PARIS: World lead-ers, heads of international organisations and activists are gathering in Paris for a mit aimed at two-day summit aimed at seeking better responses to tackle poverty and climate change issues by reshap-ing the global financial sys-tem. Developing nations point to an outdated sysem where the United States, Europe, China and States, Europe, China and other big economies that have caused most climate damage are leaving the poorest countries to deal with the consequences. The Paris talks also come as the COVID 10 condends the COVID-19 pandemic, the war in Ukraine and a global debt crisis have led to a drop in life expectancy and an increase in poverty in most countries around the world, the United Nations Development Program reported. French President Emmanuel Macron, dent Emmanuel Macron, who organized the summit, said the fight against pov-erty, efforts to curb global warming and the protec-tion of biodiversity "are closely intertwined. We therefore need to agree
