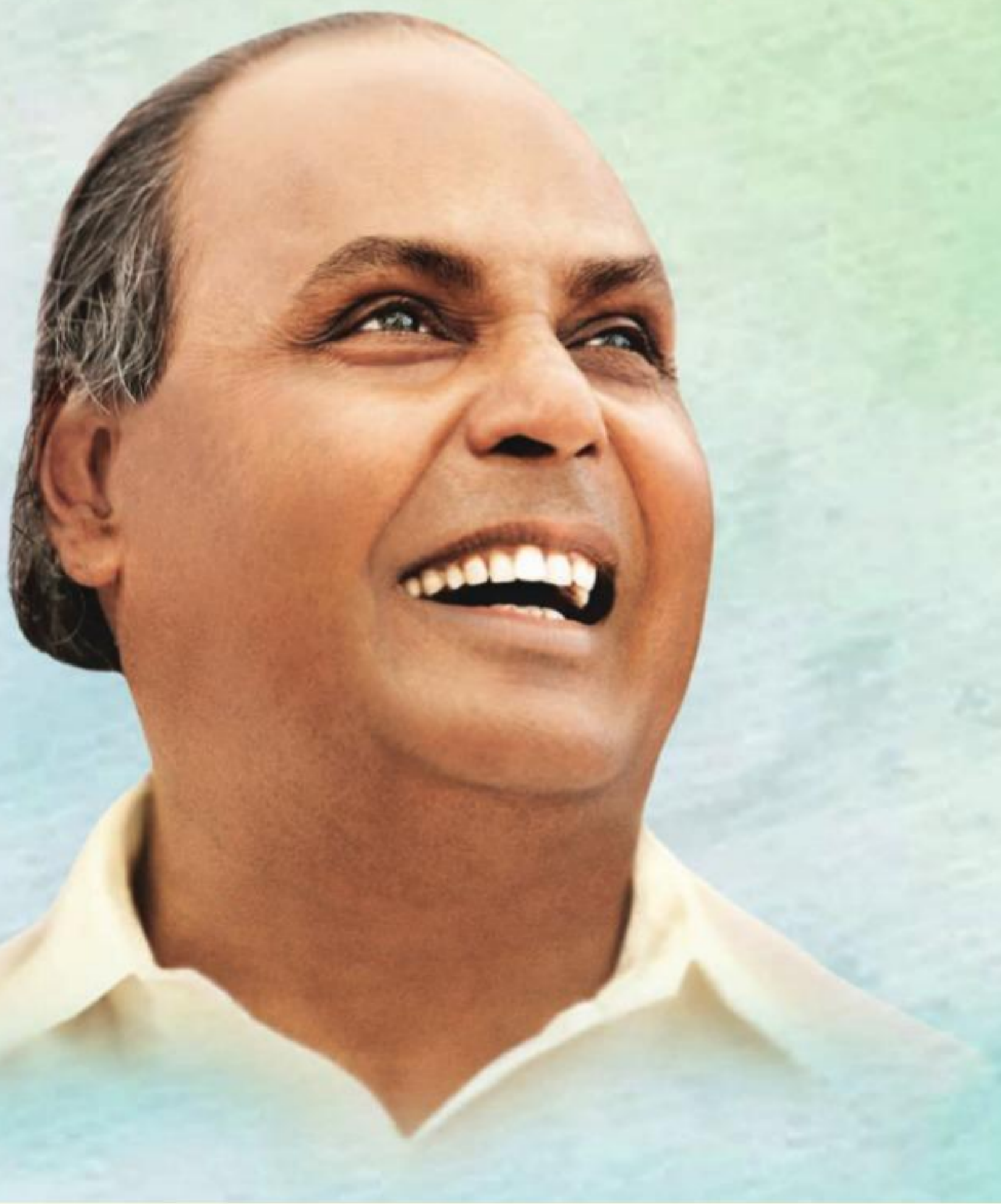

23 KILLED IN LIGHTNING INCIDENTS IN UP

LUCKNOW/BHADOHI: At least 23 people were killed and 29 others injured after being struck by lightning in various districts of the state on Saturday. According to an official statement, eight people lost their lives in Allahabad, six in Mirzapur, two in Kaushambi and one in Jaunpur. A report from the Relief Commissioner's Office said that nine others in Prayagraj, 10 in Mirzapur and four in Kaushambi suffered serious burns. CM Yogi Adityanath has expressed deep anguish over the loss of lives and directed respective DMs to extend ex-gratia of Rs 4 lakh to the next of kin of those killed.

TEEN GIRL RAPED, ATTACKED BY YOUTH

MUZAFFARNAGAR: A 14-year-old girl was allegedly raped and later beaten up by a youth in a village in Uttar Pradesh's Muzaffarnagar district, police said on Sunday. The incident happened in a village under Charthawal police station limits of the district on Saturday, its SHO Suresh Singh Yadav said. According to Yadav, a complaint was lodged by the girl's maternal uncle and a case was registered against the main accused and his three friends who beat up the victim. All the accused men are absconding while the victim has been sent to hospital for a medical examination, the SHO added.

KANPUR SHOOTOUT PROBE

'Dubey enjoyed support of some cops on caste lines'

KANPUR: Vikas Dubey, the prime accused in the shootout in which eight police personnel were killed at Bikru village in Kanpur early on July 3, allegedly enjoyed the support of some policemen on caste lines, according to those privy to the investigation. This was the reason that despite 60 known criminal cases against him and a career in crime spanning 28 years, Vikas Dubey did not figure on the list of top 10 criminals of Kanpur, they said. The police never registered his gang's name at the district level, they added.

At present, about 30 policemen are under investigation after UP Special Task Force and investigators found they were in touch with him. Inspector general of police, Kanpur range, Mohit Agarwal said three policemen were in touch with Dubey and a parallel investigation was going on to unearth this nexus. "Services of police personnel in league with him will be terminated and they will face criminal trial," he said. Another official said the staff of the entire Chau-beypur police station was suspect.

Two senior police officers of deputy SP rank, one of them currently posted as a circle officer, a number of sub-inspectors and constables have been questioned. The deputy SP posted in Kanpur was asked why he did not follow the routine procedure of invoking the Gangster's Act and registering Dubey's gang at the district level after another shootout, which Vikas Dubey's men carried out in Kalyanpur. The officer was also questioned in the context of a murder assault on Vikas Dubey's brother Anurag Dubey in Kalyanpur. Anurag's wife Rita had lodged an FIR naming Vikas, his closest aides Pawan Tiwari, Aman Tiwari and two others with the police on April 18, 2018. "The officer kept mum on repeated questions about why he went soft on him (Dubey). The reaction of others was no different," said an official involved with the investigation.

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UP BOARD EXAMS

Error-free High School, Inter mark-sheets this year

PRAYAGRAJ: In a first, the UP Board is planning to issue error-free mark-sheets-cum-certificates to all of the over-52.57 lakh students who appeared in its high school and intermediate exams. For this, it is making the most of the additional time it has got due to coronavirus outbreak. The board plans to save students from the running around that usually follows post distribution of mark-sheets-cum-certificates each year for making corrections in these vital documents, according to board officials. Board secretary Divyakand Shukla has sought details of all redressals made as a follow-up of the complaints and requests received at the grievances cells set up at all five regional offices including Prayagraj, Varanasi, Bareilly, Gorakhpur and Meerut. The aim is to ensure that all corrections are entered into board records well in time before the board undertakes the printing of the mark-sheets-cum-certificates, officials say.

'Pay a month's fee by July 14 to continue online classes'

LUCKNOW: Students of unaided private schools, whose parents don't deposit at least one month's fee of the first quarter of the current academic session by July 14, will be denied access to online classes from July 15 onwards. Unaided Private Schools' Association (UPSA), Uttar Pradesh, has taken a decision to this effect. Giving this information, Association's president Anil Agarwal said, "School fees should be paid immediately by parents who are able to. UPSA, UP, as well as school organisations of several other districts have decided to deny online classes to students from July 15 if there parents do not deposit one month's fee along with an application of adjusting remaining two-months' fees in the following months."

The decision comes after additional chief secretary (secondary education) Aradhana Shukla asked the parents, who are regularly getting their salaries, to deposit school fees as many private schools are struggling to pay salaries to their staff because several parents have not paid fees of their wards on time for the lockdown period. UPSA has also decided that only students with 75% attendance in online classes will be promoted to next class and all the schools will take admission only after obtaining NOC issued from the students' old schools.
