and KMs done, and also the option of locating the nearest Revolt Switch Station to swap your Revolt's battery at, and be on-the-move in less than 60 seconds. Revolt RV300 features a 1.5KW (Hub Motor), 60-volt, 2.7 kWh lithium-ion battery which delivers the longest range of 180km. It comes with USD forks up-front and a fully-adjustable monoshock at the rear.

Both the models feature three riding modes - Eco, Normal and Sport – each suiting to the riding style and needs of the driver. Both RV400 and RV300 come with Upside Down (USD) forks up-front and a fully-adjustable monoshock at the rear to give an unparalleled riding experience.
