BJP's state chief CR Patil to hold 2 public meetings in Ahmedabad



February 21 and vote counting for it will take place on February 23.

Ahmedabad: Gujarat BJP President CR Patil will address two public meetings in Ahmedabad on Sunday. Both the public gathering will be held in the evening. CR Patil, who successfully led BJP to victory in the bypolls last year, is looking to get more than 175 plus seats in the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation elections. On February 14, CR Patil will hold a public gathering at Dariapur and then in Nikol. BJP aims to win most of the seats in AMC. The BJP will also highlight its work through LED lights in the city. BJP has planned to distribute pamphlets and conduct a door-to-door campaign for the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation elections.

Minister Pradipsinh Jadae and BJP leader TK Jadae will also inaugurate BJP offices in several wards of the city. The BJP star campaigners including cabinet minister Smriti Irani, Purushottam Rupala, and Mansukh Mandaviya will also participate in the election campaign in the city. BJP has also declared ex-MLA Alpesh Thakor as its star campaigner for the civic body polls.

To win civic body polls in Gujarat, BJP has made the slogan 'Gujarat Che Makkam, Bhajap Che Adikham'.

BJP brought in a new rule for civic body polls where those above the age of 60 years will not be given tickets for the local body elections in Gujarat. BJP this time has thus given tickets to many youngsters, although this has led to some disappointment among senior leaders. BJP also did not give a ticket to PM's niece Sonal Modi who had sought a ticket from Bodakdev ward. Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation elections will be held on

Surat runway strip to be made strong as per int'l standards

Surat: The Airports Authority of India (AAI) has invited tenders for the strengthening the Surat airport runway strip for reducing damage to the runway in the event of an unintentional excursion from runway surface, as per the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) standards. The project, which was to be taken up during the runway expansion of 5.5 metres in 2016-17, has been delayed by five years. A runway strip—and its graded portion—aims to reduce the risk of damage to aircraft running off the runway and to protect the aircraft flying over it during take-off or landing operations. Aircraft manufacturers consider a depth of 15cm below the finished strip surface be prepared to have a bearing strength of California Bearing Ratio (CBR) of 15. The intention of this underlying the prepared surface is to prevent the nose gear of the aircraft from sinking more than 15cm in the event of excursion and veering off from the main runway. A senior AAI officer seeking anonymity said, "The input cost for the strengthening of the runway strip at Surat will be increased by 30% as the prices of cement and steel have increased compared to 2017. However, the runway strip work is the need of the hour to protect the aircraft in the event of excursion from the main runway." Sources said that the Surat airport authorities had requested the AAI headquarter for taking up the improvement and stabilisation of the runway strip. However, the AAI postponed the project. At present, Surat airport has more than 15 flights per day to various domestic destinations in the country.

Court rejects bail of accused who stole 3 lakh litre crude oil by puncturing IOC pipeline

Ahmedabad: A local court in Ahmedabad has rejected the bail of a man who allegedly stole 3 lakh litre crude oil worth Rs60 lakh by puncturing a pipeline of Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL). The court while rejecting the bail of Ismail Modan said the accused is involved in an offence where there is a provision for capital punishment too. The man is accused of being involved in an offence that is against the country, society, or national property. His anticipatory bail plea was also rejected earlier.

The man put public life in danger and other accused involved in the offence are yet to be arrested and hence court was not inclined to grant bail. This sort of offence cannot be taken lightly, the court said. The accused is booked under the Damage To Public Property Act, Petroleum & Minerals Pipeline Amendment Act 2011, and several other provisions of IPC. The public prosecutor argued before the court that the accused is a history-sheeter and has been booked for similar kinds of offences earlier too. The accused damaged public property worth Rs60 lakh by stealing 3 lakh litre crude oil from the IOC pipeline in Bareja. The investigation is at a preliminary stage and other accused are

yet to be arrested and hence bail should be denied. The advocate appearing for the accused submitted before the court that the applicant is not named in the FIR and was arrested on the statement of co-accused involved in the case. The applicant has no role in the offence, he is just involved in the business of oil. Nothing has been recovered or discovered from the applicant and being a resident of Ahmedabad, he will not run away if granted bail and so it should be given to him. A complaint was

registered against the accused who allegedly punctured the IOCL pipeline near Bareja. As the oil pressure got low due to the theft, the engineer of the company registered a complaint with the police. The stolen oil was taken through pipelines that were going into farms near the area. Police lodged a complaint against both the owner of the land from where the pipelines were connected.

The Company has considered the possible effects that may result from the pandemic relating to COVID-19 on the carrying amount of its assets are fully recoverable, equipment, investments, inventories, receivables and other current assets. In developing analysis on the assumptions used and based on current estimates the assumptions relating to the possible future uncertainties in the global economic conditions including conditions in India because of this pandemic, the Company, as at the date of approval of these financial results has used internal and external sources on the expected future performance of the Company.
