Government surrenders to criminals: Jitu Patwari

The girl who was raped in Bhanwarpura, Gwalior, her family has left the village. The victim's family has gone to Shivpuri. According to the police, the family has been considering their safety. Police have also arrested Akash Gurjar, the third accused in the gang rape of a fifteen year old girl in Bhanwarpura. Akash's father Gabbar Singh operates a mine illegally, the victim's parents used to work as laborers at the same mine. Akash told that Bunay Gurjar had also raped Sanjeev. The police administration has used a bulldozer on Bunay Gurjar's house.



Here, Madhya Pradesh Congress President Jitu Patwari has conveyed the state government over the rape of a minor daughter in Gwalior. Patwari said that the family of the 15 year old girl who was gang-raped in Bhanwarpura, Gwalior, had to leave the village. Patwari said that the accused and his relatives belong to the same village, hence the police say that there is a threat to the life of the family in the village and the victim's family has been sent to Shivpuri under police surveillance.

He urged the Chief Minister that Mohan Yadav is the Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh and also the Home Minister, public safety is your responsibility, law and order is the option of migration, the victim's family should be made to feel safe. Then it will be considered that the government has surrendered before the criminals.

State Organization General Secretary Hitanand along with cluster in-charge Prahlad Patel, Kailash Vijaywargya and Lok Sabha extension were present. Regarding the meeting, State President VD Sharma said that meetings were held with the convenors, in-charges of our cluster, all the Lok Sabha convenors, in-charges and expanders regarding the resolution of increasing the votes by

10 percent at each booth for the Lok Sabha elections. When 40 families of Jatav community were stopped from serving plates in Bhandara, adopted Buddhism

In village Bahugwana of Karara tehsil, 40 families of Jatav community abandoned Hindu religion and adopted Buddhism when they were stopped from serving plates in the Bahugwa Katha Bhandara. However, the Sarpanch says that all the allegations are baseless, the villagers have been seduced and made to accept Buddhism. According to the information, the villagers had organized Bhagat Katha in village Bahugwana by donating donations. On January 31, a day before the Katha Bhandara, 40 families of the Jatav community suddenly accepted Buddhism and took an oath to abandon Hinduism. Mahendra Buddhists says that work was distributed among all the communities in the Bhandara, in the same



sequence the Jatav community was assigned the task of serving patials and picking up false patials, but later someone said that if the people of Jatav community would serve patials. Then the lead will get spoiled. In such a situation, they should be made to do only the work of picking up false leaves and in the end the villagers said that if you have to pick up false leaves then do so, otherwise go to your home after having food. According to Mahendra Buddhists,

because of this untouchability, we asked the society to adopt Buddhism and all the people adopted Buddhism. Village Sarpanch Ganendra Rawat says that the allegations are completely untrue. According to him, the people of Jatav community had distributed basana prasad with their own hands a day earlier, which was taken and eaten by the entire village. Buddhist monks had come to the village, they seduced the people of the society and got them converted to religion. In the entire village, no work was distributed to any particular community, everyone did all the work together. People from other Scheduled Caste communities have also got Pats (parashad) done and have taken up false papers. According to Ganendra, due to the withdrawal of the donation given by the Jatav community, the villagers have made donation again to fulfill it.

In Indore, Rani Rawaliya has been made the convenor and MP Sumar Singh Solanki has been made in-charge. In Jabalpur, Sarlanand Godwala has been made convenor, Rajkumar Patel as co-convenor and Narendra Tipathi in-charge.

BJP and Congress intensified preparations for Lok Sabha elections in Madhya Pradesh

Prime Minister Narendra Modi may visit Madhya Pradesh on 11 February. He will sound the trumpet of Lok Sabha elections from Bhopal. State BJP has started preparations for this. Balwan Prasad Shrivastava said, the meeting was held with the resolution of increasing the vote share by 10 percent at every booth. Last time it got 58 percent votes in the Lok Sabha elections. This



time our target is to achieve 68 percent vote share. After getting a landslide victory in the assembly elections, BJP is now eyeing the tribal voters in the Lok Sabha elections. Also, along with the BJP government led by Dr. Mohan Yadav, the focus of the organization is on the tribal vote bank. The share of tribal voters in the state is around 22 percent. This is the reason whether the ruling BJP or the

opposition Congress is leaving no stone unturned to woo the tribals. The number of tribal voters in Madhya Pradesh is about 22 percent. Out of 29 Lok Sabha seats in the state, 6 Lok Sabha seats are reserved for tribals. At present BJP is in control of all the seats, 47 assembly seats in the state are reserved for tribals. There are a total of 78 assembly seats in Madhya Pradesh, where tribal voters have the power to make someone win or lose. This is the reason why BJP and Congress are leaving no stone unturned to woo them. Congress has decided on the 50-50 share formula for 29 Lok Sabha seats in Madhya Pradesh. Congress will give tickets to youth on 14 to 15 seats out of 29. Senior leaders will contest the remaining seats. Congress leader Sanjay Singh Verma gave this information during the party's screening committee meeting at the state Congress office on Saturday.
