This is to inform that NBCC (India) Limited has secured new works for various infrastructure projects. NBCC has secured following new works.

- 1. **Development of permanent campus at IIM Visakhapatnam:** New work from Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Visakhapatnam to provide Project Management Consultancy services for development of permanent campus (Phase-1) amounting Rs. 463 Crores (approx).
- 2. Development of Medical College And Hospital Chamba (Himachal Pradesh): New work to provide Project Management Consultancy services for development of Medical College And Hospital Chamba (Himachal Pradesh) amounting Rs. 200 Crores (approx).
- 3. Development work under Namami Gange Programme at Bihar: Company also secured various Ghat Rehabilitation & Development works at Bihar. Ministry of Water Resources, River Development Ganga Rejuvenation, Govt. of Indiaentrusted NBCC to take up the entry level activities pertaining to Ganga Rejuvenation in the various towns of Bihar along river Ganga. The estimated project cost is Rs. 100 Crores (approx).
- 4. NBCC also secured Rs. 130 Crores of additional work of IIT Bhubaneswar Campus.
- **5. Puducherry Railway station Redevelopment:** After starting Charbagh & Gomati Nagar, Lucknow Railway Station Redevelopment, NBCC secured and started Puducherry Railway Station Redevelopment. The estimated project cost is Rs. 110 Crores (approx).

With reference to letter dated June 30, 2017; NBCC and Rail Land Development Authority (RLDA), a statutory authority under the Ministry of Railways had signed a MoU for re-development of 10 nos Railway stations i.e. Tirupati, Puducherry, Ernakulam, Nellore, Madgaon, Thane New, Charbagh (Lucknow), Kota, Gomati Nagar (Lucknow) & Sarai Rohilla (Delhi).

The total estimated costs of these projects are Rs. 1003 Crores (approx).
