Let us meditate on the reflection of water. O Lord of Ocean Blue, give me higher intellect. And let the God of Water illuminate my mind.

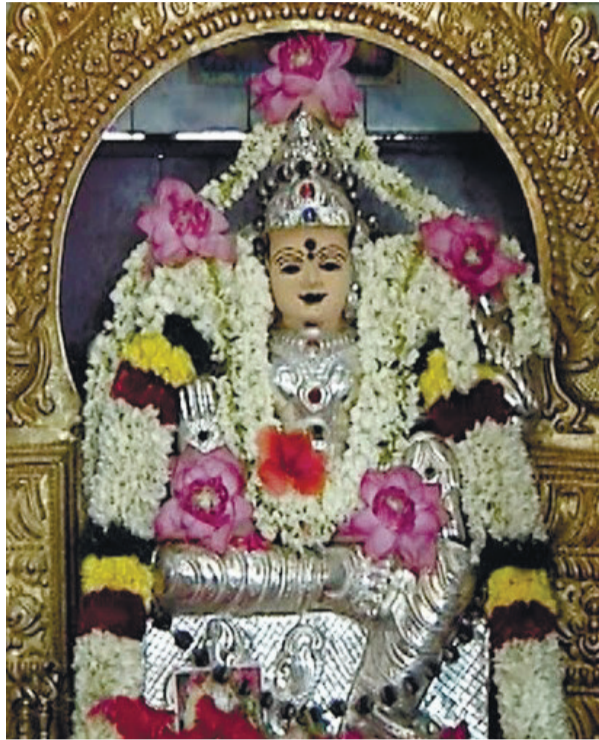
Sri Varuna Bhagavan Temple is located at Serayampalayam Road, Neelambur, Coimbatore. This is one of the few temples built during the 20th century. The temple is believed to have been constructed at a time when the people in this area suffered greatly due to drought and famine.

Lord Varuna is one of the important Vedic deities described elaborately in the hymns of the Rig Veda. The four Vedas

describe him as a deity who created heaven, earth, and air. He is considered to be omnipresent and omniscient. Varuna means "he who covers." He is also the controller of rivers, streams, lakes, and oceans. He is also known as the "God of Oceans". That is the reason why fishermen offer prayers and perform to this Lord before going fishing.

**Legend**  
Lord Varuna is believed to be one of the most ancient deities in Hinduism and is regarded as a universal monarch. In Rigveda, Varuna is thought to be the keeper of the moral law, one who disciplines.

Lord Varuna is the son of Sage Kashyapa and one of the twelve gods regarded as Adityas. In Hindu scriptures, he is regarded as the father of the Vedic sage Vasishtha. Varuna is considered to be the lord of the waters and was assigned the job of controlling the clouds



and rains. Thus, he is revered as the King of Waters and manages the rivers, seas, oceans, and all the water bodies. It is also believed that worshipping the deity shields us from thunder and lightning. According to one of the mythologies, Varuna, being the ruler of the Asuras, was adopted

his 'all-comprehensive wisdom', are cited in the Atharvaveda.

**Deities**  
The main deity of the temple is Varuna Bhagavan. There are also other shrines for Siddhi Vinayaga, Sri Bala Murugan, Kasi Viswanathar, Srinivasa Perumal, Bairavar, Dakshinamurthi, Hanuman, and Navagrahas.

**Pujas**  
The temple performs the usual pujas every day. Special pujas are done for Bairavar on Mondays, which attracts a huge crowd of devotees.

**Festivals.**  
The temple celebrates all the days of Navarathri in a grand and colorful manner. Tamil New Year Day and Deepavali Day are also celebrated with special pujas to the deity.

**Benefits**  
Devotees carry water in pots for abhishegam to the deity, to be devoid of all their worries and enjoy prosperity. Worshipping the Lord can help cure many diseases. The deity is also said to help people who are afraid of water.

## Krishna dons role of Arjuna's spiritual mentor

**Chapter 1: Battlefield of Kurukshetra**

Two armies, those of the Pandavas and the Kauravas, face each other on the Battlefield of Kurukshetra. Many signs indicate victory for the Pandavas. Dhrtarashtra, the Pandavas' uncle and the Kauravas' father, doubts the possibility of his sons' victory and asks Sanjaya, his secretary, to describe the scene on the battlefield.

Arjuna, one of the five Pandava brothers, undergoes a crisis just before the fight. He is overwhelmed by



compassion for his family members and teachers, whom he is supposed to kill. He elaborates to Krishna many noble and moral reasons why he is

reluctant to enter into a battle with his kith and kins. Arjuna casts aside his weapons, overwhelmed with grief. Arjuna's kind heart is finding it

hard to reason out the need to fight. Such a person needs to change his mind as the situation demands. That is possible only when he is bestowed with transcendental knowledge. **Chapter 2: Gita in a Nutshell**

Krishna is not sympathetic towards Arjuna's arguments for not fighting the battle. Krishna reminds Arjuna that his duty is to fight and advises him to overcome his weakness. Arjuna is torn between his desire not to kill his relatives and Krishna's firm order that he should fight. Driven by sorrow and anguish, Arjuna seeks the guidance of Krishna and surrenders and becomes his disciple.

Krishna takes on the role of Arjuna's spiritual master and starts a long spiritual dialogue to convince Arjuna. He starts by saying that the soul is eternal and cannot be destroyed. Dying in a battle paves the way for the gallant fighter

to reach heavenly planets. From this perspective, Arjuna should feel happy that the people he is about to kill will benefit from superior births. The individual is eternal. Only his physical body perishes. Therefore, there is nothing to grieve.
