the Easter bombings. A person named Abdul Sakhtar Mohammed, alleged to have been in charge of the finances of the NTJ, was arrested in Gampola area, the Sri Lanka Mirror reported. —Agencies

15 dead, 15,000 infected by dengue in Sri Lanka

Fifteen people have died and over 15,000 infected by dengue across Sri Lanka in the first four months of this year, the Epidemiology Unit said in Colombo on Friday.

The April 30, total 15,407 dengue cases were reported with highest 3,405 cases from the Colombo district, followed by Gampaha on the outskirts of Colombo (2,007) and Jaffna in the north (1,783). *Xinhua* reported.

Medics urged people to seek immediate medical aid

if they suffered from high fever, uncontrolled vomiting, abdominal pain, dizziness and reduced urinary. All fever patients need rest and must refrain from attending work or school. Dengue haemorrhagic fever can be fatal, epidemiologists said.

In 2018, more than 50 people died and over 48,000 affected by the dengue virus in Sri Lanka, with the National Dengue Control Unit launching several programmes to eradicate dengue's breeding grounds in several districts of the island country.

India-based Reuters lensman gets bail

COLMBO: An India-based photo journalist of Reuters news agency was given bail on Friday after he was arrested by Sri Lanka police for alleged unauthorized entry into a school, officials said.

Siddiqui Ahmad Danish, who is based in New Delhi, was arrested on Thursday when he allegedly attempted to forcibly enter a school in Negombo city to speak to its authorities. He was later remanded by the Negombo magistrate till May 15, police said. Through a special motion on Friday, his lawyers pleaded bail for Danish. He was released on surety bail and was asked to appear in court on May 9.

Meanwhile, a media report said the Lankan govt will deport all foreigners staying in the country without a visa or with an expired one as part of the heightened security measures in the wake of the Easter Sunday bombings. —Agencies

5 lakh evacuated in Bangladesh

Bangladesh on Friday evacuated over five lakh people from its southwestern districts as cyclonic storm 'Fani', brewing over the Bay of Bengal, is drawing closer and is likely to hit the country late night and cause severe damage after ravaging the Indian coastlines.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has classified 'Fani' as an "extremely severe cyclonic storm".

Met office spokesman Omar Faruque said the cyclone is likely to "enter Bangladesh through Khulna coastlines and will take the entire night to cross the country, ravaging southwestern coastal districts.

Bangladesh skyline turned dark in many parts of the country since noon as 'Fani', dubbed to be the deadliest cyclone in decades to hit the region, started approaching, albeit with an weakened force, after ravaging India's eastern Odisha coastlines, weather officials said.

IS bride will be hanged: Bangladesh Minister

Shamima Begum, a British teenager who ran away in 2015 to become an Islamic State (IS) jihadi bride, will be hanged for "terrorism of fences" if she comes to Bangladesh, the country's Foreign Minister has said.



In an interview to Britain's *ITV*, Bangladesh's Foreign Minister Abdul Momen said the 19-year-old—who is currently living in the Al-Hol desert refugee camp in Syria—would face the death penalty if she ended up in the South Asian country.

She was also stripped of her British citizenship by Home Secretary Sajid Javid in February. Shamima Begum is of Bangladesh descent, the country's Foreign Ministry denied it.

"If anyone is found involved with terrorism, we have a simple rule. There will be a capital punishment. And nothing else. She will be put in prison and immediately the rule is, she should be hanged," Momen said. Begum ran away from her London home as a schoolgirl after reading about the IS online.

Faruque said the impact of the approaching cyclone caused downpour in some parts of the country and the intensity of the rainfall is expected to increase.

Disaster management ministry's senior secretary Shah Kamal told *PTI* by afternoon, around 5,50,000 people were shifted from the coastal districts to shelters or other safer places.

"In most vulnerable areas like river shoals, we are trying to help people move out along with their valuables and cattle as well," he said. The evacuees were being provided dry food, while "we have enough stock of relief materials for them", he added.

Officials said two-third of people from vulnerable areas like Kolar and Dakop in Khulna district, through where the cyclone was likely to penetrate Bangladesh, have been evacuated.

Facebook bans 'dangerous individuals'

After years of pressure to crack down on hate and bigotry, Facebook has banned Louis Farrakhan, Alex Jones and other extremists, saying they violated its ban on "dangerous individuals". The company also removed right-wing personalities Paul Nehlen, Milo Yiannopoulos, Paul Joseph Watson and Laura Loomer, along with Jones' site, InfoWars, which often posts conspiracy theories.

The latest bans apply to both FB's main service and to Instagram and extend to fan pages and
