## Mystery shrouds final hours of couple found dead inside bathroom

THE CAUSE of death of Ghatkopar-based couple Deepak Shah (45) and Tina Shah (39), whose bodies were found inside the bathroom of their flat in a Ghatkopar high-rise on Wednesday, remains shrouded in mystery as their post-mortem report on Thursday ruled out murder, suffocation or death due to electric shock or injury.

Police are now focusing on a six-hour period on Tuesday when the movement of the couple is unaccounted for.

An officer said that while the post-mortem report was inconclusive about the cause of death, it ruled out murder, suffocation or any external injury mark as the cause of death. The officer added that while there was a gas geyser in the bathroom, it was not switched on.

"The door of the bathroom and the glass door that separated the toilet and the bathroom were ajar when the domestic help and family members reached the house. So there was no chance of them being suffocated," said the officer.

Vital organs of the two bodies have now been sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory at Kalina, where a viscera test will be conducted to see if any poisonous substance is found. The officer said that some vomit-type substance was found in the bathroom, which too has been sent for forensic testing.

Meanwhile, police teams are focusing on the movement of the couple between 3.30 pm and 9.30 pm on Tuesday. An officer said that on Tuesday morning, the couple, along with five friends, had gone to a ground in Juhu near Ritambhara College, where their community had organised a get-together to cele-

brate Holi.

The couple reached the ground at 11 am and left around 3.30 pm along with two friends. "One of their friends was with them till the Chheda Nagar junction in Ghatkopar, till around 3.15 pm. The couple, who were then five minutes away from their residence, reached the building only at 9.30 pm, according to the watchman," said a police officer.

"The CCTV cameras at the building were not working, so we couldn't find footage of them entering the building, but the watchman said they came to the building around 9.30 pm," the officer added.

"We have formed teams to look through CCTV footage to find out where the couple went from Chheda Nagar for six hours," the officer said.

Meanwhile, the last rites of the couple were carried out at a crematorium in Ghatkopar on Thursday evening. An officer said the couple got married around two years ago, after they met in Bengaluru, where Deepak ran a garment business.

This was Deepak's second marriage. He has two children from his first marriage.

## Hot weekend on cards for Mumbai

MUMBAI IS set to experience a hot weekend, as the day temperature is expected to rise significantly in the next three days.

The India Meteorological Department's (IMD) Santacruz observatory on Thursday recorded 37.9 degree Celsius, six degrees above normal. The IMD's coastal observatory at Colaba recorded 36.4 degrees Celsius, five degrees above normal. Besides, the night temperature also

showed a significant rise on Thursday, as the Santacruz and Colaba observatories recorded above normal temperatures of 21.6 and 24.4 degrees Celsius, respectively. On March 6, Mumbai was the hottest in the country at 39.3 degrees Celsius - the highest maximum temperature recorded in the city so far this year.

Following unseasonal rain that lashed parts of Maharashtra, including Mumbai, from Tuesday midnight, the city's temperature has seen a significant dip. However, experts said the temperature will increase this week.

"Between March 10 and 12, the city's temperature may range between 36 and 39 degrees Celsius and by March 12, it will be at its peak. This will happen mainly due to the presence of strong easterly wind, which is delaying sea breeze. However, after March 12, the temperature may again dip slightly," Sushma Nair, scientist from IMD, said.

The relative humidity recorded in Santacruz on Monday was 57 per cent. In Colaba, it was 46 per cent. The city's AQI again dipped to the poor category at 215.

## 20-hour mega block by WR

Mumbai: The Mumbai Division of the Western Railway (WR) will operate a 20-hour block between March 11 and 12 to remove a steel girder to dismantle the Gokhale bridge. The steel girder will be removed in two parts. At the

Andheri station, on platform 9, the girder will be removed between 9.30 pm and 5.30 pm. On platform 4, from where the up and down local train services are operated, the block will be operated from 12.10 am to 4.40 am. **ENS**

## Court asks NCB to return passport of celebrity manager for renewal

ASPECIAL court recently directed the Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) to return the passport of celebrity manager Karishma Prakash so that it can be renewed.

Prakash was granted anticipatory bail by the Supreme Court last

October after she was probed in connection with the drugs case lodged after actor Sushant Singh Rajput's death.

Prakash had approached the court, stating that her passport expired in December and she had requested the NCB to return it for its renewal, but got no response from the agency. NCB opposed her plea, stating that she may not be avail-

able for further investigation and repeat such offences.

"At this stage, the situation is that NCB has not chosen to file a complaint against (Prakash). Passport was seized by NCB and the applicant has all rights to get her passport renewed from competent authority and therefore NCB must return the passport..." the special court said.

## Civic body announces strict norms for work on project to concretise 397 km of roads

TO KEEP a check on the quality of work, the BMC on Thursday announced stringent guidelines for its Rs 6,000-crore project to concretise 397 km of Mumbai roads.

The BMC had issued a work order for the project in January to five contractors. In a circular (accessed by *The Indian Express*) issued on Thursday, the BMC administration said the contractors will not be allowed to appoint sub-contractors or smaller agencies for the works.

Further, the circular stated that payment for men and material shall be directly made by the winning bidder (contractor who was awarded the work) from its company's accounts. It maintained that a periodical audit of vouchers by specific teams will be carried out to check whether the payment for men and materials are being made through the company's accounts.

The circular was issued by P Velrasu, additional municipal commissioner (Projects).

"The work order for the project has been awarded to big companies. There have been incidents in which big companies internally appoint smaller agencies to execute the work at a cheaper rate, to generate additional profits, which in turn results in poor quality of work," Velrasu said.

"Therefore, to prevent such malpractices and to keep a check on the quality of work, we have come up with these stringent guidelines so that the contractors only carry out the work with their own manpower... disobeying the rules may also result to blacklisting them from future works," he added.

After Chief Minister Eknath Shinde announced that roads in Mumbai would be made free of potholes, the civic body had issued a mega tender to concretise roads.

The Bhoomi Poojan for the project was carried out by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on January 19 and work began in the first week of February.
