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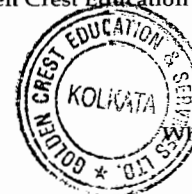

We have audited the standalone financial results ('the Statement') of Golden Crest Education & Services Limited for the quarter and year ended March 31, 2022 attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('the Regulation').

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the Statement:
