Note for information of Media

This is to inform that an unfortunate accident has occurred in one of the boilers of NLC India Ltd. today evening at around 17.00 hours. The fire broke out at the TS II Power plant at Neyveli, resulting in burn injuries to two regular employees and six contract workers. The injured persons were immediately shifted to Kaveri Hospital in Trichy where they are undergoing treatment. The fire which broke out has since been brought under control by the Fire wing of CISF Unit of NLCIL.

Arising out of the incident, two other generating units of 210 MW capacity each have also been shut down and these units will be restored for power generation only after all safety aspects have been taken care of which is expected to be completed shortly.

Simultaneously, the Company is ensuring that the injured workmen are given best possible treatment with necessary support extended to their families by NLCIL.

The Company has constituted a six member Committee headed by a General Manager to enquire into the incident and give its findings at the earliest for taking further necessary action.
