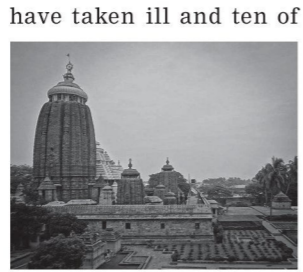
10 devotees faint inside Puri Jagannath Temple due to heavy rush

PURI, NOV 10 --/ At least 10 devotees fainted inside the Shree Jagannath Temple here on Friday and were taken to the district headquarters hospital here, police said.

The Shree Jagannath Temple Administration (SJTA) chief administrator Ranjan Kumar Das said the heavy rush of devotees was responsible for the incident that took place in the early hours of the day. The Hindu

month of Kartik is considered holy and large number of devotees flock to the 12th century temple to pay their obeisance to Lord Jagannath.

"Those who fell ill were mostly elderly persons. We are augmenting the arrangement to ensure smooth darshan of devotees inside the temple," Das said. According to preliminary information, about a dozen devotees were reported to



Devotees have taken ill and ten of them fainted soon after Mangal Aarati in the temple. They fell down as the crowd of devotees surged

inside. They were given preliminary treatment in the Temple and then shifted to Puri hospital.

Das said Jagannath Temple Police (JTP) helped the devotees who fell down. Most of the injured persons were discharged after treatment, officials said. Puri superintendent of police KV Singh said, "There was rush in the temple but no stampede. A total 15 platoons (450 personnel) of the police

were deployed to control the crowd. Their number will be increased keeping in view the rush of devotees." One of the devotees said that those who went for darshan of the deities were allowed to enter the temple after the morning 'Mangala Aarti'. As the gates opened many of them scrambled towards the deities and some of them fell down and became unconscious near Ghanidwara and Satapahacha in the Temple (PTI)

Kolkata Police bust fake call centre, arrest 8 for duping US citizen

KOLKATA, NOV 10 --/ Kolkata Police on Friday busted a fake call center in the city and arrested eight people for allegedly duping a US citizen of US \$1,44,000 (about Rs 1.2 crore), a senior official said.

The fake call center was busted in the New Alipore area of the city and the eight were arrested from there during a raid, he said. Several mobile phones, one laptop, and two hard discs were seized during the operation, the official said. The US citizen was defrauded on March 2 this year by the eight accused who used Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) and posed as officers of the

Cyber Security and Infrastructure Security Agency, a US body meant to protect that country's cyberspace, the police official said. VoIP is a technology that allows voice calls to be made by using a broadband internet connection instead of a regular (or analog) phone line. "The accused persons had induced the victim on the pretext of conducting a sting operation and took remote access to her computer system and siphoned off US \$1,44,000 from her account," the official told PTI. The police are investigating the role that the eight accused played in defrauding several

US citizens, he said. The information about the racket was received at the city's Cyber police station through the CBI and Interpol, who were intimated about the crime by Federal Bureau of Investigation. "We raided the fake call center at New Alipore and arrested the eight accused. A considerable number of documents were also seized. The documents establish the call center's role in duping several US citizens, including the victim of the instant case," he said. The arrested are residents of Behala, Parnasree, and Sarsuna areas, which are near New Alipore, the official added. (PTI)

KOLKATA, NOV 10 --/ A man from Bihar was arrested in Kolkata's Jorasanko area on Thursday with around 900 kg of banned firecrackers, police said. Acting on a tip-off, the Anti-Roadway Section of the Kolkata Police's Detective Department nabbed him from a Bihar-bound bus, they said. The man procured the banned firecrackers from Budge Budge in South 24 Parganas districts and was taking those to Bihar when he was nabbed, they added. (PTI)

Nitish's food being spiked by those coveting his chair: Manjhi

PATNA, NOV 10 --/ Hindustani Awam Morcha chief Jitan Ram Manjhi on Friday alleged that "poisonous substances" were being mixed into the food served to Bihar CM Nitish Kumar, by those "coveting his chair".

Manjhi, a former CM, made the allegation while speaking to journalists outside the Vidhan Sabha premises, a day after he was upbraided by Kumar, his former mentor, on the floor of the House. "Nitish Kumar used vulgar language a few days ago which caused him to apologise in

both Houses of the legislature. Yesterday he again lost control over himself and spoke to me in an insulting manner, forgetting that I am senior to him in age and political experience. This is a sign of deteriorating mental health", alleged Manjhi, who was flanked on both sides by members of the BJP, his current ally.

Manjhi also disclosed that he would meet Governor Rajendra Arlekar on Saturday to apprise him of the "grim situation" prevailing in Bihar. "I also demand a high-level inquiry into the food served to Nitish Kumar which, I suspect, is being laced with substances which would make him go insane. There are some people around him who are coveting his chair", said Manjhi, who refused to elaborate further. Notably, Kumar had given Manjhi a tongue-lashing

on Thursday when the latter had raised doubts over the government's caste survey following which quotas in jobs and educational institutions for the deprived sections have been raised by 15 per cent in the state. Both Houses of the legislature were adjourned till 2 pm, on the last day of the winter session, following an uproar over Manjhi's issue. The assembly also witnessed high drama before the commencement of proceedings at 11 am as BJP members gheraoed the

Speaker's chamber while those of the ruling 'Mahagathbandhan' staged a demonstration outside attacking the saffron party over alleged poor treatment of women by its leaders, including MP Braj Bhushan Sharan Singh and former Union minister Chinmayanand. Members of both sides entered the House carrying the placards which were snatched away by security personnel upon instructions from Speaker Awadh Bihari Chaudhary. The Speaker conducted the Question Hour for about 20 minutes, during which many Opposition members stayed in the well raising slogans and hooting the treasury benches where the CM was also seated. Before adjourning the proceedings till post lunch session, the speaker noted with dismay "It is clear that you people do not want the House to run". (PTI)
