# Bharat Sangeet Utsav begins tomorrow, top Carnatic stars to perform

Chennai, Nov 8: Bharat Sangeet Utsav 2022 is back at Narada Gana Sabha, Alwarpet from Nov. 9 to 15 and it will feature some of the top tanking artistes. The festival is organised by Carnatica and Sri Parthasarathy Swami Sabha.

Sri Parthasarathy Swami Sabha and Carnatica will conduct Bharat Sangeet Utsav 2022 from November 9 to 15. The festival, which will be held offline after a hiatus of two years, will feature performers from across the country, collaborative concerts and cover a wide variety of genres and themes.

M Krishnamurthy, secretary, Sri Parthasarathy Swami Sabha said, "We have been conducting



the festival for the last 18 years. Last year, we couldn't have live programmes due to the pandemic. So we had an online event that featured the best of Bharat Sangeet Utsav - we had recordings and took permission from artists to showcase the same."

"This festival features collaborative concerts and kickstarts the December season, which primarily celebrates Carnatic music." On the inaugural day,

senior musicians such as Neyveli Santhanagopalan, Lalgudi GJR Krishnan, Lalgudi Vijayalakshmi and Thiruvavur Bakthavatsalam will be honoured with the 'Global Ambassadors of Carnatic Music' award. It will be followed by their performance, 'Kala Sangamam' -- A Collaborative Concert'.

Carnatic musician S Sowmya, who will be performing on November 12, says, "The first part

of the concert will be regular. Later, I will be joined by 108 students from Tamil Nadu Dr J Jayalalitha Music and Fine Arts University, Tamil Nadu Government Music College, Chennai; and Tamil Isai Kalloori, Chennai. For one of the pieces, there will also be a dance performance by the students."

Other highlights include 'Rajesh Meets Rajesh', where the versatile and popular vainika Rajesh Vaidhya will join hands with U Rajesh on the mandolin. 'South Meets North' will feature classical vocals by Kunnakkudi M.Balamuralikrishna and Hindustani vocals by Jayateerth Mevundi. The concerts will be held at Narada Gana Sabha Hall.

# Digital re-survey: TN, Kerala to undertake joint inspection of border areas

Chennai, Nov 8: With the Kerala government having launched a digital re-survey of its land on November 1, the Tamil Nadu government said officials from both States would hold discussions and undertake a joint field inspection of areas along the inter-State border.

In response to a report published by The Hindu on Monday, Tamil Nadu's Revenue Minister K.K.S.S.R. Ramachandran said officials from both States would hold a discussion to compare their respective revenue records and other documents, and undertake a joint field inspection, only after which decisions would be arrived at.

In September this year, Kerala's Assistant Director (Re-survey) in Thodupuzha wrote

to Assistant Director (Survey) in Theni district of Tamil Nadu, seeking a convenient date, place and time for a discussion on a digital re-survey of areas in Chinnakkal, Sathurangapparai, Karunapuram and

Santhanparai villages that share a border with Tamil Nadu.

"A date and time for the participation of senior Survey Department officials from Theni district for that meeting would be conveyed by the

Theni administration," the Minister said.

Officials from both States would hold a discussion to compare their respective revenue records K.K.S.S.R. Ramachandran Revenue Minister.

# Health Dept steps up vector control, surveillance measures

Chennai, Nov 8: With the northeast monsoon bringing rainfall over the past week, the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stepped up vector-control and surveillance measures.

While mosquito pools are being tested for the dengue virus, daily field visits are being undertaken to determine the house index of

mosquitoes. Officials of the directorate said all ongoing precautionary measures for vector control were intensified following the rain in the last few days. District-wise review of the works was being done on a periodic basis.

"We are collecting mosquito pools from various places in the State. These mosquitoes are tested under the RT-

PCR method for the dengue antigen. The testing is done in our laboratories in Hosur and Chennai. Though one or two cases of dengue are being reported, no mosquito pool has been found to be positive for the dengue virus so far, meaning there is no large density of the Aedes mosquitoes," an officer said.

# Heavy rainfall predicted in several TN districts and Puducherry on Thursday

Chennai, Nov 8: On Tuesday and Wednesday light to moderate rain is likely at a few places in Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Karaikal.

Around 13 districts in the State are likely to witness heavy rain on Thursday in isolated places over Kanniyakumari, Tirunelveli, Tenkasi, Thoothukudi, Ram-anathapuram, Sivaganga, Pudukkottai, Thanjavur, Tiruvuru, Nagapattinam, Mayiladuthurai, Cuddalore and Villupuram

districts, Puducherry and Karaikal.

According to P. Senthamarai Kannan, Director, Area Cyclone Warning Centre, light to moderate rain has been

forecast at many places with thunderstorm and lightning over isolated places in Tamil Nadu, Puducherry and Karaikal on Thursday.

Strong winds with

speed of 45-55 km/h gusting to 65 km/h are also likely to prevail over Tamil Nadu-south Andhra Pradesh coasts on Thursday and Friday.

# Adult immunisation key to protect India's 260 million ageing adults

Chennai, Nov 8: The World Health Organisation (WHO) defines healthy ageing as "the process of developing and maintaining the functional ability that enables wellbeing in older age." The WHO has also recognised adult immunisation as one of the strategies for healthy ageing in their 'Decade of Healthy Ageing - Baseline Report -2020'.

The Indian population is ageing rapidly with the number of people above 50 years of age expected to increase to 404 million in 2036 from 260 million in 2020[2], representing 27% of the country's projected population. Ageing results in reduced immunity and makes older people vulnerable to infectious diseases such as pneumonia, influenza, and shingles and their complications, but these can all be prevented with the help of vaccines[3].

Dr. Maya Vadamurthy, M.D, D.D., MAMS, FRCP (Edin), dermatologist at RSV Skin and Research Centre and Apollo Hospitals, Grems Road, Chennai, says, "Infections in old age can lead to severe complications. My advice is that adults above 50 years of age specially those who suffer from chronic conditions such as diabetes and those who are on medications such as chemotherapy should take all the available vaccines for protection against infections. Shingles is one such infectious disease which, in older adults, can lead to debilitating pain and in some cases, vision loss and hearing loss. When a vaccine for shingles becomes available in India, all adults above 50 years of age must take it."

In India, non-communicable diseases (NCDs) such as cardiovascular diseases, chronic

respiratory diseases and diabetes contribute to more than half of the total disease burden[4]. Adults who suffer from such comorbidities are more prone to VPDs. A report recently suggested that more than 95% deaths due to VPDs in India occur in adults[5]. Not only are these diseases debilitating, but they also tend to complicate the NCDs leading to increased hospitalisation.

Vaccines have saved millions of lives through complete or almost-complete eradication of deadly diseases such as smallpox and polio. The concerted effort to make paediatric vaccinations accessible to all children has yielded measurable results. The need of the hour is to prioritise adult immunisation to save more lives and improve quality of life. These measures can also serve to reduce the economic burden of healthcare for individuals, caregivers, and the nation.
