● SUPPLY-CHAIN DISRUPTION ENDING

Shipping costs ease but MSME exporters still face difficulties

GLOBAL FREIGHT RATES have dropped 20% since the Ukraine war started on February 24, in signs that a supply-chain disruption is easing, although the rates are still 13% higher than a year earlier. Trade sources told *FE* that while container availability has improved for Indian exporters in recent weeks, small and medium players are still facing this issue. Nevertheless, the easing rates have brightened India's export prospects at a time when it is eyeing a second straight year of robust growth.

According to Drewry's composite World Container Index, the rate for a 40-foot container declined to \$7,579 as of June 9 from \$9,477 as of February 24, but it's still up 13% from a year before.

Freight costs had spiked in 2022, as demand for goods surged following an industrial



resurgence in advanced economies.

But a lockdown in select cities of China in recent months to contain a fresh surge in Covid cases has put a leash on Chinese demand for containers. Similarly, global growth has come under strain after the Ukraine conflict caused international commodity prices — especially of oil — to surge. These factors have resulted in the drop in shipping costs.

However, given the spike in global oil prices and uncertainties around the Ukraine war, shipping costs may not go down considerably from the current level.

Moreover, once Chinese demand starts rising again, freight costs may inch up. Mahesh Desai, chairman of the engineering exporters' body EEPIC India, said the situation has improved, both in terms of shipping costs and container availability.

Global freight rates started surging at a fast pace in the aftermath of the Covid outbreak in 2020 and hit a peak of \$10,377 per 40-ft container in late September 2021, according to Drewry's index.

The rates started easing thereafter to \$9,051 as of December 2, before inching up again to \$9,180 by March 10. Of course, exporters concede the shipping costs have spiralled across the globe and India isn't an outlier.

Sunil Sawla, former president of Indian Oilseeds and Produce Export Promotion Council, said the situation is still far from the normal (pre-Covid scenario). "But it's better than the worst exporters have faced in terms of post-Covid freight costs," Sawla said.

Trade sources said large exporters have benefited more than the MSME ones in securing containers, as most of them get preference in bookings. Typically, large exporters do the bookings through established brokers, so they get better access to containers.

Ensuring reasonable shipping costs remains crucial to realising India's lofty merchandise export target of \$1 trillion by FY28. Exorbitant shipping costs hurt mainly small and medium exporters. The country's exports rebounded strongly in FY22 and hit a record \$422 billion, compared with the previous peak of \$330 billion.

GNFC set to become largest concentrated nitric acid producer by the end of year

GUJARAT NARMADA VALLEY Fertilizers & Chemicals (GNFC), a joint sector company promoted by the Government of Gujarat and the Gujarat State Fertilizers & Chemicals (GSFC), is all set to become the largest producer of concentrated nitric acid (CNA) by the end of the current calendar year.

"At present, we are making 1,15,000 metric tonne (MT) CNA annually. The company has three plants of CNA at its Bharuch complex. Now we have initiated the process of installing a fourth plant of 50,000-MT annual capacity. With this, GNFC's production will escalate to 1,65,000 MT by the end of year 2022," said Pankaj Joshi, MD of GNFC, while speaking to *FE*.

Pune-based Deepak Fertilizers and Petrochemicals is currently the highest producer of CNA with installed capacity of 1,30,000 MT. According to Joshi, almost 90% of the CNA produced by GNFC is used for captive consumption. CNA is used for the production of ammonium

nitrate, a major component of fertilisers. It is also used for producing explosives, like nitroglycerin and trinitrotoluene (TNT) as well as oxidising.

Metal prices fall from April highs, but volatility sticky

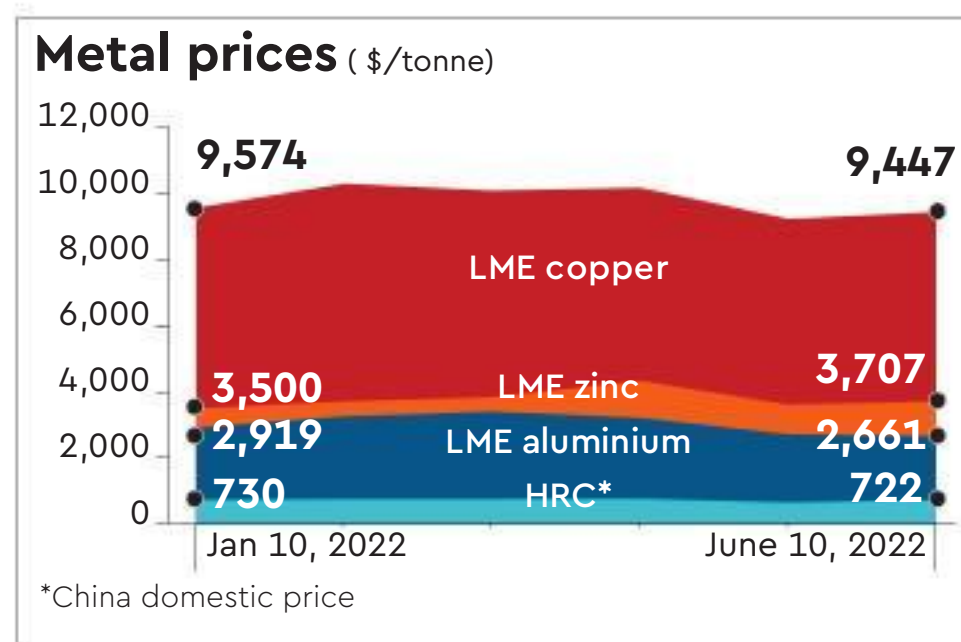

GLOBAL PRICES OF base metals have fallen 9-17% since April from highly-elevated levels, providing some comfort to user industries in India, which have seen sharp spikes in input prices in tandem with the world trend.

However, some metals like copper and aluminium have of late turned volatile again.

Analysts say though some correction was due after the rally caused by the geopolitical turbulence, metal prices are likely to remain somewhat elevated through the current year, amid high volatility.

Between April 11 and May 10, aluminium prices have fallen by 15% on the LME, copper by 9% and zinc by 17%. The domestic price of hot-rolled coil (HRC) of steel in China also fell 15%.



But since then, prices have staged some recovery. As on June 10, zinc prices on the LME are up by 3% and copper by 2% though aluminium prices continued to slide a bit. China's domestic HRC prices are up 11% from the level a month ago. In India, steel prices are dependent on the landed cost of imports, while prices for other metals are mostly linked to LME prices.

Pricing powers of metal companies may come under some pressure.

In the Indian markets, in the month till June 13, Tata Steel stocks were down by 10%, Hindalco by 6%, Hindustan Zinc 1.5%, but Hindustan Copper stocks were up 5%.

In a report last week, Moody's Investor Services said, "Prices for copper, zinc,

nickel and aluminium reflect low inventories and supply risk related to Russia. Supply, which was tight even before disruptions from the military conflict, will remain constrained."

"We expect prices and earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortisation (EBITDA) to remain historically high. The aggregate EBITDA decline will be driven by steel (non-US) and iron ore producers as their earnings are decreasing from unsustainably high levels because of high energy and input costs. EBITDA will rise for other commodity producers, supported by contin-

ued high prices," said Barbara Mattos, senior vice-president, Moody's Investors Service.

Icra's Jayanta Roy also said, "Price volatility to prevail in the international market with gradual downward bias. Given high inflation prompting central bankers to raise interest rates, there are clouds on economic prospect across the world which will adversely impact demand for metals and in turn, prices."

In a May 30 interview with *FE*, JSW Steel's joint MD & group CFO MVS Seshagiri Rao said, "The steel prices have corrected more than 10-12%. Unless cost pressure

comes down, don't expect steel prices to correct significantly from the current levels because steel companies will not be able to make money."

Rahul Sharma, director - India at International Zinc Association (IZA), said prices of zinc might remain at the current level. In April, the International Lead and Zinc Study Group said that after rising by 4.1% in 2021, global demand for refined lead is anticipated to rise by 1.7% in 2022 to 12.42 million tonne (mt). Similarly, global demand for refined zinc is expected to go up by 1.6% to 14.26 mt in 2022. It rose by 5.1% in 2021.
